

## Homemade Diapers

Take the scissors and cut the milk gallon in half, leaving the handle in place. It should look like this~

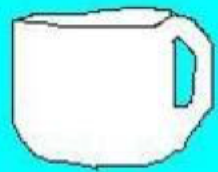

Now, carefully cut holes in the base of milk container, leaving ample room for babie's legs, like so:

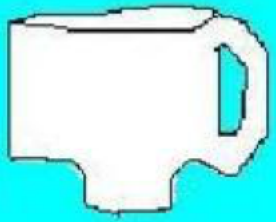
