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HOWES ANCESTRY.

The English records of the family date from John de Huse, of Berkshire, in 1066, the year of the Norman conquest, to John Howys, in 1457, at Bestthorp, in Norfolk. Robert—1508, Richard—15—, Thomas—1555, James—1592, Robert—1618. John Howse, who died in 1663, having served as Sheriff of Norfolk county, changed the spelling to Howes, which is still retained by the heirs of Morningthorpe.

Thomas, the third son of Robert was the father of Thomas who was born in 1590, and who in 1635-6, with his wife Mary Burr, came to America. Having spent 1637-8 in Salem, they settled in that part of Yarmouth which is now Dennis, on Cape Cod.

It has been estimated that from this pair there are now 5,000 descendants in the United States.

For the foregoing, and for the early records of the American family I am indebted to the recent admirable work of Joshua C. Howes of Dennis, Mass.*

JOHN, No. 36, of (6) generation is the central person of these records. Those which precede are simply to show his ancestry, and following him is a full record of his descendants.

We find him in early life in Tolland, Ct. Thence he removed to Cambridge, Washington Co., N. Y., where he had a family of nine children. From Cambridge, he removed about 1810 to Madison, Madison Co., N. Y., and settled on the "Dix" farm. The old house upon the hill was for many years the Mecca of the family and kin, till it gave place to the house which still remains.

Cena found her home about a mile at the south; Sally and John went to Monroe Co., Heman and Elijah occupied farms about a half mile at the north-east of the old home where Leonard remained, Clara lived on the west road between Madison and Hamilton villages, and Orrin, after a sickness of nine or more years died of consumption.

In these records each member of the family is assigned a number, for convenience of reference. To trace from individuals to their families, find their numbers on the left hand margin, then turn on till the same number is found again and in the middle of the page. To trace backward reverse the process. C. stands for child or children, b. is for born, m. married and d. died. The number of the American generation is included in a (). Dates of death are after the dates of birth in the family records, and the P. O. addresses of the living are in the same records next after their names.
