

Winsor & Newton's Artists' Colors.

In the year 182, when WINSOR & NEWTON first established themselves as Artists' Colormen, the condition of the Artist, viewed from the more material aspects of his profession, was far from satisfactory. His choicest efforts, both in Oil and Water Color, were often, in so far as they depended on the maintenance of a scheme of color, doomed to a mere transitory existence; and instances were constantly being cited of the irretrievable ruin which had, in this respect, overtaken some celebrated picture. The cause of this state of things was happily not far to seek. Many substances were, at that time, employed as pigments, which from their essential fugacity should find no place on the palette of the Artist; and many others—really permanent in themselves—were rendered more or less fugitive for want of proper purification, or by being unskillfully prepared.

Then, again, there were many bad gaps in the palette of the day :--colors were needed, for lack of which the Artist was fettered in the expression of his ideas. There are, doubtless, many reasons which should induce a painter to "curb the liberal hand subservient proudly," as Raphael is reported to have done; but among these reasons absence of the proper colors cannot be held to constitute a legitimate item. Here, once more, was an opening for inventive enterprise.

The task, then, which WINSOR & NEWTON, in 1832, set themselves to accomplish, is not difficult to gather. Firstly, they endeavored, by the introduction of more permanent substitutes, to weed out many of the old colors. Secondly, by improved methods of preparation to enhance the brilliancy and permanence of the really good colors of the day. And, finally, by earnest research to invent such new colors as were then in urgent request.

From the outset WINSOR & NEWTON recognized that the era of *Chemistry* had arrived, and that it behooved them to abandon all old rule-of-thumb processes in favor of the more accurate and rigid methods of modern science. Following this principle, they had in 1844 progressed so rapidly as to be able to erect that perfectly-appointed Chemical Manufactory which was to form the nucleus of the present huge structure, known as the *North London Color Works:*—a fabric gradually built up in perfect adaptation to their particular requirements, and replete with every appliance for the manufacture and testing of colors that ingenuity can devise.


It is to this correct method of starting as *actual manufacturers of their own colors* that WINSOR & NEWTON, LIMITED, consider they owe the unprecedented success that has attended, and still attends, their venture. In laying stress on this point, they do not, of course, wish to assert that *all* the colors they sell are manufactured by themselves. There are, for instance, such colors as *Artificial Ultramarine*, the 'manufacture of which is an industry in itself, and which are 'made much more effectively, in the large continental factories specially devoted to the production of one particular color, than WINSOR & NEWTON, LIMITED, could ever hope to manufacture them.

It may be contended by those houses who make a practice of buying their pigments that there are other color makers quite as good as WINSOR & NEWTON, LIMITED, and that their own wares do not therefore necessarily suffer when placed in comparison. This, as a general proposition, and exclusive of certain specialties for which they are renowned, WINSOR & NEWTON, LIMITED, are ready to admit. But it is nevertheless true that in being their own makers they are in a better position to command the confidence of the Public. They are, in the first place, by knowing exactly what they are using, able to lguarantee the permanence and uniformity of their products in a manner quite impossible to those houses who buy elsewhere; and they are able further by their own manufacturing experience to much more efficiently gauge and value those materials of which they are themselves obliged to be buyers.

Looking back through a period of sixty years at the popularity which has been won by their colors—from the carly Madders, Lakes, Carmines, Genuine Ultramarines, Lemon Yellows, etc., down to the Cadmiums, Aureolins, Aurora Yellow, Alizarin Lakes, etc., of the present day—WINSOR & NEWTON, LIMITED, think it will be conceded that they have much reason to be proud of the measure of success which has been achieved in pursuance of those sound principles which were kept in view by the original founders. The Exhibition of 1851 first set the seal of public recognition on 'the efforts of the firm in the directions which have been indicated; and when in 1862 the Jurors of that Exhibition accompanied the bestowal of their medal by a specially awarded tribute* to the manufactures of WINSOR & NEWTON, and to the motives which actuated them, it was felt that the firm had at once stepped into that unique position which it has ever since been its good fortune to occupy. These awards find their counterparts to-day in those which have been recently conferred— ANTWERP in the Old World and CHICAGO in the New bearing accordant testimony that WINSOR & NEWTON, LIMITED, are still, as they were half a century ago, in the forefront of the times.


