



NOTE REGARDING GENERAL JOSEPH MARTIN WHO WAS THE HUSBAND OF NANCY WARD'S DAUGHTER BETSY;

"John Stuart was stationed at FORT LOUDOUN (Tennessee) as Captain of a British company in 1757. The Fort was besieded and captured by the War Chief OGONOSTOTA 8-7-1760. Nearly all of the Garrison was killed, but Captain Stuart was rescued and taken to Virginia by the Civil Chief ATTACULLACULLA (He was the uncle of Nancy Ward) Stuart was later appointed Superintendent of Indian Affairs South of the Ohio River and Married Susannah Enory and their only child was always known as Oonodutee or Bushyhead and this name has clung to his descendants --Captain Stuart was known to his cherokee acquaintances as Oonodutu on acc account of his shock of blond hair. He died at Pencacola Florida 2-21 1779. Susannah 's second husband was RICHARD FIELDS an Englishman and her Third (3RD) Husband was

BRIGADIER GENERAL JOSEPH MARTIN WHO HAD THE RARE DISTINCTION OF SIMULTANEOUSLY BEARING COMMISSION TO THIS RANK IN THE MILITIA OF VIRGINIA AND NORTH CAROLINA.

Your favor of the 13 instant in which you ask for information received in regard to No 3005 (not 3009) (this may be a different case)

Ans. to quest No 1, yes I had a cousin by name of John Hildebrand, yes he was a son of MICHAEL my uncle. I cant give the date of his birth. Yes he died 1838.

Ans. to quest No 2. I cant say whether John Hildebrand and Nisa Russell was married or not they lived together for a time and she had one child by him, ELVIRA. Ans to quest No 3 As babove stated Nisa only had one child by JOHN HILDEBRAND and they parted. I dont know whether this child was enrolled or not. Ques to quest, 4. I had a 2nd cousin by name of Michael Hildebrand, he was a son of Joe Hildebrand. He went from from here to the territory with his grand father MICHAEL HILDEBRAND SR. and died there before he reached manhood, and he was enrolled in 1851. Ans to quest 5. None of John Hildebrand's children lived with Michael Hildebrand, my uncle.

Nisa Russell had several children after her and John Hildebrand parted. When can we expect to get money from the Cherokee fund. If there is anything for us we would like to have some idea as to when to expect it. (s) John W.Hildebrand.
