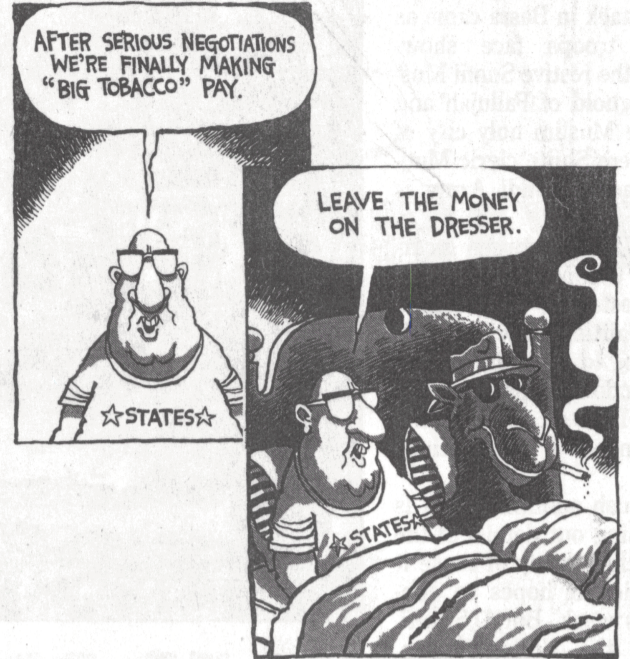

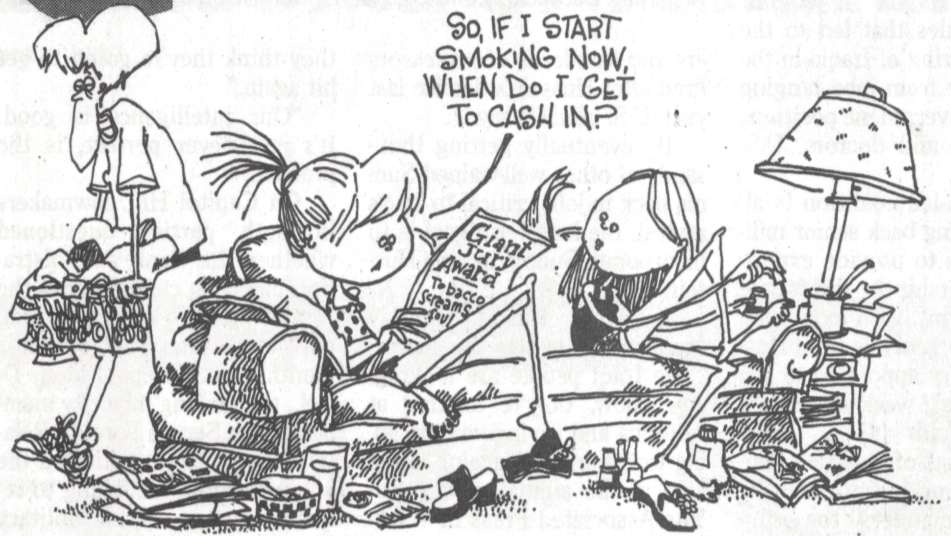
CARTOONISTS TAKE UP

Among the programs and events is today's grand opening of an exhibit of cartoons about tobacco at Ann Tower Gallery in the Downtown Arts Center on East Main Street.
