PARKING PRIVILEGES

There are two forms of identification used for persons with disabilities parking: parking placards and Disability License Plates.

Parking placards are available free to persons with permanent or temporary disabilities.

Disability License Plates are available to any person who has a permanent disability. These plates may be purchased at the cost of standard license plates for vehicles titled in his or her name.

Disabled veterans may obtain special Disabled Veteran Plates if their disabilities are 100 percent service-related.

INSURANCE DISCOUNT

Discounts on liability insurance premiums are available to eligible drivers age 55 and over upon successful completion of an Automobile Insurance Discount Program approved by the Secretary of State's office.

PHOTO ID PROGRAM

An official Illinois photo ID card may be obtained through the Secretary of State's office. The free non-expiring ID card is available to persons age 65 and over and to persons with disabilities. The card may be obtained at any Driver Services facility or mobile photo ID unit throughout the state.

RULES OF THE ROAD COURSE

A free Rules of the Road Review Course is offered statewide to people taking the driver's license examination.

Veterans' organizations are encouraged to sponsor these classes for members and their families. Contact the Senior & Community Services Department to locate a course in your area.
