## Grass Growing Vases.

These Vases were first introduced in I88.4, from Italy, where they have been quite popular as parlor ornaments for a number of years.

We have now on hand a large stock of these Vases in several unique shapes, which we mported from the originator along with the proper varlety of grass to grow on them.

IIRECTIONS.-Soak the vase in water $4 S$ hours; while wet sprinkle the seed on the outside, covering well such portions as you wish to grow; keep in a wain, moist atmosphere.

Always keep the vase filled with water. Care should be taken not to let the water fall on the seed. The seed can be forced by putting the vase undr glass, but the glass must be removed as soon as the seed hegins to sprout; then give it light and air, but licep it out of sun and draught.
