



aren Blixen, the famed Danish author best known for writing *Out of Africa* under the pen name Isak Dinesen, likely never suspected how true her words would be when it comes to hydroponic horticulture. The "cure" for traditional soil-grown pot is water mixed with salts to create a nutrient solution. Plants grown hydroponically—i.e., without soil—exhibit explosive growth rates far exceeding their soil-based counterparts. Understanding what's in your reservoir is the ultimate key to a successful hydro harvest.

It all might sound a bit complicated and high-tech from afar, but the truth is that soilless growing has been around since the ancient Hanging Gardens of Babylon. All that's required is a fundamental understanding of the basic needs of roots: food, water, and oxygen at the proper levels and temperature. And that's what we've provided in our annual Hydro Report, along with equipment reviews and some tips and tricks for mastering the art of hydro growing. We've even included a list of reasons why hydroponics may be *more* sustainable in terms of the environment than growing with soil indoors.



## **Getting Fracked!**

Our existence depends on clean water. That's why the fracking industry must be stopped. *By Kent Lebsock* 

**Is fracking dangerous?** The short answer is *yes*.

Fracking (short for "hydraulic fracturing") is the oil and gas industries' highly controversial process for retrieving natural gas from deposits in shale rock 6,000 to 10,000 feet (or one to two miles) beneath the surface of the earth. Highly pressurized water, mixed with a veritable gumbo of highly toxic chemicals and sand, is injected into the "well," creating a chemical reaction that opens fissures in the shale. Natural gas escapes through the fissures and is drawn back up the well to the surface, where it is processed, refined and shipped to market. Gee! What could possibly go wrong? Let's start with the fracking mixture, which is made up of highly corrosive and carcinogenic chemicals. It seems reasonable to regulate the chemicals that make up this mixture, but the industry considers that information a trade secret—and, of course, the government and courts have supported that position.

We do know that there are approximately 600 different chemicals that the industry can choose from. These include methane, benzene and toluene (all of which are considered toxic under the Clean Air Act and the Safe Drinking– Water Act), plus diesel fuel, lead, sulfuric acid and formaldehyde, just to name a few. Not all 600 chemicals are used in a single injection (or frack). The industry asserts that only five to 10 chemicals are used per frack, and this makes a difference because, presumably, there is safety in using fewer chemicals. But whatever the concoction, there can be from 80 to 300 tons of these chemicals used in each injection. What the industry also fails to mention is that, although a fracking well may be host to "only" 300 tons of hazardous chemicals, a fracking minefield contains thousands of wells, all using different compounds, amassing an enormous cumulative effect.

The industry may insist that the fracking process itself is not dangerous, but the components used in the process definitely cause problems. In Pennsylvania, inspectors found that nearly 1 in 10 wells had faulty cement and steel casings, making\_\_\_\_\_\_ them prone to leaks and contamination.

Kee Because these drilling sites are not only vertical, but also travel horizontally sometimes for miles—the risk presented by these faulty "components" is greatly increased. A Pennsylvania study shows this risk has increased since 2009 with the growth of the fracking boom, and that the depth and breadth of the wells has increased as well. How can the components of fracking be separated from the safety of the process?

Fracking presents levels of potential contamination never experienced before—and, increasingly, water is the victim. Wastewater, called "flowback water" or "produced water," returns to the surface after the fracking process is completed. There is no known way to effectively dispose of it. Some of this water is reused, but that only delays the ultimate problem. Some of it is pumped into even deeper injection wells, which, according to Dr. Bill Chameides of Duke University, causes "an earthquake every now and again."

The only other known way to dispose of this wastewater would be to treat it. But the technology has not kept up with the industry here. Highly sophisticated processes are required, and, to date, none have proven effective.

Beyond the issues of water contamination

and wastewater disposal, the sheer quantity of water used is enormous. Two to eight *million* gallons of water are used per frack. These millions of gallons are used across minefields, which can be populated by thousands of mines, and each fracking well can be used repeatedly. It's no wonder that water-usage calculations can't be found in the research. The industry doesn't know—or perhaps it's willfully ignorant.

Moreover, rarely do fracking minefields have access to that quantity of water; it has to be brought in, mostly by truck. According to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation, each frack requires 400 to 600 tanker trucks for each well and another 200 to 300 tanker trucks to take away the liquid waste from that frack.

The potential for disaster is consistently minimized or dismissed entirely. However, it's not corporations who will live with the contamination or pay to try to clean it up—we will. Earlier in September, John Gladden, a retired research

manager and fracking foe, told commissioners in North Carolina what the average person seems to understand, but the industry chooses to ignore: "It's cheaper to prevent contamination than to clean it up."

Fracking operations are currently underway in at least 17 states. Sadly, Colorado—a state close to the hearts of all in the cannabis community—is second only to Texas in the number of fracking wells. Colorado may be enjoying a popculture grooviness because of legal weed, but its environmental policies leave a lot to be desired.

Many municipalities are challenging the frackers, but the government and corporations have put up many roadblocks. As human beings—and, in particular, as human beings who smoke pot—it is our responsibility to support these challenges, in Colorado and across the nation. Legal cannabis production and retail sales may usher in a new viable industry, but let's never forget that it's completely reliant on *clean* water.  $\frac{1}{2}$

#### **High on Hemp**

**Kentucky Harvest** On September 23, the first legal hemp harvest in the Bluegrass State since World War II occurred at the University of Kentucky's Spindletop Research Farm, which is cultivating and evaluating 13 different types of hemp for seed and fiber production. Some of the seeds were shipped from Italy. They were detained by US Customs officials in May, until the Feds approved a permit.



#### **Global Gains**


Europe reached a new record in hemp-seed production in 2013 with 9,000 metric tons (almost 20 million pounds). In Canada. 36,000 hectares (approximately 90.000 acres) were utilized for hemp-seed production in 2014. In 2015, that total is expected to increase to 50,000 hectares, for both human food and animal feed markets. Hemp has been around for centuries. Everything old is new again.




**Oregon Gets Ready** Measure 91 would legalize recreational pot in Oregon, but a less-publicized provision moves the state closer to an industrialhemp industry. The state decriminalized hemp production in 2009, but because of the federal ban, the State Department of Aariculture refused to issue any hemp-production licenses. Measure 91 removes all barriers to hemp production and would allow licensing.



**House of Hemp** Hempcrete is both the common and brand name for construction materials consisting of the inner woody core of hemp combined with a lime-based binder, known for its superior acoustic and thermal insulation. Last August. 64-year-old Bob Clayton unveiled his hempcrete house in Tarpon Springs, FL. The house is reportedly only the fourth hemp home currently standing in the US.



**Mali Moves Forward** In September, the Global Hemp Group partnered with the Republic of Mali's national agricultural research institute to investigate industrial-hemp cultivation. As in Kentucky, varieties of hemp will be analyzed to determine those best suited to be cultivated in this West African nation struggling with deforestation and drought, with the long-term goal of establishing a Malian hemp industry.

Infused wine that she promises will "taste amazing." On the Bloomberg TV program *Taking Stock*, Etheridge gushed: "I believe this is a huge opportunity a huge business and a huge market."

Etheridge has plans to attach her name to a number of new cannabis products. She also discussed her use of medical marijuana in successfully coping with breast cancer: "Cannabis kept me very healthy during chemotherapy. I would highly recommend anyone who is undergoing [chemo] to really look into the medical sides [of pot]."

Before her wine and other ganja goodies can be sold commercially, Etheridge said, there are a handful of legal issues that need to be addressed. But once those are settled, she looks forward to "bringing this to the world in a not-scary way, not an outlaw way. It's not that anymore. This is an American business."

#### **Billions in Buds**

Green Wave Advisers, a group founded to research and analyze the emerging cannabis industry, states that by 2020 the industry could be worth as much as \$35 billion yearly if pot is legalized at a national level. The *Washington Post* crunched those numbers. That would make the business of pot bigger than the NFL, America's newspaper publishing industry or even the confection industry. (We expect profits to soar in the confection industry to o!)



#### **Marijuana and the Marathon Bombing**

Pot smoke continues to swirl around the 2013 Boston Marathon bombing. In October, defense attorneys for Robel Phillipos, a childhood friend of bombing suspect Dzhokhar Tsarnaev, argued in federal court that Phillipos was so "high out of his mind" that he can't recall accompanying two other friends to Tsarnaev's dorm room to remove incriminating evidence three days after the attack. Phillipos, 20, faces two counts of lying to the FBI, thereby depriving the Feds of critical information during the height of their bombing investigation. He faces up to 16 years in prison if convicted.

Phillipos's defense attorney, Derege Demissie, argues that his client signed a confession admitting to being in Tsarnaev's dorm room only after being placed under intense pressure by the Feds—not because Phillipos actually recalled being in the dorm. So he doesn't remember witnessing Azamat Tazhayakov and Dias Kadyrbayev removing a backpack containing modified fireworks. For his part, Assistant US Attorney John Capin insists that Phillipos "created a fiction."



New research proves that pot provides neuroprotection against traumatic brain injury (TBI), with THC actually limiting the presence of toxic chemicals while decreasing swelling in the brain.

The Los Angeles Biomedical Research Institute investigated 446 TBI patients who were administered urinalysis to detect THC. Of the 82 patients who tested positive for THC, only 2.4 percent died. The remaining 364 TBI patients—who had no discernible THC in their system—had a significantly higher death rate: 11.5 percent.

Lead author Dr. David Plurad noted that this trend had already been observed in earlier animal research: "Previous studies found certain compounds in marijuana helped protect the brain in animals after a trauma."

So pot may protect as well as stimulate your brain—but don't toss that motorcycle helmet.

#### The UN: Ineffectual, As Always

In October, a top official at the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) rejected an international panel's well-reasoned recommendation that UN countries should experiment with decriminalizing and regulating illegal drugs such as cannabis.

The Global Commission on Drug Policy is a 22-person panel, formed in 2011, that includes such luminaries as ex-Mexican President Ernesto Zedillo, Virgin Group billionaire Richard Branson and even ex-UN Secretary-General Kofi Annan. The commission's September 2014 report, Taking Control: Pathways to Drug Policies That Work, calls for an end to criminalizing people for drug use and requiring "compulsory treatment" for individuals whose only offense is a drug violation. The commission also advocated alternatives to incarceration for nonviolent, low-level participants in manufacturing and trafficking operations.

However, Yury Fedotov, executive director of the UNODC, believes that the recommendations would undermine major provisions of international drug-control treaties, adding that "such experiments certainly will make drugs more available and cheaper."

But the commission's report was extremely blunt: "The international drug-control regime is broken."

And yet the UN continues to insist on adherence to outdated treaties that impede meaningful drug-law reform across the globe.

## Plant Offers Pot

When ex-Led Zeppelin vocalist Robert Plant recently appeared on *The Colbert Report*, he came bearing gifts, presenting host Stephen Colbert with what definitely appeared to be a joint. "I brought you a little present from our stock room," Plant said.

Colbert accepted the doobie and asked, "What is that?" Then he sniffed it and said: "Let's find out what this is later, shall we?"

Plant countered: "I think it's one of the accessories of being, not quite a knight of the British Empire, but on the way."

Colbert quipped, "And for the purposes of my lawyer and my network, this is a cigarette." Then he deftly slipped the jay inside his jacket. No word on whether they toked up later.



#### **Shame of New York City**

Last year, nearly 50,000 people were arrested for possession in New York City. What's more, recent studies demonstrate clear racial bias in arrests for lowlevel possession, with African-Americans arrested four times more frequently as whites—despite roughly equal usage rates. When New York City Mayor Bill de Blasio campaigned for office last year, he called the policy "unjust and wrong."

But it's business as usual in the Big Apple under Mayor de Blasio. According to a new report from the Marijuana Arrest Research Project and the Drug Policy Alliance, pot busts are up from March to August of 2014 compared to the same period last year under Mayor Bloomberg. The new report also sheds light on the racially disparate impact of prohibition, finding that 86 percent of those busted in that time period were black or Latino. Just 10 percent were white.

#### **Elitism at Work**

The pot-marketing agency Cannabrand found itself doing spin control to limit the damage to its reputation after insulting the cannabis community. On October 3, The New York Times ran a story titled "In Colorado, a Rebranding of Pot Inc." It featured a profile of Olivia Mannix and Jennifer DeFalco, the co-founders of Cannabrand. Mannix said: "We're weeding out the stoners. We want to show the world that normal, professional, successful people consume cannabis."

Right. There's no chance in hell of a "stoner" being successful or professional or normal. She also said dispensaries "look like underground abortion clinics."

Not to be outdone, DeFalco insisted that legal cannabis ads are full of "women with whipped cream straddling bongs."

Such rhetoric hardly went unnoticed. Mindful, a Colorado dispensary group, quickly terminated its business with the company, calling the comments "hurtful and insulting to the industry and to the many that have fought so hard for years in the name of patient rights and safe access."

Mannix and DeFalco issued a joint statement: "There were several quotes that did not clearly convey our stance. Please let us clarify: we support everyone in the marijuana industry, and it's unfortunate that those statements do not accurately portray Cannabrand or our community." We have put all our knowledge, experience and best technology into this device.

#### ISIS to Attack the US Through Mexico–Not!

Here we go again. Francis X. Taylor, undersecretary for intelligence at the Department of Homeland Security, testified before the Senate Homeland Security Committee on September 10 that operatives from the extremist jihadi movement known as ISIS (or ISIL, or the Islamic State) have discussed infiltrating the US through Mexico. "There have been Twitter and social-media exchanges among ISIL adherents across the globe speaking about that as a possibility," Taylor said in response to a question by Senator John McCain, who asked if ISIS chatter had been intercepted that "would urge infiltration into the United States across our southwestern border." But Taylor said he was "satisfied that we have the intelligence and the capability at our border that would prevent that activity." Pressed further, he admitted: "At present, DHS is unaware of any specific, credible threat to the US homeland from ISIL."

We've been hearing the same paranoid tune for years now—only the names have changed. A year ago, officials and pundits were speculating about Hczbollah plotting with the Mexican cartels,



#### **Record Bust in Peru Points to More Cartel Influence**


A record-breaking cocaine bust on Peru's coast indicates not only the country's booming production, but also the increasing role of Mexican cartels in the Andean narco economy. Peru's Interior Ministry announced the haul on September 1, saying that National Police and DEA agents had uncovered an unprecedented 7.6 metric tons of cocaine hidden in a coal shipment at a warehouse in the port of Huanchaco.

Paperwork seized at the warehouse indicated that the shipment was bound for Spain and Belgium. Eight Peruvians and two Mexicans were arrested. The Interior Ministry said that a Mexican gang arranged the shipment.

Peru's cocaine boom can be attributed to the "success" of the US-led eradication efforts in Colombia, which have pushed production into the neighboring country in a case of the "balloon effect"—ironically, the exact opposite of what happened in the 1990s, when aggressive eradication in Peru led to the Colombian boom.

or Al Qaeda recruiting criminal gangs to send terrorists across the border. The Mexican government has denied any Islamist militant presence in the country.

This propaganda motif dates back to World War I, when fears were stoked of a German invasion of the US via Mexico. An intercepted German diplomatic cable-the notorious Zimmerman telegram-invited Mexico to join the Central Powers. Nothing ever came of it: Mexico told Kaiser Wilhelm to take a hike. But the revelation fueled war fever and actually helped propel the United States into the global conflict. A century later, you'd think the trick would be getting a little stale.



#### Protesters Demand Release of Vigilante Leader

Supporters of José Manuel Mireles Valverde, imprisoned leader of the "self-defense" forces in Mexico's violencetorn Michoacán state, are holding protests to demand his release. Mireles was the one "community police" leader who refused to accept the government's deal to bring local militias under its control. He was arrested on June 27 at the Michoacán pueblo of La Mira and charged with narcotics and arms trafficking. His lawyers say the evidence against him was fabricated and that he was tortured in detention. His supporters insist that Mireles is being punished for opposing the plan to integrate local militias into the official security forces, which are deeply corrupted by the drug cartels.

#### A New "Pax Mafiosa" in Mexico?

Amnesty International on September 4 issued a report harshly criticizing the Mexican government for its failure to stop torture and other "cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment" at the hands of the military and police. The report calls on




Mexico to enforce humanrights laws. Instead, President Enrique Peña Nieto has created even more layers of police. In addition to the Rural Defense Corps that incorporates local "self-defense" militias in Michoacán, he unveiled a "national gendarmerie" to help the police battle gangs. But adding to police forces merely provides more firepower for the cartels to co-opt-a situation that won't change until the underlying roots of Mexico's narco violence are addressed.

Since Peña Nieto took office, there has been speculation that his government could rebuild the "Pax Mafiosa" that more or less kept the peace between rival cartels under the country's old one-party state. Ironically, the opening of Mexico to a multi-party system with the 2000 election of Vicente Fox marked the beginning of its descent into endless cartel warfare. Peña Nieto's election returned to power the Institutional Revolutionary Party (PRI) from the one-party era, when the Mexican government brokered a turf division among the cartels. 🖗


#### Pot for Your G-Spot?

Like an inexorable flow of lava down the side of an erupting volcano, new pot products are seeping into every corner of the market—including a new cannabis-infused "sensual enhancement oil." Foria harnesses the well-known aphrodisiac power of marijuana with an alluring invitation to "slow down, relax deeply, and discover the pleasure within."

The personal lubricant is designed for use by women. Aphrodite Group, the medical collective behind the oil, says it created Foria to "benefit women's health and wellbeing by opening the door to natural, euphoric pleasure." The oil's orgasm-enhancing claims have garnered plenty of attention, and the response has been enthusiastic. Effects can vary depending on a woman's menstrual cycle-which is interesting, especially in light of a recent study showing that female rats are more sensitive to THC than males, thanks to their estrogen levels.

Women describe their experience with the oil as "buzzy," "tingly," "relaxing" and "magic." The *HT* staffer who tried it out experienced "a soft, warm, melting feeling," saying, "On the pleasure spectrum, I'd rate it a nice, mellow body high."

Whether you experience heightened sensation or sweet relaxation, it seems that this potenhanced oil may indeed be good for your punani.



#### **Kick Tobacco with Shrooms!**

*Psilocybe cubensis*—magic mushrooms—have been used in healing rituals for thousands of years; now, a new study suggests that the curative powers of shrooms may help longtime cigarette smokers kick the habit better than any pharmaceutical drug.

Johns Hopkins researchers report that 80 percent of smokers receiving a controlled dose of psilocybin while participating in a cognitive-behavioraltherapy program abstained from smoking for six months—much higher than the typical success rate of less than 30 percent using nicotine replacement and behavioral therapy. Even the most effective smoking-cessation drug, varenicline, has only a 35 percent success rate after six months.

The study, published in the Journal of Psychopharmacology, observed 15 men and women who smoked, on average, 19 cigarettes a day for 31 years. All had repeatedly tried, and failed, to quit.

Despite the 80 percent success rate, researchers strongly cautioned that the study results did not justify do-it-yourself attempts at quitting smoking through the use of psychedelics. Professor Matthew W. Johnson, a co-author of the study, says the psilocybin was administered "after careful preparation and in a therapeutic context." The subjects, all mentally and physically healthy, reported minimal past use of hallucinogens; five had never taken psychedelics of any kind. Clinicians administered a dose of psilocybin to each participant on the day they planned to quit smoking; two subsequent sessions with higher doses were held two and eight weeks later. During each six- to seven-hour session, participants were moni-

tored in a homelike environment, wearing eyeshades and listening to music through headphones, and encouraged to relax and focus inward. The shroom sessions were supplemented with weekly counseling.

Researchers suggest that the psilocybin helped break the cycle of addictive thoughts and behaviors, with the benefits of the drug lasting long after its physical effects had worn off. Professor Johnson and the Johns Hopkins team will next compare the success rates of psilocybin and nicotine patches, using MRI scans to study brain activity. Stay tuned for more interesting results from the world of magicmushroom medicine.

#### Have Weed, Will Travel

We find out all about Freddie Gibbs' latest projects and what's fueling his high-energy performances. *By Chris Simunek* 

At this very moment, it's likely that Freddie Gibbs has some spare pot in his luggage. "Y'all check my bag, there might be some weed in there," he tells us, relighting a Backwoods blunt that went out in his hand as he gesticulated. He takes a fat pull and addresses the world: "T'll keep it real with y'all. You wanna lock me up? That's what I do, that's my shit, and I'll be doing it until y'all legalize it."

Following a slew of independent mixtapes that raised his profile to a national level—and, most recently, a renowned album produced by eminent weedhead loop-digger Madlib—Gibbs finds himself traversing the country to perform. And there's no way he's making those trips without copious amounts of bud on hand. Gibbs recalls a recent stint with rapper Tech N9ne: "On that tour, I was definitely the big smoker. was one of many street substances Gibbs sold to get by. Back then, he'd get gripped up and cuffed for having a few small bags in his pocket. Today, he gets a slap on the wrist for an ounce. He could have used that kind of leniency as a young kid, but if now is when America decides to change its mind on weed, Freddie Gibbs is with the trend. As he puts it: "Everybody's running around dumping goddamn ice on themselves for the ALS Challenge. Nigga, let's just smoke a blunt for the ALS Challenge! Let's legalize weed and use the revenue to research ALS, or sickle-cell anemia, paralysis, things of that nature. I've been selling weed since I was 13, so I know the value of some weed. Everyone in the country wants it. Let's put it to good use."

As for the legal business of weed, Gibbs sees many of his fellow rappers jumping into the game with newfangled vape pens. He's not wholly convinced. "I fuck with it, but I'm not about to load it up myself. I'm just an old-fashioned blunt-smoking nigga off the street. I don't got time for that shit." What he would have time for, however, is a partnership with Backwoods. As Gibbs lights a fresh one, he brainstorms a name. "We'd call it Crackwoods," he says finally. 💥

Rapper Freddie Gibbs is smoking furiously through tours with Tech N9ne, studio sessions with Madlib, and his own steady ascent on the global hip-hop scene. And he's fearless about the extra ounce stashed in his bag.

#### In your autobiography, *Wild Tales*, one of the book's opening photos is of a tray with lots of weed and different accoutrements. Was smoking marijuana an important part of your life?

We were high constantly all the time. Not only on marijuana, but cocaine, also. I don't advocate that people take drugs, but at that time they did pretty good for me. I think smoking dope opened up my mind of the possibilities, it took me out of Manchester [England], and it made my mind flower. I enjoyed it tremendously.

#### Did you use cannabis as part of your songwriting process?

No, I was high all the time, it was a part of every process. It wasn't like I smoked dope to write.

#### Do you still use cannabis?

I love to smoke dope. I'm very interested in seeing what's going on with people in Colorado, Washington State and Alaska. I think people really need to come out from under the reefer madness craziness.

But it's changing now. People understand that if you want to go and smoke a joint,

the last thing you want to do is fight. But if you get drunk, the first thing you wanna do is fight. I don't agree with [an] American society where liquor is completely legal because it kills many, many thousands of people per year-not only in abuse of alcohol-but in road accidents, rage and shootings. When people smoke dope, the last thing they want to do is get into an argument and start fighting. I don't know anybody that smokes dope and wants to fight. Do you?

No, I've only ever seen people fight over the next hit. You've been through lots of different political movements, do you consider marijuana a political movement now?

Everything's politics. Getting up and having breakfast is politics. I was amazed to read the Maureen Dowd



article where she overate too many pot cookies and told everybody what a horrible time she had, and how she ended up in the fetal position. What she never told you about was the dozen of times she was fucking blasted on alcohol and didn't know whether her knickers were on or off.

#### You're a big environmentalist. Right now what is your biggest issue?

The ocean and the planet we live on. It's very obvious what's going on; 98 percent of the scientists know global warming is happening. They know that humanity is a major cause and that it's going to get incredibly bad in the next few years.

In the song "Déjà Vu," there's a great line about how "we've all been here before," and how history repeats itself. Are there political situations that we're dealing with now that also resonated with you in 1974?

Well, "Military Madness" is a song I wrote for my father going off to World War II, and yet look where we are. We were just in Iraq and now we are in Afghanistan and in Yemen, and Somalia, and all the other places that we've got wars going on. "Field Worker" is about the plight of people that grow our food and pull it out of the ground and put it on our tables. Immigration matters: look at what's going on even today is about the immigration situation. So a lot of those songs that we spoke about are still problems today. It's a dichotomy because it's thrilling that the songs last this long... and it's a pain in the ass that we still have to sing them. 💥

Life Used to Be So Hard

#### Crack Control Contras, cocaine and the CIA.

**This film tells** a story of government-sponsored urban decay, of the CIA helping stoke the 1980s crack epidemic by protecting high-level dealers who flooded the market with cheap coke in order to fund Nicaraguan contras.

It was done through people like Nicaraguan cocaine magnate Oscar Danilo Blandón, who sold to "Freeway" Rick Ross (the original dealer, not the rapper who took his name), the man widely blamed for bringing crack to LA. Although it may sound like a conspiracy theorist's wet dream—or nightmare—it's true, and there are government documents to prove it.

Emmy Award–winning filmmaker Marc Levin chronicles the whole sordid tale, using tapes of



government officials talking openly about the scandal. The film also uses police footage from the 1980s, bringing the devastation of crack culture to light.

Freeway: Crack in the System Directed by Marc Levin (Blowback Productions/Al Jazeera America) The documentary centers on Ross, a young man from South-Central LA who didn't smoke crack, instead working to expand his business—sometimes selling \$1 million worth of coke in a single day. Ross's

success caught Blandón's eye, and the Nicaraguan began funneling cocaine through Ross into the hands of the urban poor. Little did Ross know, but he was helping fund the contras—a right-wing guerrilla army that the Reagan administration had vowed to support, despite a measure by Congress intended to cut off its funds.

The War on Drugs means harsh sentences for dealers (at least those without government protection). Ross eventually got busted, but he managed to shorten his life sentence to 20 years by learning to read and keeping his nose in law books in prison. He's now a free man with a new mission: to improve the areas of LA he helped to debase. He also speaks to students about steering clear of the choices he made. *Claire Scimeca*

#### Crust

5½ tbsp. unsalted butter 5 grams ground cannabis 1¼ cups crushed gingersnap cookies 3 tbsp. granulated sugar 1 pinch salt

#### Filling

¼ cup ice-cold water
1 package unflavored powdered gelatin
3 tsp. finely grated lemon zest
¾ cup granulated sugar
¾ cup fresh-squeezed lemon juice
(about four lemons)
1 pinch salt
1¼ cups heavy cream
¼ cup powdered sugar
4 egg yolks

Start by making your cannabutter: In a double boiler, melt the unsalted butter over low heat and stir in the ground cannabis. Continue cooking on low for 35 to 45 minutes, stirring occasionally and being careful not to burn the green matter. (Pull it at the first whiff of toastiness.) Squeeze all the butter out of the weed through a cheesecloth.

Preheat the oven to 350°F. Mix the cannabutter, salt, crushed gingersnap cookies and granulated sugar (note the High Times February 2015

This heavenly chiffon pie will have similar results, and it tastes even better than it smells! The weed-infused gingersnap crust is spicy and plays off the lemon flavor of the smooth, creamy filling. It's also easier to make than you might think. This classic dessert calls for separated egg volks and a little elbow grease, but you'll forget any toiling once that first bite melts in your mouth. Fold the whipped cream into the cooled lemon filling until evenly mixed. Next, put the filling in the crust, make the top look pretty, then stick it in the fridge for around four hours and voilà! *Stones 6 to 8*.

In this industry, the people who make stuff fall into one of two camps. They're either manufacturers (like 420 Science and Grav Labs). Or they're artists (like Salt, Slinger, and the man who started it all, Bob Snodgrass).

Some of these artists create elaborate glass pieces that sell for thousands of dollars.

Dave, the founder of Grav Labs, has always been a fan of Micah Evans (aka ME).

Micah is known for his elaborate work that blends art, the science of fluid dynamics, and a technical proficiency unmatched by other glassblowers.

Dave's not the type to spend hundreds of dollars on a pipe (let alone thousands), so he never bought any of Micah's pieces.

Until he saw the Upline.

This piece spoke to Dave. It's classic Micah Evans:

Art - The aesthetic is unlike any other pipe ever made. It's balanced, it's beautiful, and it's clean.

**Science** - The "spine" acts as a percolation device and creates a wonderful chugging sound that is deep and rich. Much like a Harley Davidson, the sound of this pipe is deeply satisfying and just feels right.

**Technical Proficiency** · This is not an easy piece to create The multiple segments of the spine are made to tight specifications.

So Dave pulled the trigger and bought the Upline because he loved it so much.

Years later, Grav was growing rapidly and Dave was developing new pieces and collaborating with glassblowers to bring their artistic pipes to a wider market.

He reached out to Micah and asked about licensing the design. They worked together to create a streamlined version of the Upline for Grav Labs.

This piece is one of the many reasons we admire Dave and what he's built at Grav.

Successful hydroponic marijuana farming requires an understanding of basic hydro principles and technology. Properly managing essential factors will lead to bigger, better harvests in a shorter time. *By Danny Danko and Erik Biks*a



#### **Hydro Basics**

Hydroponics is the art of growing plants without soil. A nutrient solution made up of water and plant foods is mixed in a reservoir and typically fed to the roots several times a day. The roots sit in an inert medium such as rockwool, perlite or grow rocks (also known as hydrocorn, puffed rock or expanded clay pellets). Some hydroponic systems, such as deep water culture (DWC), employ no medium at all; the roots simply dangle in an oxygenated nutrient solution and take up the liquid and foods as needed.

#### Why Go Hydro?

The advantages of hydroponics over hand-watering plants in a soilless mix are many. Plants grow faster when their roots aren't encumbered by thick, clumpy soil mix. With the ability to take in more oxygen through their roots, their explosive growth rates far exceed what can be accomplished in buckets full of dirt. Also, there is no bulky spent soil to get rid of, which can be advantageous in urban environments or warehouse grows, for which literally tons of soil are needed.

Another huge reason that people use hydroponics is that there's much less chance of pest infestations. The lab-like conditions necessary for hydro don't supply many places for pests to hide, thrive and reproduce. Also, many organic soil-based mediums and nutrients attract bugs with their smell of compost and rot. Introducing fish, seaweed or guanos will certainly bring more pest issues.

#### **Hydro Systems**

#### **Nutrient Film Technique** (NFT)

NFT uses round or squared tubes to deliver a constant flow of shallow nutrient solution. The plant roots sit in a trench and take up what they need, eventually forming a mat along the bottom of the tubes. It's important to ensure that the water is well oxygenated when using NFT, because the roots dangle down into the solution.

#### **Ebb-and-Flow or Flood-and-Drain**

These systems use trays to contain plants in a growing medium. Nutrient solution is periodically pumped into the trays from a reservoir and then drains back to the reservoir for the next feeding cycle, allowing roots to take in plenty of oxygen between waterings without completely drying out.


#### **Deep Water Culture (DWC)**

In DWC systems, each plant gets its own bucket, typically 5 gallons or larger. The plants are secured individually in mesh pots cut into the top of the buckets, and the roots dangle down into an oxygenated nutrient solution. Sometimes the buckets are connected to a larger reservoir, but they can also operate as stand-alone systems.

#### Aeroponics

Plants grown areoponically are fed a nutrient solution in the form of a mist aimed at the roots. The solution is fed via a pump through misters that bathe roots constantly, allowing them to absorb food while also taking in abundant amounts of oxygen. When aeroponic methods are properly dialed in, plants grow incredibly fast and big.

#### **Aquaponics:** Let Fish Do the Fertilizing

Aquaponics is an interesting method of soilless cultivation being used by urban-farming movements and some developing nations to produce crops and fish—with just a fraction of the water needed in conventional farming.

Aquaponics is a combination of *aquaculture* and *hydroponics* in a closed system: The fish defecate in the water in one tank, which then gets regularly circulated through the hydroponic medium of the plants, whose roots extract the nutrients they need and clean the water for the fish. Beneficial bacteria play a central role in this system, helping turn ammoniaheavy fish waste into useful nitrates for your plants. All you have to do is sit back and feed the fish, and a "mature" system (i.e., one with enough working bacteria) will provide the nutrients necessary for the flourishing growth of many plants, cannabis included. And though there are quite a few predesigned aquaponic systems out there, the possibilities for experimentation are endless.

One thing to keep in mind, however, is that the fish provide only a source of nitrogen; the system on its own is deficient

in iron, magnesium, sulfate, phosphorus and potassium. Iron DTPA chelate and magnesium sulfate can be added to the reservoir with no negative effects to the fish, but the amount of phosphorous or potassium desired for cannabis growth would be toxic to them.

So how have cannabis growers gotten around this? By using a system called *dual root zoning* (see the illustration), in which vegetative growth can match—and often surpass—even the growth

seen using traditional hydroponic methods, while producing buds with the natural and earthy flavor of the best soil-grown organic. The grower adds just the right amount of a phosphorous-andpotassium-rich nutrient solution to the top soil layer, but the main water reservoir won't be contaminated, because the soil mass absorbs it like a sponge. The system also uses a burlap flap that the plants' roots can grow through to separate the layers of soil and hydrocorn. As a result, the root-ball can absorb all the micro- and macronutrients it needs without those nutes circulating through the system and poisoning the fish.

This does seem like a laborintensive method, but in our rapidly changing and precarious world of water and energy shortages, resource-saving setups like this are just what the cannabis industry needs to be sustainable. *Sirius J*

Plus you don't need any pumps or tubing that can end up getting clogged, usually with catastrophic results.

Clay pellets are heated and then expand, forming what look like solid rocks that actually contain many crevices and air holes for oxygen to circulate. One advantage to pellets or grow rocks is that they can be reused many times, as long as they're properly cleaned between cycles.

#### Rockwool

Rockwool is made from rock that is heated and spun into long fibers that resemble the insulation used between walls in buildings. It has the advantage of holding lots of water while also allowing air to reach the roots. Rockwool can be an irritant to the skin and lungs, so always get it wet before working with it.

#### **Perlite and Vermiculite**

Perlite and vermiculite are two forms of heated minerals that expand into small, porous pebbles. They are typically used to lighten soilless mixes, but they can also be used alone as a hydroponic medium. Both exhibit good water retention and also have "wicking" properties that draw the nutrient solution upwards.

#### **Coir/Coco Peat**

Made from the fibers on the exterior of a coconut shell, coco peat is a natural byproduct of the coconut industry. Many hydroponic growers enjoy using this medium over rockwool due to its sustainability as well as its water-retention capacity. However, this medium requires a unique and specific type of nutrient solution made especially for use with coco peat.



Stay consistent: Cannabis plants have an amazing ability to adapt to a variety of situations, but they often produce best when given a consistent and stable environment. It's okay, for example, to have differences in temperature between day and night—but a stable pH and a steady EC (or ppm level) in nutrient formulations made specifically for hydroponics and applied at the same daily intervals, or continuously, will result in superior plants.

Be slow to change: Hydroponic systems can be incredibly responsive-much like a performance racecar's accelerationwhen growers make changes to the feeding program. You can see changes in hours instead of days when it comes to hydro, because nothing gets in the way of the roots absorbing supercharged nutrient solutions. However, this also means that you shouldn't make drastic changes, but rather gradual ones, so as not to lose control and crash and burn (or not burn, as the case may be, because your buds got overfertilized and won't smoke right).

Stay chill: Take advantage of the natural laws of thermodynamics. In simple terms, you can run a slightly warmer growroom, which can result in big power savings from reduced cooling when you use water-culture methods, and cool the nutrient solution rather than the air. Essentially, the plants' response to temperature has more to do with their internal temps and less to do with the temperature of the air. So a plant filled with water that was supplied at 68°F at the roots will stay cooler even when surrounded by warmer air. And when you add CO<sub>2</sub> to a warmer environment, it's like nitrous at a drag race—stand back and watch them go super-fast!

Cleanliness is important to hydro success.

Keep it clean: For professional medical producers and home growers alike, the "clean" factor of hydroponics is a big advantage. If you use natural principles and inert materials to cultivate plants, as in pure water-culture methods, your finished buds are far more likely to be free of any potential contaminants. And the same is true for the surrounding area, since hydro growing means fewer occurrences of problems like insects or diseases that may surface in "dirty" growing environments.

#### **Hydroponics AND Sustainability**

We live in an age of information. While this is undoubtedly a good thing, it can also mean that a lot of confusion and even flat-out misinformation gets propagated. The age-old hydro-versus-organics debate is a great example.

It would seem that only a fool would argue against organics. After all, that's what people pay a premium for—whether at the grocery store or the dispensary, or even at your favorite grow-supply shop. For whatever reason, most of us tend to look at organics in a more positive light than synthetics. Fair enough—but there's more to the story that we need to consider, and that concerns sustainability.

So let's say that, being into tasty and clean-burning buds and having a sense of value for the earth and its ecosystems, you opt for a bag of peat-based organic growing mix and a couple bottles of your favorite organic nutrients. Feeling good about your choice? Wait a sec ....

First, almost all of the cost associated with peat- or even coir-based grow mix is actually related to shipping bulk materials. Peat is super-cheap at the source, because the producers simply tear it from the earth (even though it can take tens of thousands of years to accumulate



naturally in a bog). So why does it cost so much? Because diesel fuel isn't cheap. Those bulk materials travel long distances before they're used in most regions.


Now consider the carbon footprint: Not only have you added more carbon to our atmosphere from that petroleumbased global bulk shipping, but you also helped strip away a part of a living system here on our planet. And what were you planning to do with it once your harvest was done? "Throw it away and start a new crop with fresh bags" is the most common answer.


The same goes for "specialty" bottled organic fertilizers. While these can produce great yields and tasty medicine, they involve shipping a lot of water around and are manufactured, at least in part, with simple dry goods, most of which you can source yourself locally.

Here's the deal with hydro: It can be more sustainable as well as more productive. But before we even go there, we need to get something else out of the way: Using hydroponic fertilizers or methods does not mean employing harmful PGRs (plant-growth regulators)-a common bit of misinformation. Synthetic nutrients are superclean basic elements-some cleaner than others, with many being food- or even laboratory-grade. For example, one of the most common ingredients is monopotassium phosphate (MKP). This has been used as a common food additive for years and years, and all it consists of is potassium, hydrogen, phosphorous and oxygen-the same as you'll find in a bottle of organic nutes, with one important

exception: It's in a stable form that your plants can take up right away for growth, and that won't spoil or sour easily.

At the heart of hydro growing in its truest form is water culture (in Greek, hydroponics means "working with water"). In this method, there is no growing medium at all—or, at the most, a very small amount of a reusable material like grow rocks, which are used simply to anchor the larger plants. The roots of the crops are bare and kept from light and drafts—essentially, they have their own mini-climate that the grower can control.

In the super-oxygenated environment that's optimal for roots, plants use nutrients more efficiently when they're supplied in clean and available forms and in specialty hydroponic formulations. Also, oxygenated roots enable plants to grow bigger, faster and stronger with lower fertilizer levels. This means that 4-liter nutrient jug will last four times as long now—and that's four times less fuel in the air than your bottle of organic nutes.

What about all that plastic? Professionally manufactured hydroponic systems are made from materials that last; they can be scrubbed clean with bleach and water and reused again—often on the same day as harvest, because



prepping a hydro system is faster and easier, in most cases, than getting a soilbased system ready to grow again. If you use grow rocks, you don't need many, because they too can be sterilized, rinsed clean and reused.

Hydroponics has many other advantages where sustainability is concerned. For example, systems and materials can be and are made from recycled plastics. A covered recirculating system uses considerably less water than traditional soil- or soilless-grown crops, because all of that water gets absorbed by rootsvery little is lost to the air or as run-off. A well-managed or automated hydroponic reservoir doesn't need to be dumped, either-with proper measurements and formulas, it can operate for the entire duration of the crop. And if your growroom gets too hot, you may not need that big energy-hungry air conditioner-a small one-quarter-horsepower water chiller cools the nutrient solution so that your crop can thrive in warmer temperatures, so long as the roots are kept at a perfect 68°F to 72°F.

There's much more to the story than what we've touched on here, but it's best for you to find out for yourself by dedicating a crop to hydro and experiencing the difference. While there's no doubt about the great quality, heavy yields and fast growth rates that can be achieved using hydroponics, it appears that there are also important environmental benefits to this ancient and yet very modern growing practice to be discovered by many of today's savvy medical cannabis cultivators.

#### The Future Is Here: Growroom and Reservoir Control

Automation technology is growing by leaps and bounds—just check out the home automation section at your local building center for proof. For cannabis growers, switches that can turn things on and off independently when you need them to are invaluable tools. A light timer is a perfect example.

We've arrived at the dawn of AI (artificial intelligence) in the growroom. One such example is Grohaus Automation's hydroponic reservoir control. Sure, the device can inject pH Up or Down and any ratio of nutrients and supplements via touch-screen programming that's all good, and save for the touch screen, these are already well-established technologies for sophisticated hydro growers.

Where the real quantum leap comes in has to do with the fact that the control thinks *before acting*. Seriously-the program watches your reservoir and the conditions (it can be set for higher or lower flow rates and aeration levels) and, once it learns the rhythms of change, will execute real-time adjustments after making intelligent assessments. For example, instead of adding pH Down the second the res value changes, it might wait

an hour—because it knows it will need to add more fertilizer soon, and the reaction when concentrate is introduced to the reservoir by the microdosers will lower the pH on its own. Smart growers know that continuous additions of pH buffers can shift the reservoir's chemistry over time, possibly causing uptake issues for hungry cannabis plants.

There are other gamechanging advances in controls and concepts that have begun to surface for hydroponic growers, including cloudbased technologies offering total growroom control. It's getting easier (and more efficient) to be productive, which means either less time fussing in the garden or the ability to

grow more (or bigger) with no additional labor. And this means, in turn, that the future is looking bright for cannabis and the dedicated people who grow it.  $\frac{4}{3}$


## America's Highest Garden

t's been said that attitude determines altitude—meaning that your approach to life has a lot to do with how high you'll fly. But in the mountains, it's just the opposite: Altitude determines attitude.

Essentially, you're looking down on everybody else-and not in a bad way. It's just that all of the world's drama is playing out far below you. The national stage seems distant when your home is nestled among majestic, snowcapped peaks. Maybe that's why the mountain towns of Colorado have always embraced progressive politics—specifically, cannabislaw reform. Who cares what the flatlanders think?

The booming ski resort of Breckenridge decriminalized up to an ounce long before recreational pot was voted on by Coloradoans, while nearby Alma holds regular town meetings to manage its emerging cannabis industry, which is pouring tax revenue into the city's economy.

**Alma, at an** elevation of 10,578 feet, also happens to be the highest incorporated town in North America. It's a bedroom community to upscale Breckenridge, offering cheaper housing and an authentic mountain lifestyle. It's home to 275

people (and a couple hundred dogs)—a community of skiers, snowboarders, rafters, anglers, bikers, hikers, miners and outstanding growers.

Alma can also lay claim to being the home of America's highest cannabis garden, which is operated by High Country Healing. But Mark January, the owner who oversees the garden operations, is quick to clarify: "We're the highest legal licensed garden in America. I know plenty of growers who have gardens in their mountain homes high above us. We're surrounded by growers ... even if you don't realize it. Tourists have no idea how many grower ski bums live here."

Though he hails from Missouri, Mark is now a man of the mountains. He's a former member of the ski patrol and now, a respected member of Alma's business community.

Like many Colorado pot shops, High Country Healing started out as a medical dispensary, but made the transition to recreational sales when Amendment 64 was passed in 2012. (High Country Healing has another location in Silver-

thorne, about 45 minutes away.)

The dispensary is ensconced in a bright yellow bungalow along Highway 9, Alma's main drag. Its buildings are nearly a century old, constructed by Gerald Galloway, a mining engineer who lived and raised a family there for close to 40 years. His wife taught music lessons in what is now the dispensary's lobby. At the rear of the house is a barn where Gerald melted and tested the ore—silver, gold and rhodochrosite—that miners brought in daily.

Alma just celebrated its 140-year anniversary. Many of the historical structures here were built in the 1930s to accommodate mining families, back when the town's population approached 20,000, spread across the area's mining camps. But history, as Mark discovered, can create hurdles—in this case, the issue of

historical preservation.

Upon purchasing the property, he was forbidden to demolish the barn. However, after a week of doing bong rips and walking in circles, his master builder brought him crude napkin drawings of a grow op he'd dubbed "Barnfarm."

His solution: convert the barn into High Country's primary garden. The Alma Town Building Department approved and, within a week, the chief of police was helping develop plans to overhaul the structure. The barn's exterior was never touched, and its historical character remains intact. But it wasn't easy—in fact, "it was a total mess," Mark recalls. "Inside were a couple heaping piles of coal that had to be hauled out. Plus a stinky old outhouse had to be demolished, which would definitely grab your gag reflex."

municipalities after filtration. So our plants' roots pull some of the earth's finest water, which definitely affects the flowers. We're a small, boutique mountain shop, and our clientele is extremely demanding when it comes to quality and potency."

As for nutrients, Mark says he's tried pretty much every high-quality product on the market. "They're all amazing, depending on what you're striving for—but we currently use Cutting Edge Solutions as a base nutrient line and Advanced Nutrients for additives. I've always liked these companies—not just for their amazing nutrients, but for their total honesty in a socially controversial industry. They don't talk 'tomatoes'; they talk cannabis. There's no bullshit with either company.

"For feeding schedules during the light cycle, we flood our trays for 15 minutes three to four times in 12 hours, depending on where we are in the cycle. We always feed for 15 minutes within the first hour after the lights turn on and for another 15 minutes about an hour before they go off, with two interval feedings staggered in between. We don't over-boost our nutrient levels; we actually suggest cutting all nutrient lines in half when starting out. Our ppm levels are lower at the start and finish of cycles, with average readings hovering around 1,200 to 1,400 ppm from late in week two until we flush beginning at the end of week six."

(The term "ppm," or "parts per million," refers to the concentration of minerals in the water that you give to your plants. Distilled drinking water can measure as low as 0 ppm, but poor-quality tap water or water that flows through bad pipes can measure as high as 700 ppm. Most tap water will fall in the 200 to 400 ppm range.)

"When we top reservoir levels with water," Mark continues, "we usually add nutrients to increase our ppm levels for optimal growth and happy plants. But we always flush for two to three weeks prior to harvest, slowly dropping ppm levels from 500 to 100.

The interior required total reframing of every rafter and stud to accommodate the brutal wind and snow-load requirements of the high country. And as with any commercial structure, all electrical requirements had to be carefully met. But thanks to its success, High Country Healing has expanded its all-hydro operation beyond the barn and added new local grow spaces.

"Prior to the legalization of recreational cannabis, we grew 50 percent soil/organic and 50 percent hydro," Mark explains. "But in order to compete with the mega-dispensaries and warehouses across Colorado, we decided to shift our gardens to 100 percent hydro. While there's higher risk with hydroponics, there's also higher reward, assuming the grow cycle is clean and free of any potential curveballs. Our hydro gardens are very rewarding when all the details are in place. We see greater yields and more consistency. We keep total control while cultivating smaller plants in greater numbers, never letting our gardens get

overgrown or overwhelming.

"Our flood-and-drain systems are very simple to operate, easy to clean, and built for consistent and perpetual production. Our growrooms are usually in transition between harvests for less than 48 hours, which means all of our flowering rooms have just two days off every year.


"There are lots of components and many parts when you grow hydroponically in multiple rooms with thousands of plants. To prevent crop failure and maintain garden performance, we're always replacing pumps, timers, fans, bulbs and ballasts to keep our wheels turning."

Mark also cites Alma's pure water as a natural reason to go hydro. The town is blessed with the highest watershed in North America. "The water is special up here, and we all know it makes a difference," he says. "Alma has always paid extra attention to any kind of impact on our local watershed. Some water reports state that Alma water comes in cleaner before filtration than the water of most



"The majority of trays and tables used in our gardens are all 4' x 4's and 4' x 8's in our flowering rooms, with 2' x 2's stacked on racks in our veg rooms. We also like 3' x 6' trays for the ease of moving them. Our reservoirs are all 70 gallons to feed the 4' x 4' trays and 115 gallons to feed the 4' x 8's. They're loaded with recirculation/feeding pumps, air-stone paddles and, of course, nutrients and Alma water.

"For the medium, the majority of our plants grow in hydroton or clay rocks for maximum root development, but also for the ease of cleaning and recycling our grow rocks. For preventative pesticide control, we use Azatrol or Azamax and keep molds and mildews at bay with GreenCure or Serenade. There's a lot of automation in our rooms, but we're very hands-on, with daily defoliation, pruning and plucking. Our plants are almost over-trained to direct all their energy to flower and bud development."


The High Country growrooms yield about 20 to 40 pounds per month, producing anywhere from 40 to 60 medical and recreational strains. But Mark says they never cherish false expectations regarding yields and avoid the temptation of the "homerun harvest." It's far more important to harvest quickly and have the flowering rooms transition smoothly, without any downtime between crops.

When asked about high-altitude grow problems, Mark's first response is: "It's fucking cold up here!" Then he adds, "You'd better love winter to live here. Summers rarely get above 80 degrees. We get piles of snow in Alma, and it's not rare to see a two-footer overnight. So you'd better love snow and shoveling. We actually fight the cold more than the heat, which makes it easier to control. But the sub-zero temps can be a bit challenging. Our nugs get super-purple and exotic-looking when that happens, and yields actually drop. Power outages during big snowstorms can be stressful, too: You gotta move fast to get those generators up and running!

"Still," he says, "it's a dream growing in the mountains, because it's consistently cool. We don't fight the extreme temperatures like most places. Our rooms are consistently operating at approximately 76.1°F, and we see little fluctuation in temperature. At this altitude, there's also a higher release of  $CO_2$ , which accelerates plant growth, flower development and potency."

Grape Ape is one of High Country's most popular stains, an 80 percent *indica* that recently tested at 22 percent THC, imbuing its users with a heavy brain and body high. Its genetics are challenging, "but worth it on harvest day," Mark says. Another High Country favorite, the Tahoe OG, has been testing at 26 percent and is sought after statewide; this 50/50 hybrid is extremely stable and provides a smooth, uplifting high. Women seem to love Mother's Finest, a strong sativa tested at 24 percent THC. It offers fruity terpene properties and a focused, grounded high. Mark calls Super Bubble Diesel a "racecar-like sativa," very potent-testing at 27 percent THC, it's a cross of Super Skunk, Bubble Gum and Sour Diesel.

may in fact be supernatural, Mark insists: "There are old spirits and energy in the shop. Everybody talks about it. Even weirder is that every grower here on staff claims they've heard instruments playing in our front waiting room, where Mrs. Galloway taught. I think our plants hear the music, too."

Perhaps. But their success is more likely due to the fact that High Country Healing's growers focus on consistency, potency and diversity in their gardens. And the pot public has taken note: High Country Healing's two shops are popular throughout Colorado and gaining stature nationwide.

"We get a lot of Front Range folks [from eastern Colorado] who simply want to get out of the city, smoke some mountain weed, go for a hike or ski—just relax in the mountains," Mark says. "We're lucky to be located just 17 miles south of Breckenridge, the busiest ski resort on earth and home to a half-dozen dispensaries. And just like the coffeeshop scene in Amsterdam, cannabis lovers are traveling from shop to shop in the mountains in search of the very best." **\***

# Golden Age of Edibles

Learn about the history of edibles, and how today's edibles are safer than ever before.

**Eating cannabis is** a tradition as old as time. Ancient Chinese emperors brewed cannabis tea. Hindus drank *bhang*, an intoxicating blend of warm milk, ginger, garam masala and gunjah. Nomadic tribes wandering Morocco ate a heady hash jam, thick with dried fruits, chopped nuts and prized spices, known as *mahjoun*. Hashish eating even figured prominently in the classic *One Thousand and One Nights* as a favorite treat of mystics, artists and healers.

In Paris in the 1840s, literary heavyweights such Charles Baudelaire, Victor Hugo and Alexandre Dumas crumbled hashish into their coffee, with the stimulating psychoactivity fueling late-night discussions at their Club des Hachichins ("Club of the Hashish Eaters"). In 1857, a young New York State resident named Fitz Hugh Ludlow published *The Hasheesh Eater*, a book about his experiences imbibing a hash tincture from a local apothecary.

So there's nothing all that new about marijuana edibles except their legal status. Thanks to nearly a century of pot prohibition, American society has been prevented from developing models of socially responsible THC ingestion. The wisdom we need to know how much to eat, when to eat it and what to expect has been driven deep underground. And so the much-hyped hysteria in the media today surrounding cannabis-infused foodstuffs is due to an ignorance of basic safety precautions and a lack of shared understanding about eating pot.

he modern marijuana edibles era began in 1954, when an elderly lesbian, Alice B. Toklas, the life partner of Gertrude Stein (the famous writer, art collector, and influencer of Hemingway, Picasso and Matisse), published her infamous cookbook. Containing a recipe for "Haschich Fudge" (sic) that was really more like a *mahjoun* or a parking-lot goo ball, The Alice B. Toklas *Cookbook* reintroduced the concept of cooking with cannabis to the American counterculture, and the idea of "pot brownies" took root in the popular consciousness. The recipe had been presented to Toklas as a gift by a painter friend named Brion Gysin, whose notes on sourcing the cannabis make it clear that he knew exactly what he was dealing with:

Take 1 teaspoon black peppercorns, 1 whole nutmeg, 4 average sticks of cinnamon, 1 teaspoon coriander. These should all be pulverized in a mortar. About a handful each of stone dates, dried figs, shelled almonds and peanuts: chop these and mix them together. A bunch of canibus sativa [sic] can be pulverized. This along with the spices should be dusted over the mixed fruit and nuts, kneaded together. About a cup of sugar dissolved in a big pat of butter. Rolled into a cake and cut into pieces or made into balls about the size of a walnut, it should be eaten with care. Two pieces are quite sufficient. Obtaining the canibus may present certain difficulties .... It should be picked and dried as soon as it has gone to seed and while the plant is still green.



### 92 Golden Age of Edibles

High Times readers first received essential knowledge about the ingestion of pot way back in 1978, when writer J.F. Burke contributed a brilliant article simply titled "Eat It!" This scribe worked as a sailor on cross-Atlantic journeys and had made a habit of eating hash, embracing the customs of the non-Western cultures he'd come in contact with, including Arabs, Indians and Africans. Burke offered tips on eating ground dried flowers along with some strangely prophetic predictions: "The next step after decriminalization may be brought about by the reintroduction of cannabis into the modern materia medica," he wrote, after describing pot's anti-tumor properties as well as its ability to lower blood pressure and relieve stress.

While '70s-era heads knew more about the medicinal uses of cannabis than we imagine, Burke and his sailor buddies didn't understand how infusing the herb into a chosen fat increased its potency and absorbability; instead, they recommended that people just crumble up the flowers and add them to their food. But Burke did offer one piece of sage advice that might have helped *New York Times* columnist Maureen Dowd navigate her recent bad trip:



"Eat It!" offered sage advice in 1978, while Chef Ra's gourmet ganja cooking taught a new generation.

What if you eat too much? You'll be drunk. You may barf. You might trip. But you won't die. The ratio of effective-tolethal dose of THC is 1 to 40,000 ... the lethal dose of THC would be 4,000,000 milligrams, an unwieldy mass to get into one's stomach, much less keep there. Later, starting in 1988, *High Times* editor Steve Hager contacted his high-school friend Jim Wilson, a.k.a. Chef Ra, and convinced him to write an infused-foods column called "Psychedelic Kitchen," which taught countless heads how to sauté their pot in butter or oil and add it to healthy Ital-style meals. Chef Ra's column continued for 15 years, and his best recipes were included in *The Official High Times Cannabis Cookbook* in 2012.







With prohibition being repealed in states like Colorado and Washington, more people are experimenting with marijuana edibles, leading to some growing pains as dosage and packaging requirements are established. However, until the cannabis community develops its own customs and rituals, and until effective public-safety campaigns are executed, we'll have to keep repeating this sage advice: "Go low and slow. Start with a low dose of 10 to 20 milligrams, then wait two hours before consuming any more pot food."





# How Clean Is Your Cannabis?

You just bought some wax. But do you know what's in it, who blasted it or who grew the plants let alone how they were grown?

nder a new program announced in Canada, strict guidelines have been imposed on the medical marijuana industry to ensure that the final product doesn't contain significant levels of heavy metals, aflatoxins, pesticides or microbial contamination. These guidelines weren't created specifically for cannabis: They're the same Pharmacopoeia-based standards used by Health Canada for other dried natural-health products derived from plants (i.e., echinacea, ginseng and so on).

### 100 How Clean Is Your Cannabis?

While the regulations were designed to protect Canadian consumers, it's actually quite difficult to meet these "dried product" standards by growing, drying and curing cannabis using the traditional methods. Many microbes that occur naturally in plants and soil can be flagged by such sensitive microbial tests. For example, the common Pseudo*monas aeruginosa* is one of the primary causes of hospital infections and can also be found on cannabis. Even a small amount of fungal sporulation, whether during growth or post-harvest, can lead to a failed test. As a result, some of the world's largest medical marijuana producers have opted to sterilize their cannabis using gamma radiation. While other, less invasive techniques exist to ensure product safety, each harvested batch must be tested independently by an outside lab prior to sale.

In the United States, the Food and Drug Administration has regulations similar to Health Canada's for most plant-based medicines. As attitudes toward cannabis undergo profound social change, there's a growing demand for lab tests to ensure the safety not only of medical marijuana, but recreational cannabis as well.

To many seasoned users, the idea of requiring such tests seems almost ludicrous. When cannabis is grown properly, without harsh chemical fertilizers or inorganic pesticides, and dried and cured in a clean environment, it's generally safe for consumption by any method. Indeed, it's not too surprising that no one is getting sick from cannabis, considering the method of consumption used by most people: Biological organisms do not typically survive the combustion or baking process.

However, several cases of illness and even death have been reported due to aspergillosis of the lungs following the smoking of cannabis contaminated by fungi. While it's difficult to prove that the infection was directly due to cannabis use, it should be noted that all of these cases involved people with compromised immune systems, such as transplant recipients or HIV/AIDS patients. And as other methods of ingesting cannabis become more popular (topicals, raw juicing, etc.), the risks of microbial infection may increase. People employing these methods should be much more concerned about whether there are infectious microbes such as E. coli on their plants.

While bacteria and fungi pose potential risks, we need to pay attention not only to the immediate short-term consequences of using contaminated cannabis, but also the long-term effects, which are often difficult to correlate with any single factor. When smoking, for example, there is always the risk of inhaling toxic vapors from the combusted material. Heavy metals, aflatoxins, mycotoxins, and residues from fertilizers, pesticides and fungicides can all be inhaled following combustion. Even vaporization can potentially release a number of these elements. Though a single low-dose

exposure appears relatively harmless, long-term exposure to these physically damaging and even carcinogenic agents should be a matter of serious concern.

This question becomes more acute when we ask to what extent these substances are being concentrated during the creation of cannabis extracts. There has been a sharp increase in extract production in recent years: Dabs, oils, waxes, budders, shatters and medical extracts are all increasingly available. However, unlike concentrated pharmaceutical drugs, many of the people making these extracts are not accredited scientists working in laboratory settings.

Testing for residual solvents has been one of the main focuses of quality control when it comes to cannabis extracts. However, this is only the obvious first thing to look for, since solvents are a major input in the extraction process. For this reason, solvent testing is extremely important, especially when substances are used that are not really safe for human consumption—for example, naphtha, a common solvent used in lighter fluid. The MSDS (material safety data sheet) for naphtha specifies that "vapors or mists from this material may cause central nervous system depression such as dizziness, drowsiness, headache, and similar nar-

cotic symptoms," which can also resemble the effects of a cannabis "high." For this reason, it is important to ensure that the solvent used in creating the concentrate has been properly removed.

For most of the extracts, residual solvent testing is the only safety analysis performed. Yet there are other concerns. Saving time or money can tempt concentrate producers to take shortcuts or make other compromises if they don't directly perceive a negative consequence. The people making these potentially hazardous decisions may not even be aware of their danger-but ignorance is not an excuse for compromising people's health.

I assume, for example, that most concentrate producers use high-quality solvents or gases. Yet the difference in cost between a 99.99 percent pure substance and something that

is *relatively* pure is considerable. Further, pure solvents or gases are much harder to acquire—and "pure," in these cases, doesn't always mean *pure*. Both the liquids and gases used in extraction often contain impurities. Typically, around 20 percent of the volatile gas found in butane is actually other gases such as hexane, heptane, ethyl mercaptan, benzene or some other potentially toxic substance.

One of the first things taught about compressed gases in a certification course is that it's not only important to know the source (i.e., supplier) of your gas, but also to know that the tank in which it arrives has been properly cleaned and stored. These tanks can be made from a variety of different metals, and each typically has

to be cleaned in a different fashion. Even more important is knowing what other gases have previously been stored in the tank. Many industrial suppliers of compressed gas simply take an empty tank and replace it with a filled one. This new tank could have been previously filled with any number of gases that may have toxic impurities. Keep in mind that when a tank is "empty," it still contains gas just not compressed at that point. The extent to which these leftover residues end up in concentrates needs to be further investigated.

# **Concentrates and Contaminants**

I set out to determine the extent to which common contaminants would accumulate in a basic extraction process. To do this, I used cannabis that had become moldy in the final stages of growth. Three separate samples were taken from these plants. Sample 1 consisted of the moldy dried flowers and had only biological contaminants (BC). Sample 2 was sprayed with a fungicide and two pesticides (FP) prior to harvest. Sample 3 contained toxic pollutants (TP) and was intended to represent potential post-harvest contamination; it included 1 gram of dried paint flecks, 1 milliliter (ml) of motor oil, 1 ml of bleach, 1 ml of dish detergent and 1 ml of rusty water.

These samples were extracted using the standard 99% isopropyl-alcohol process commonly used to make cannabis oil. After soaking overnight, the liquid was filtered and evaporated off. Each 100-gram sample yielded from 15 to 17 grams of cannabis oil. This was sent to an accredited third-party laboratory to test for aflatoxins, elemental components and pesticide residues.

The results were not encouraging (*see table*). Aflatoxins were found above acceptable limits in the two samples not treated with fungicide. This demonstrates that the toxins produced by fungi *did* accumulate in the extract. At the same time, pesticides were detected in Sample 2, demonstrating that these also accumulate during the extraction process.

Heavy metals were detected in Samples 2 and 3—specifically, charged metal ions like aluminum, cadmium, copper, lead, magnesium, nickel, strontium, tin and zinc. Regardless of whether these levels can be considered "safe," the continuous inhalation of such particles over time cannot be good. These simple tests demonstrate the potential for toxic impurities to accumulate during the extraction process.

### **CBDanger**

While many people make their own high-THC extracts, the interest in CBD has sparked a whole new industry surrounding this molecule and its potential medical benefits. Not only have breeders begun to focus on strains with high levels of CBD, but those looking to commercialize such extracts are able to create inexpensive CBD concentrates using industrial hemp.

One of the first and largest American producers of a high-CBD extract claims to be using raw hemp material grown in Canada. Similar extracts can now be purchased cheaply from other countries, such as China and the Czech Republic.

It didn't take me long to track down a number of extracts coming from China. While a supplier in Chicago claims to possess a certificate of analysis (CA) ensuring the safety of the product, I was able with relatively little effort to trace the source of the raw material: It was being shipped by a company in Hong Kong that acquired the hemp from China's Heilongjiang province.

Google Earth reveals a disturbing fact: The crops are being grown in a mountain valley that has mines all around. The runoff from these mines directly feeds the

or water. Precisely because of their capacity to hyperaccumulate toxic elements, these plants are used to clean up contaminated areas through a process known as photo-remediation. Plants also exchange air with the atmosphere, essentially breathing in any toxins that may be present. Fungicides and pesticides can leave residues as well.

Many plants-


A lack of strict environmental controls leads to contaminated soil. In the past six months, The New York Times has published two articles detailing how soil and water pollution in China have ended up in the food supply. Heavy-metal concentrations in plants grown in wastewater-irrigated soil were also significantly higher, exceeding the permissible limits

set by the Environmental Protection Agency and the World Health Organization. The extent to which these toxic substances are accumulating in Chinese hemp-and especially the concentrates made from it-have yet to be determined.

The disturbing reality is that without knowing exactly who grew your plants, what chemicals they used and how they produced the extract, you are taking a gamble with your future health. Aflatoxins and heavy metals are among the most carcinogenic substances known to science. Hitting a dab or using a concentrate with high levels of these substances is relatively unnoticeable over the short term, yet it will drastically increase the risk of cancer down the road. With new research coming out showing that cannabis smoking does not necessarily increase cancer rates—and may even play a preventative role-it would be detrimental to the cannabis movement to see a reversal of these statistics due to the consumption of contaminated extracts. 💥

#### Does pot figure into your creative process at all?

I smoke occasionally, but it's not a part of my routine. I mean, I don't need it—I do smoke occasionally, though. I don't like it that much when I'm out and about; I like smoking at home. I like it to be one of the last things I do that day. I don't wake and bake at all; I couldn't do that. If I'm waking and baking, then I'm staying inside my place the rest of the day. I can't start my day off high.

I used to smoke more in high school and college. But I still enjoy weed. I'll smoke and write some jokes sometimes-I've written some good stuff on weed. But sometimes it has my mind blown so much that it's tough to catch what you're thinkin' of, your mind is just firing so fast.

#### What's your reaction as America becomes more favorable to pot?

I think it's good, man. It's good that it's being decriminalized; it makes sense. People shouldn't be in jail for years for it. It's all out therethe research and different

studies about weed versus alcohol. Alcohol is legal but more dangerous; it causes violence. I mean, that's all out there. What's so funny to me is that different states can have their own thing. One state can say, "This is what we do here." But another state can say, "If you did that there, that's okay-but we don't fuck with that shit here." It's pretty goofy and arbitrary.

#### People of color have far higher arrest rates for pot than white people. What's your reaction to that?

That's not shocking-it's true for all arrests. People of color are profiled by the police more overall. The police have been doing that for years now, and they might continue to do it for a long time. Certain individuals and certain groups aren't in a great place in this country, so there's a lot of progress that needs to be made.

#### You seem pretty laid-back. What really pisses you off?

People who aren't reasonable ... you know, when you try to be logical and intelligent, and they just have a wall up and don't wanna help you out at all. It's when people use the rules as a way to be an asshole. My example is, I lost my ID while traveling a couple of weeks ago. I didn't have ID, but you can fly without ID-they just really search you. Like I had insurance cards and copies of my ID; I had emails, prescriptions ... so if you can prove your name and address, you can fly. But they give you a full pat-down and look through your bag.

So, like, I've been touring: three days, three different cities-I was doing three oneday flights back-to-back. It was awful and I don't recommend it to anyone. 



Increasing yields by controlling internode lengths.

#### **The Advantages of Keeping It Short**

Internode lengths are the distances between branches that emerge from the cannabis plant's main stem. The shorter these internode lengths are, the more compact a plant will be. This, in turn, equals more plant growth proportionate to the same amount of root growth. Keeping internode lengths shorter is also important because it allows plants to develop more efficiently so that their yields can be maximized.

For indoor growers, it's important to remember that a grow light's intensity decreases by half for every foot it's moved away from the plants. Having taller plants in your indoor garden means that the light source must be hung higher, resulting in the lower parts of your plants getting much less light. Additionally, the taller a plant grows, the more energy it must expend developing a thicker, longer stem and transporting nutrients throughout the plant. This is energy that could be better used developing bigger flowers (yield) and more trichomes (potency).

In terms of spacing, smaller, squatter plants can be placed closer together, thereby allowing growers to fit more plants in a limited space. Conversely, taller plants cast more shade on their neighbors and create the need for more space between plants.

Finally, if you plan to supplement your garden with carbon dioxide, you should keep in mind that  $CO_2$  is heavier than air and naturally sinks to lower levels in the growroom. Thus, growing taller plants indoors makes it harder to supply them with adequate  $CO_2$ .


#### **Controlling Internode Lengths**

There are three main non-chemical methods that let growers control their plants' internode lengths and keep their gardens short and efficient. The first involves simply positioning your grow lamps as close to the garden canopy as possible. This is because plants use extreme red light (760 to 800 nm) as a barometer for being overtaken by neighbor plants. The far red end of the spectrum is also the only wavelength of light that penetrates foliage easily-so when a lamp is placed too high above the garden and only this red light makes it down to the plant, its far red phytochrome is activated, sending the "stretching" signal to the rest of the plant so that it begins growing taller in search of normal light. This is also a reason why it's preferable

to use metal halide (MH) bulbs during a plant's vegetative phase, since the heavier white/blue spectrum enables a plant to grow squat, with shorter internode lengths.

Another method to keep plant height down is to use fans in the garden or gently shake plants a few times a day. This creates vibrations that disrupt the elongation of cells and causes plants to thicken their stem walls instead.

Temperature is the final method by which plant internode lengths can be kept short, specifically by using what's known as "negative differential" in daytime and nighttime temps. Plants in rooms with slightly warmer temperatures during the dark cycle have been shown to grow much more compactly. Of course, this is a bit tricky to achieve, as the room is often warmer during the light cycle due to heat from the lamps. However, some growers achieve "neg dif" by turning off any air conditioning during the dark cycle, or by using a space heater near the garden. 🖗

A few top growers in California recently stabilized the strain, and its popularity has been growing steadily around the country. Keep

an eye out for this beauty, as these days she may be right around the corner.





#### SUBJECT: Does Size Matter? FROM Michael R.

№ I just bought a fivepack of seeds, and one seed in there was three times the size of the others. Is it like puppies, where the one with the biggest paws gets to be the big dog? Also, Danny, I'm 54 years old and very sick. I need to know what strains would most help me with lack of appetite? I need a supermunchie strain that is readily available. Thank you for all your advice over the years!

#### Dear Michael,

The size of the seed doesn't directly affect the size of the plant. It's curious, though, that one would look so different from the rest. I would keep a close eye on all of the plants as you grow them out, because it seems a bit suspect for there to be that much variation among seeds. As far as strains that help with lack of appetite or nausea, I always recommend sativa-dominant varieties such as Trainwreck, Super Lemon Haze and Island Sweet Skunk; however, some indica-dominant strains can also bring on the munchies, including Kosher Kush, Tahoe OG or Ogre. Hope that gives you enough to choose from, and best wishes for a speedy recovery!

SUBJECT: Window Weed FROM: Corey 

Ny buddy and I were wondering how much pot a plant grown in a window will yield? I can't really afford fancy grow lights or air conditioning, so I'd like to know if it's worth my time just to crack some beans and let them grow out like houseplants.

#### Dear Corey,

It's possible to grow buds on your windowsill, but there's a number of factors that will determine how much you'll yield. First, the window should be southern-facing and get full sunlight for as many hours of the day as possible; otherwise, your plant will be spindly and won't yield much at all. Also, you need to be sure that the window itself is clean (as well as not tinted). Apart from those considerations, plants on a windowsill

indoors can dry out very quickly, so be sure to keep them well watered. You shouldn't expect a massive yield, but it's quite possible to grow buds this wayand it's also a great way to get started without having to invest too much on equipment. Nothing beats the experience you gain when you're actually cultivating cannabis yourself, so get growing today!

#### SUBJECT: Seeds and Herms FROM: Nasty Nass

🚵 So I started five seeds indoors that I purchased last year from a seed bank I'd heard about, thinking that I was getting feminized seeds, but it seems they were actually chosen at random. In the beginning, I ran my lights 24 hours a day, but in preparation for the plants' transition to outdoors, I changed the lights to 18/6

for the last month or so. All of a sudden, one of the five started showing signs of being male, although the others haven't. My question for you: Is it safe to assume that the rest are female? Or did I stress the plants by changing the light schedule and cause a hermaphrodite myself?

#### Dear Nass,

It's not clear from your letter where you ordered the seeds, but it's never safe to assume that your plants will be female (particularly since, in this case, at least one seems to have turned out male). But it's doubtful that switching your light cycle from 24 hours on to 18/6 on/off would have caused a female plant to turn male, so you should carefully monitor the other seedlings for any signs of male flowers or hermaphroditism. And in the future, be sure to order from reputable seed companies-though even then, you should always keep an eye on your plants during the first few weeks of flowering.

#### SUBJECT: My Pot's Too Big! FROM: Mario A.

My question concerns starting seeds in larger containers. I tried this once but ran into problems with overwatering, and then the container took a long time to dry out, which led to some mold. How do I manage water levels when starting seeds in large containers, and what's the best way to handle the runoff? Or do you avoid watering to runoff until the plant is bigger-and, if so, for how long, and does salt buildup then become an issue?

#### Dear Mario,

When growing seedlings in large containers, it's important not to overwater them. The problems you're describing are all due to having too much water in your growing medium. Because the seedlings' roots are so short, you should take care to water only the layers of mix in which they're prevalent. Watering from below is a great way to get young roots to stretch and seek out water, resulting in more vigorous growth up top. But you certainly shouldn't be watering to runoff that early in your plant's life.

Also, as they grow bigger, never allow your plants to sit in stagnant runoff water. You may experience a little salt buildup, but once the taproot has

reached the bottom of your container, you can start watering to runoff in order to leach some of those salts from your medium. Another way to avoid salt buildup early on is to feed your plants at one-quarter to one-half the strength recommended on the nutrient bottle. Underfeeding is much easier to fix than overfeeding.

You can always start your plants in smaller containers and transplant them as they grow-just be sure they don't become too root-bound prior to the transplant. Also, be gentle when removing the root-ball, placing it into its new container and backfilling with extra soil. The roots will recover much more quickly if you take care not to disturb them too much.

#### SUBJECT: Grow for Life FROM: **T.**

I lost the lower half of my body to an IED (improvised explosive) device) in the war. I retired after 22 years of active service and 15 vears in the reserves. I was/am an explosive-ordnance disposal or EOD tech (Navy), rank of senior chief petty officer. Weed is about the only thing that helps me with the pain and spasms. I take a total of 36 different pills a day, and I hate the side effects from all those meds. Is it easier to grow my own? Tennessee has no med-potmost think it's still the '60s here. Can you give me any help on what I need to get started? Going to another state is impossible: I can't ride in a car over 30 minutes or I start having spasms and increased pain. I'm stuck in a hole, trying to crawl out.

#### Dear T.,

It's heartbreaking to read your story. Even sadder is that I often hear versions of this tragic tale from other veterans. It's disgraceful that, as a country, we can send you off to war and then not allow you to alleviate your pain in any way that helps. Thank you for your enormous sacrifice on behalf of us all, and know that we're working to ensure that you and others like you won't have to continue to suffer forever.

It's difficult for me to recommend that you grow your own in Tennessee, where the penalties for cultivation are harsh. At the NORML.org site, I see that even growing less than 10 plants can lead to a felony conviction and one to six years in prison. If there's anything you can do to get to a more forgiving state,





such as Colorado—to which I found one-way flights from Tennessee that were under \$100 and just over two hours—please do. I know of many "reefer refugees" who have made it to the promised land, and all are much better off now.

Having said that, if you still wish to grow where you are, buy yourself a good grow guide (such as *Marijuana Horticulture: The Indoor/Outdoor Medical Grower's Bible* by Jorge Cervantes), keep on read-

ing *High Times* and checking out our website, and listen to my podcast *Free Weed* for abundant information to get you started. You'll likely find that growing your own medicine can be fun and rewarding. Just be sure not to tell anyone about it that doesn't need to know.

You'll also need a space to grow, and I recommend getting a grow tent. You'll need a grow light as well, and for beginners, I think a 400-watt high-pressure sodium (HPS) fixture, ballast and bulb are the most appropriate. Next you'll need seeds or clones, which can be difficult to obtain but certainly not impossible. You can purchase a pack of seeds online and then start a mother plant of your own from those seeds. That way, you won't have to rely on buying seeds every time you want to grow.

#### SUBJECT: Managing Pests FROM: Alexander in PA

My wife and I have been growing outdoors, but we're looking into grow boxes now. Outdoors, we've been experiencing some insect problems (mostly mites). If you're able, please give me a better understanding on how to use tobacco-leaf tea as an organic pesticide (i.e., the amounts to be sprayed and the preferred concentration), or whether I should be using it in the first place.

#### Dear Alexander,

I don't generally recommend tobacco-leaf tea because nicotine, the main active ingredient, while effective as a pesticide, is also highly toxic—so it's just not something I want soaked onto my plants. Neem oil is much less toxic and very effective when used as part of an integrated pest management (IPM) system. This involves attacking your infestations with a variety of organic methods; you can liken it to targeting different muscle groups with physical workouts. It's always best to switch up your techniques, because pests can build up tolerances if you use only one thing against them.

You should find that you have less pest issues in a grow box than you did outdoors. Plants inside are much less likely to get bugs—but if they do, those bugs have no natural predators, so infestations can happen fast. That's why you should inspect the undersides of your leaves and the stems of your plants frequently. &



What's the word on alcohol versus marijuana in teens?

#### Hi Twit,

The research of Joseph Palamar, a professor of behavior medicine at New York University, revealed that teen marijuana users were more likely to report no negative consequences than those who pounded brews. Nevertheless, neither the plant nor the alcohol was harmless for everybody. Marijuana tended to lead to more trouble with authority figures like teachers and supervisors. Alcohol was more likely to generate regretful behavior (especially in females) and dangerous driving.

Can black pepper really keep paranoia to a minimum? Gordon Ramses

#### Hi Gordon,

Pepper in huge doses contains terpenoids, some of which might contribute to the cannabis experience. Myrcene, one of the pepper terpenoids, seems to contribute to "couchlock," i.e., sedation. CBD is probably a better blocker of paranoia. Of course, nothing beats toking in a fun, safe environment with reassuring friends and pleasant things to do.

My campus is plastered with posters stating how many people drink alcohol, but there's never anything about cannabis. What gives?

Hi Moe,

These "social norm" campaigns rely on one idea: Students who drink a lot tend to think that everyone does it. Once they realize that most students don't drink as much, they drink less too.

By contrast, cannabis users don't seem to care what other people do. When they learn how few people on campus actually commune with the plant, it has little impact on how often they use. In addition, many school administrators don't want big posters lining the halls if they suggest that *any* students are breaking the law.



## **The Great Extract Debate**

Solvent or solventless? Boiling down the dispute as to which method produces the cleanest, most dab-worthy concentrates. *By Joshua Shipman* 



rganic and veganic methods of growing cannabis have taken over the cultivation industry. Producers as well as consumers have begun to see that force-feeding synthetic chemicals to our plants is not a sustainable or healthy way of approaching medicinal production.

Not a lot of industries have the sense of ethics that the cannabis industry is now promoting. This strict adherence to the notion of doing what is right has led me to examine solvent-extracted concentrates with a more critical eye.

On one side of this debate are the organic purists, who argue that the only clean extraction methods are those that leave absolutely no residual chemicals in the final product—i.e., 0 ppm. These concentrates are either water- or  $CO_2$ extracted; therefore, they have the possibility of leaving only a small amount of  $H_2O$  in the finished product.

When ice hash is produced correctly, it's a beautiful, even artistic process to watch, and it results in an even more beautiful product to taste. I find that the terpenes in well-made ice hash are stronger and cleaner-tasting than in most butane hash oil. However, the yields are small compared with BHO production.

On the other side of the debate

are those more focused on the commercial and production value of BHO. The yields are incredibly high, inferior products can be refined, and the entire process is somewhat easier than producing high-quality ice hash.

I have never seen a test result for BHO that showed less than 10 ppm of residual chemicals. However, BHO producers would argue that our polluted environment is far unhealthier to inhale—not to mention what you take in every time you hold a butane lighter to a pipe.

In my company's retail shop, we carry both BHO and ice hash because consumers demand both. While we're strictly organic growers, there is such a demand for BHO that if we removed it from our shelves, we wouldn't be able to compete with the other retailers.

We've seen both nicely and poorly extracted BHO as well as ice hash. And so I've come to conclude that by embracing both methods, you embrace two different sides of an industry that takes art and science very seriously. This debate will only drive the production of clean concentrates even further, regardless of what method is being used.  $\checkmark$

"Oh!" she said with a relieved smile.


I was hoping he'd offer me a hit, or at least hold it up for the photo, but no such luck. And despite his outward civility, I could tell he was ready for us to go.

## **High History**

A major American university archives the cannabis movement for posterity.

his past September, the University of Massachusetts at Amherst held a weekend event to publicly acknowledge the acceptance of NORML's archives, which cover the organization's 44 years of fighting to reform marijuana laws, and which will become part of the world's first drug-policy reform archive housed at a major state-run university.

In 2012, archivists at UMass, observing the watershed changes in American culture and politics regarding marijuana legalization, contacted NORML and expressed interest in acquiring the organization's massive collection of cannabis-related information. Included in NORML's archives are scientific and medical reports; thousands of letters from busted and/or incarcerated cannabis consumers; testimonials from medical patients extolling the utility and safety of cannabis as a therapeutic; and hemp-related agronomical and botanical reports. Also included are legislative strategy papers and communications, political opposition research, litigation and legal documents, fundraising materials, exchanges with media and opinion-makers, and internal communications (sometimes relating to strife and disputes between staffers, or between the NORML staff and board, or between NORML and other drug-policy reform organizations-as the archivists call it, "the good stuff").



Over the course of two years, tens of thousands of pounds of original documents created since the organization's birth in 1970, plus thousands of photographs, miles of videotape, and loads of really cool cannabis-related memorabilia and ephemera (from NORML and other cannabis-law reform events nationwide) have been painstakingly conveyed to the W.E.B. Du Bois Library at Amherst.

To date, the UMass Drug Policy Reform Archive has been fortunate to receive the personal papers of NORML founder Keith Stroup; Dr. Lester Grinspoon, the pioneering Harvard Medical School professor and author; and Melanie Dreher, the anthropologist and health expert who researched Jamaican cannabis use and culture. The papers of Richard Evans, the longtime Massachusetts cannabis-law reform advocate, and myself are also included. MassCANN, the organizers of the annual Boston Freedom Allen St. Pierre is the executive director of NORML. Visit norml.org

Rally, donated its own extensive archive covering more than 25 years of activism to the state's flagship university as well. And UMass archivists (and NORML) were overjoyed to learn that *High Times* will also be making a significant donation of some of its unique archives.

In time, this collection will become an open multimedia archive available to scholars, authors, reporters and policymakers from around the world who want to understand precisely how groups of dedicated citizens moved this country from fully embracing cannabis prohibition to soundly rejecting it. (When NORML was founded in 1970, approximately 12 percent of Americans supported legalizing marijuana; today, Gallup polling shows that 58 percent want to see prohibition end.)

NORML's staff continues to work with the university's dedicated archivists and graduate students to procure the materials of other notable individuals, organizations and businesses that have made major contributions to educating the public-and pushed the cultural boundaries as well-in the quest to end cannabis prohibition. 💥
