NOTE REGARDING GENERAL JOSEPH MARTIN WHO WAS THE HUSBAND OF  
NANCY WARD'S DAUGHTER BETSY;

"JOHN STUART WAS STATIONED AT FORT LOUDOUN (TENNESSEE) AS CAPTAIN OF A  
BRITISH COMPANY IN 1757. THE FORT WAS BESIEGED AND  
CAPTURED BY THE WAR CHIEF OGNOSTOTA 8-7-1760. NEARLY ALL OF THE  
GARRISON WAS KILLED, BUT CAPTAIN STUART WAS RESCUED AND TAKEN TO VIRGINIA  
BY THE CIVIL CHIEF ATTACULLACULLA (HE WAS THE UNCLE OF NANCY WARD)  
STUART WAS LATER APPOINTED SUPERINTENDENT OF INDIAN AFFAIRS SOUTH OF THE  
OHIO RIVER AND MARRIED SUSANNAH EMORY AND THEIR ONLY CHILD WAS ALWAYS  
KNOWN AS OONODUTEE OR BUSHYHEAD AND THIS NAME HAS CLUNG TO HIS DESCENDANTS  
--CAPTAIN STUART WAS KNOWN TO HIS CHEROKEE ACQUAINTANCES AS OONODUTU ON ACC  
ACCOUNT OF HIS SHOCK OF BLOND HAIR. HE DIED AT PENCACOLA FLORIDA 2-21  
1779. SUSANNAH 'S SECOND HUSBAND WAS RICHARD FIELDS  
AN ENGLISHMAN AND HER THIRD (3RD) HUSBAND WAS

BRIGADIER GENERAL JOSEPH MARTIN WHO HAD THE RARE DISTINCTION  
OF SIMULTANEOUSLY BEARING COMMISSION TO THIS RANK IN THE MILITIA  
OF VIRGINIA AND NORTH CAROLINA.

APPLICATION OF JOHN HILDEBRAND. Made application in Bradley county Tenn, at Cleveland, Born 1837 in POLK COUNTY TENNESSEE And claims right to share by my father John Hildebrand, but he died before 1851 and subsequent to 1833, having had his name listed for Cherokee Removal 1833 to 1840. He is married to Amanda Humbard, age about 67.

His father was John Hildebrand, and his mother was NICE Russell, not indian.

~~My~~ Father was born in POLK COUNTY TENN ON HIWASSEE RIVER AND MOTHER WAS BORN IN SOUTH CAROLINA, not indian They resided 1851 ; - died prior to 1851 and after 1838 - 40? mother died at Cle. Tenn 1883, father probaly died near 1840.

Father was on list for removal and mother was paid by General Wool, U.S.A. at Newton Georgia, date unknown.

Your favor of the 13 instant in which you ask for information received in regard to No 3005 (not 3009) (this may be a different case)

Ans. to quest No 1, yes I had a cousin by name of John Hildebrand, yes he was a son of MICHAEL my uncle. I cant give the date of his birth. Yes he died 1833.

Ans. to quest No 2. I cant say whether John Hildebrand and Nisa Russell was married or not they lived together for a time and she had one child by him, ELVIRA. Ans to quest No 3 As babove stated Nisa only had one child by JOHN HILDEBRAND and they parted. I dont know whether this child was enrolled or not. Ques to quest, 4. I had a 2nd cousin by name of Michael Hildebrand, he was a son of Joe Hildebrand. He went from from here to the territory with his grand father MICHAEL HILDEBRAND SR. and died there before he reached manhood, and he was enrolled in 1851. Ans to quest 5. None of John Hildebrand's children lived with Michael Hildebrand, my uncle.

Nisa Russell had several children after her and John Hildebrand parted. When can we expect to get money from the Cherokee fund. If there is anything for us we would like to have some idea as to when to expect it. (s) John W.Hildebrand.

Hildebrand and she is not married. Her mother's maiden name was Eliza Jane White, her father was born here in this county when it was a territory. Her mother was born in Va. They resided 1851 in POLK County Tennessee, both resided 1851 Polk Co Tenn.

My father was Peter Hilderbrand (roll 1835) No. 7. My mother was ELIZABETH HARLAN, maiden name was Elizabeth Harlan. Father resided 1851 in the Indian territory west of the Mississippi river, mother was dead then.

Father died 1852, mother died 1826. My father was enrolled here but the removal of the Cherokee but cant give date.

I WAS A COUNCILMAN IN NORTH CAROLINA, IN 1875 OR 1876 WITH THE CHEROKEES. I WENT TO WASHINGTON DC 1876. I THINK AS A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE CHEROKEES. I VISITED MY FATHER AMONG THE CHEROKEE INDIANS.

who was my great great great Grandmother; - mother was daughter of

JOHN W. HILDERBRAND, who was a son of

ELIZABETH HILDERBRAND was a daughter of KATIE HARLAND

who was a daughter of NANCY WARD, - cherokee

That my father's name was J. C. Hannah; that my mother's name is Mary Hildebrand, that she was married to my father 1863; that they have since resided at Benton, - Cleveland and Chattanooga, Tenn.
