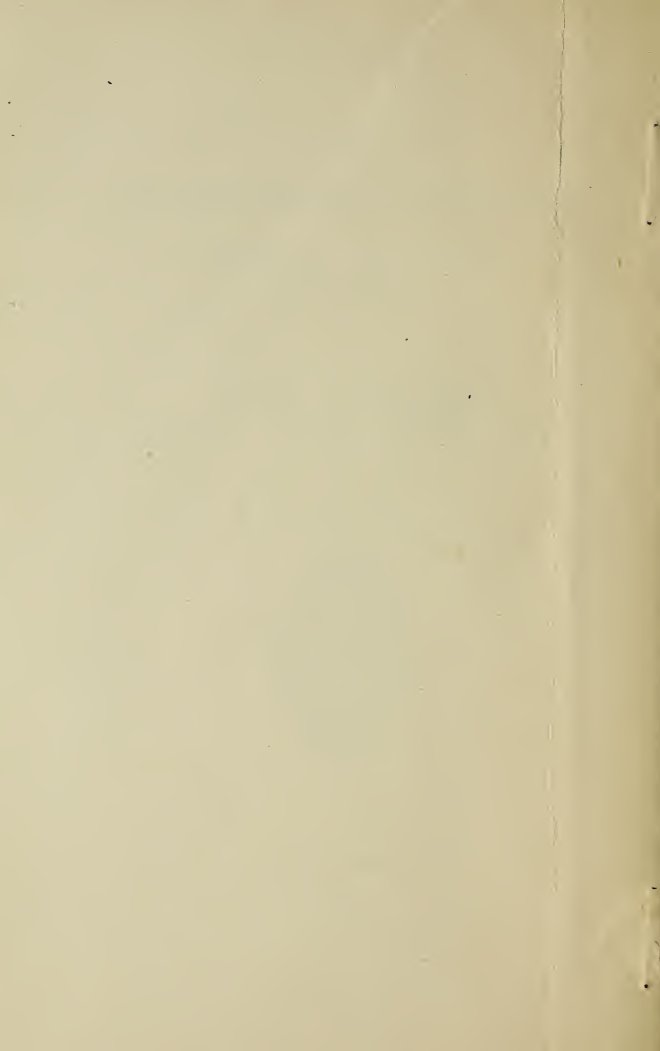

HOLIDAY BOOKS FOR BOYS AND GIRLS

THIS list has been prepared to meet the many requests for suggestions of children's books as holiday gifts.

The selection includes old favorites in new editions and such new titles as seem worthy of a special place in a child's own library. The make-up of the book has been very carefully considered in determining the selection, and preference has been given to editions with the best illustrations, the clearest type, and the most attractive book covers.

As the list of "Vacation reading for boys and girls" includes camping and woodcraft, out-door and indoor games and sports, gardening, animal stories, handicraft, etc., these subjects are omitted from the holiday list.

Copies of the vacation reading list may be had on request and the appropriate books listed therein will be included in the exhibit of children's books to be shown in the central children's room during the month of December.

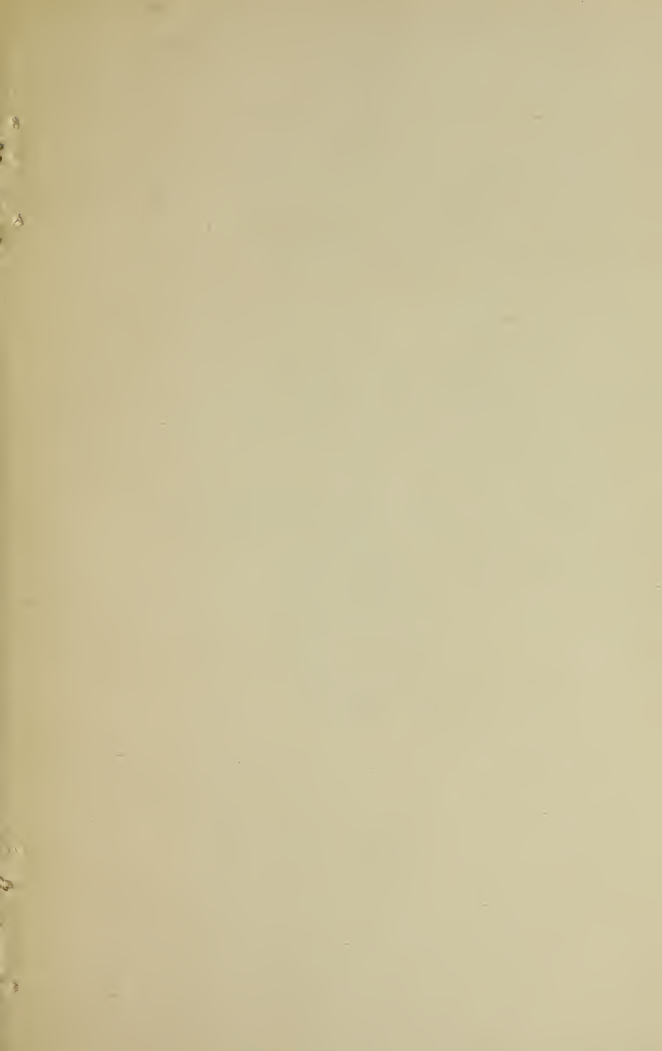
