the earliest, by the middle of next year. The marke is changing so quickly and it is the markerplace which will dictate what we offer."
The Vectrex games player, costing 5130, has a Sin upright monochrome screen and a delachable joystick unit with fire buttons.

The protolype keyboard is designed so the games unia stands on top. Although a price has not been decided, it would have to be compelitive with complete home computers.
Milton Bradley says its Vectrex monitor gives a sharper, faster moving image, using less computing power because it uses the vector scan technique instead of the raster scan used by domestic TVs.
Raster scan refreshes the whole screen every one-filtieth of a second. Vector scan creates only the image required - building it up with lines - without scanning the whole screen.
Vectrex accepis only cartridges and there are also screen overlays to add colour.

## Why <br> programs need a seal of approval

Microcomputers, we are constantly being told, will bring about a nevolution in the classroom.

A prenequisite of this revolution will be the ready availability of top quality software, fully documented and error Irapped and free from bugs.

Anyone who takes the trouble to read the soffware reviews in this and other magazines will know that there is nor, at present, a greal deal of educational software available, and a good proportion of what there is at best of dubious educational benefit.

In the short time I have been involved in soft ware retailing, it has become transparently clear to me that parents of children who use micros at school or at home are crying out for some decent software to lure sheir children away from Space Invaders and the like.

At the moment there is no way for them to check the quality of the software that they are thinking of buying funless they cw oul all the reviews and file them away for future reference).

It would therefore seem like a very good idea to have some sort of universal standard by which educational software can be measured.

Having given the subject a great deal of thought I have come up with the following ideas:
1 That representatives of the microcomputing industry (particularly from the software side) approach the Department of education with a view to serting up a joint panel of teachers and programmers to identify the areas in which microcomputers can be most beneficial.
2 Having identified those areas, produce a sel of guidelines for aspiring soff ware authors in order to achieve some uniformity of presentation.
3 Anyone wanting their soffware to carry Department of Education approval would have to submis their programs to the panel and carry out any changes that the panel decide are necessary. Then, and only then, would authors be allowed to advertise their programs as "approved educational software."

It is my belief that the availability of soft ware carrying such approval would encourage parents who are contemplating buying their childrent a micro to go ahead with the purchase, secure in the knowledge Ihat it will help them to learn as well as giving them many hours of entertainment.

Obviously a great deal of discussion would need to take place befone my ideas could be put in to practice but it is essential that some sort of debate should start now if our children are to reap the rewards that the microcomputer offers.

Ifhank thas is one of the funntest cases of the left hand nor knowing What she righs hand is doung - computer dept, handware division. I hope humour does not give way so tragedy.

Recently there has been much hoo-ha about the use of portable computers aboard planes. Apparently some of these guys are thought to be cousing or contributing to problems with arpolane navigation and communcations equpment.

Some portables are being banned from use on some aurines; atf porrobles are being banned on others. The Federal Awation Acsoctation (FAA) is now looking into these issues. The ussue is certanly not much ado over nothtng; the Federal Communicatons Commestion, which lextsores the allowable nadared emsssions from computers, set a Class B interference standard which is very close to the level of signals used in navigaron

Even lests done by the Canadath Department of Transport revealed that an electronc catcuiator interfered wish the novigation system of a heficopter when held in close proxamity to it fcomputers generate more inserference than calculators). The whole istue is now under in vestrgation.

Meanwhile up in Canada, Canadian Pacy/ic Asr, of Vant couver, Britsh Columbsa, has slarted instaliation of Inay size selfconsamed video games on board frights between Vancowver and Amsterdam. The big diffenence, however, is that the games use liquid crystad displays and not video display unts, which alone conthbute greaty to radiared interference. And the unts use very hitie power, which atoo tends to hmit the distonce ony interference may be radaated

One of the unts used underwent a rigorous study conducted by an independent reseanch agency. The 15-page report gave the unt, called Aurplay, a clean bill of health Even so, plans are underway to introduce more versatile, and therefore more powerful, onboand unus.

Back in 1981 when the ZX81 had just been hatched, software standards were generally pretty low Once exception to this rule was a program called 3D Monster Maze, which has been a firm favourte with ZX 81 owners sunce t first appeared in November 1981
Monster Maze was, according to tts creator Malcolm Evans, the first-ever true 3D game for the 2X81. As you travel along the passages of the maze, they appear on the screen as you would see them in real life- and every now and then an ommous speck at the end of a long comdor, getimg larger and larger every second, warns you that you'reabout to be eaten if you don't escape from the monster quickly.

Even now the $2 \times 81$ has been overshadowed by more sophisucated home computers, the graphies on Monster Maze still look good. To Malcolm Fvans, programming wathan the limutions of machines like the ZX81 is a challenge. "My am is always to come up with something completely differem", he sard. "None of my garnes are direct copies of arcade games,
Malcolm now runs New Generation Sofiware, but when he wrole Monster Maze, he was working full tume for the microprocessor applications group at Spery Lmac. He 100k up ZX81 programming as a hobby, after his wife Linda bougin him a ZX81 for burthday surprise
The brthday surprise turned out to be more useful than Linda had imagined. A couple of weeks after Maicolm had his first big order for Monster Maze from 5 muths, the was made redundant from Spersy, and went into home computer software full tume.
Compared to his work al Sperry, he finds games program* mung "very relaxing and enjoyable. Trivyal? It depends on how you look al it I approach 11 from the point of view of pushing the machune to its tumats. My IK version of Breakout for the ZX8: was orgmaily an exercise to see how much could be done in 1K The people at Smiths couldn't believe tt."
At first, Malcolm was a partner in J. K. Gireye soffware Then last Seprember he formed New Generallon, Why New Gencration? "Well, it's mank the new generation buying sofiware, isn't it ${ }^{\prime \prime \prime}$, Malcolm explaned

Until last June, Malcolm ran the company alone, as well as doung all the programmung, with some help from hus wfe. Then his brother Rod, "the famsly busimess expert", jouned hm and took over the commercial side.

# Writing for the new generation 

> A birthday present and a redundancy started Malcolm Evans of New Ceneration on a new career. Candice Goodwin found out how he lost a joband gained a software bempany


Malcolm says he used to spend seven hours a day runnong and bustness, and seven hours programmung, but finds that "now I spend all 14 hours programmong

It doesn't seem to have given me any more free tme. The programs aren't coming out any faster, ether, but they're getting more complex. After all, II don'i want to produce somerhung that computer owners could write for themselves."
He has writen all seven of New Generation's programs, three for
the $\mathrm{Z} \times 81$ and four for the Spectrum, and each has taken himt two to four months. In each new game, he tries to use new programming techniques, bulding on methods used in previous games
"For example, I took the concept of the train that you see in 3D Tunnel and developed it in my larest program, Gemon"*, he said "I partuluarly lake 3D effects they bring the player into the game '

Like Monster Maze, Genon is a maze game, but with circular corridors and doors that open and close. The am is to get into the centre and crack the code set by a hostile computer, hell-bent on stopping you. On the way, you're chased by a monster called Bogul "who does the most revolting things to you if he catches up with you."

Then when you do manage to break the code, you have to get out agann - but now Bogul has cloned

Malcolm is now writng exclusively for the Spectrum, partly because it's such a big markel each of his Spectrum programs has sold 30,000 copies - and parily because distributors will no longer take $2 \times 81$ sofiware. But he says: "l almost prefer the ZX81 to the Spectrum, because II's mare flexible
"You can do ihings, bike swilching screens by using display files, that you can't do with the Spectrum, and 1 haven't found that the Spectrum has any major advantages to make up for the disadvantages. From the programmer's point of vew, colour and sound are just two more things to worry about."
He actually wrotes his program not on a Spectrum or a ZX81 but on a Sharp MZROB, because of its large ( 64 K ) memory, good eduor and assemblet, and fast disc system. "If I run the program and it crashes, I don't have 10 wat for ages to reload it from tape", he sald.

Malcolm finds that, despite the long hours he puls into programming, hfe is a lot easier now than in the early days of the busmess, when he had to deal wath mat order as well as everything else "Oar turnover's doubling every month now, and we're doing less than we used to, ${ }^{11}$ he grms.

By using distributors, he doesn't even have to negotiate with shops - and now he finds his programs turning up in some unexpected places. "Would you beleve it, I recently saw our programs on sale in Carrefour."

He sees the danger that distributors may start to call the tune in terms of both prices and grogram content, but reckons, "the important theng is to ge into as many distributors as possible, and create a demand for your product. People go into shaps and ask for games, and it gels back to the distributors, ${ }^{3 \prime}$

Another reason why the pressure is easing is a recent move to a 100 -year-old house at $15 \mathrm{Sun}-$ nybank, Lyncomb Vale, Bath ln the grounds of the house is a coachhouse that Malcolm's had renovaled for use as an office. "It's a lot better, he says. "Now 1 can just roll out of bed and straight ento work."
