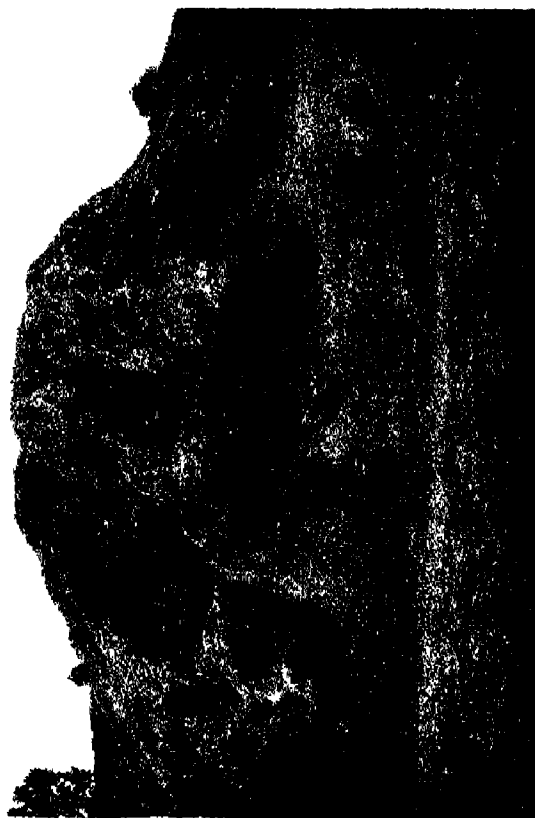

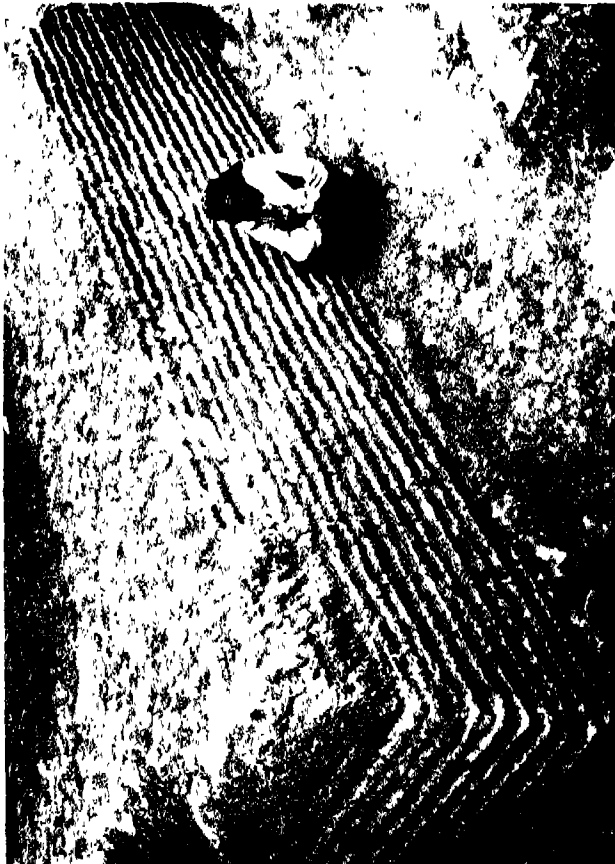

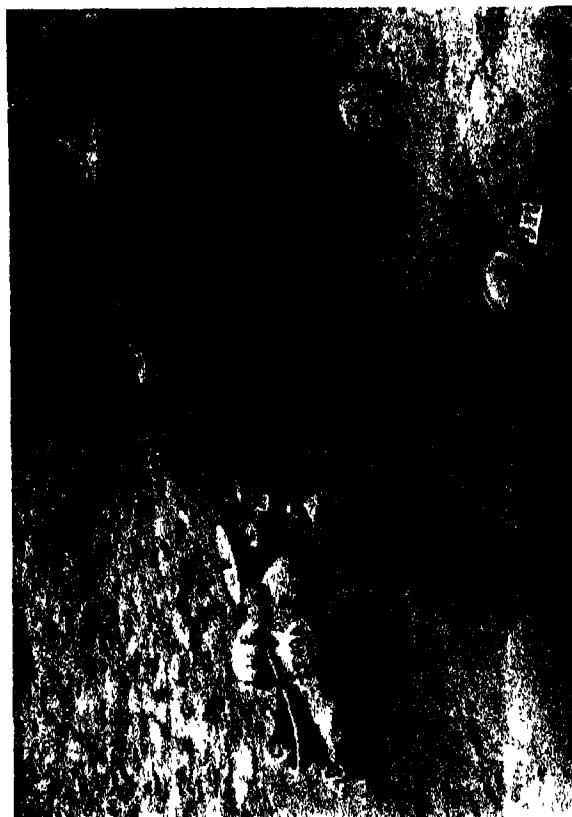

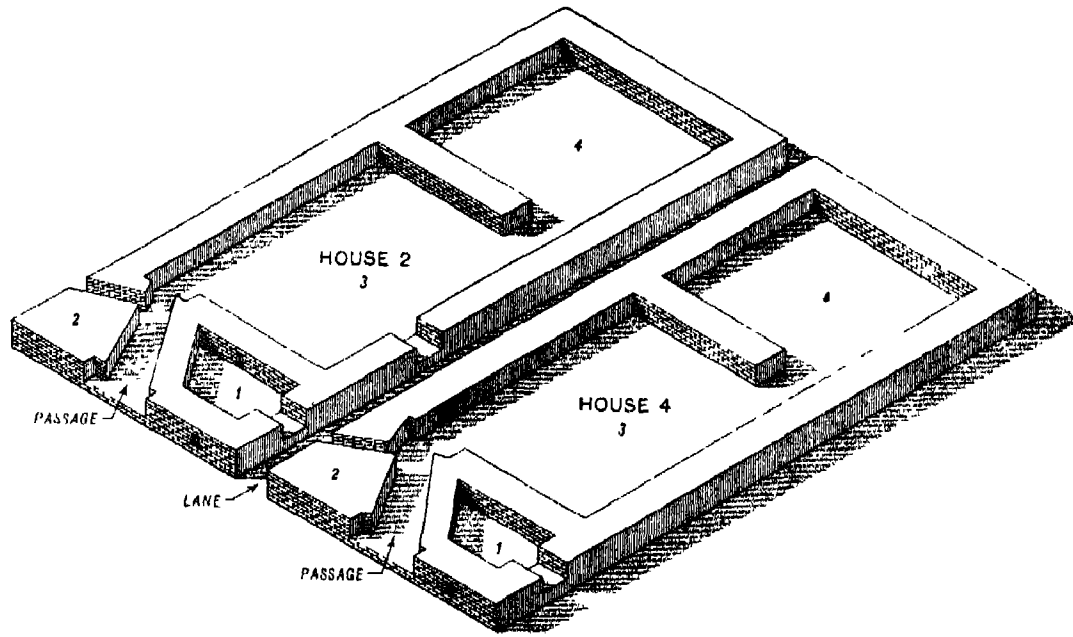

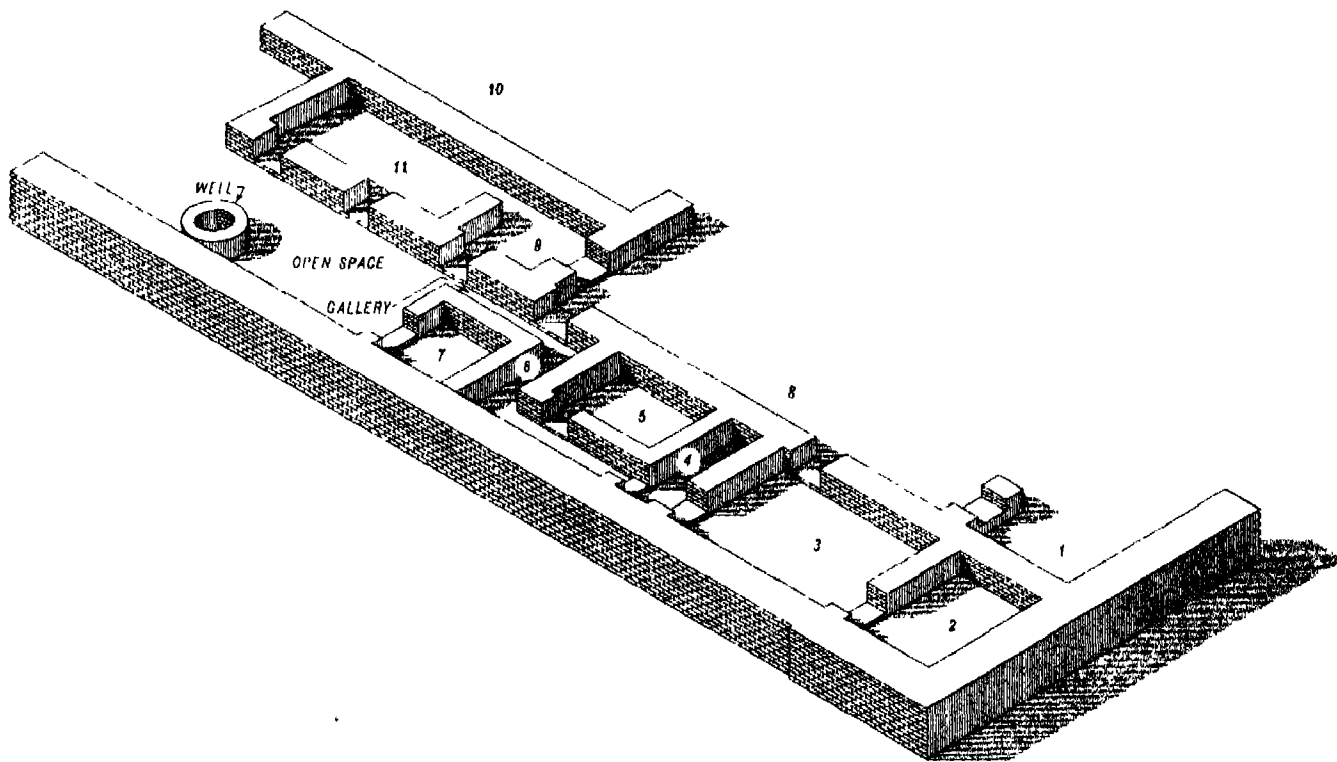
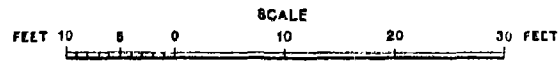

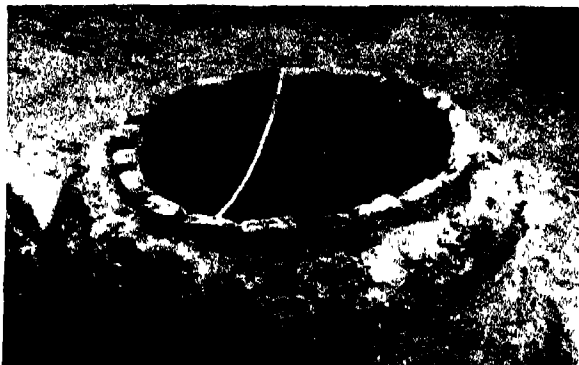

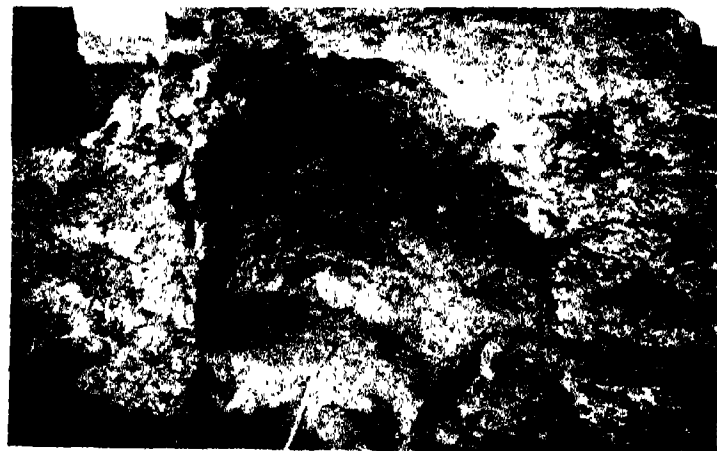

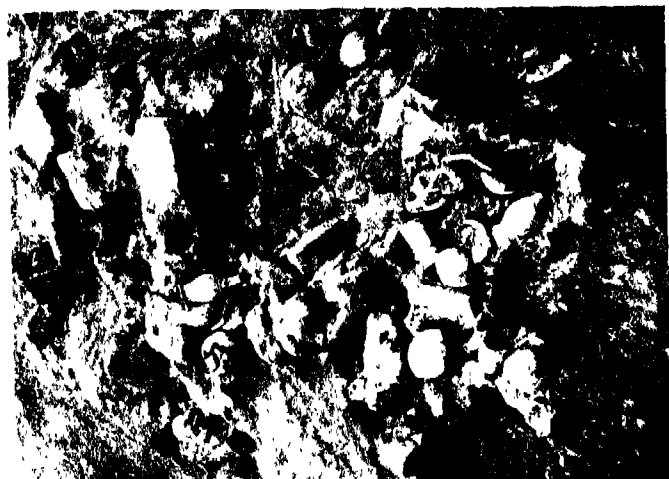

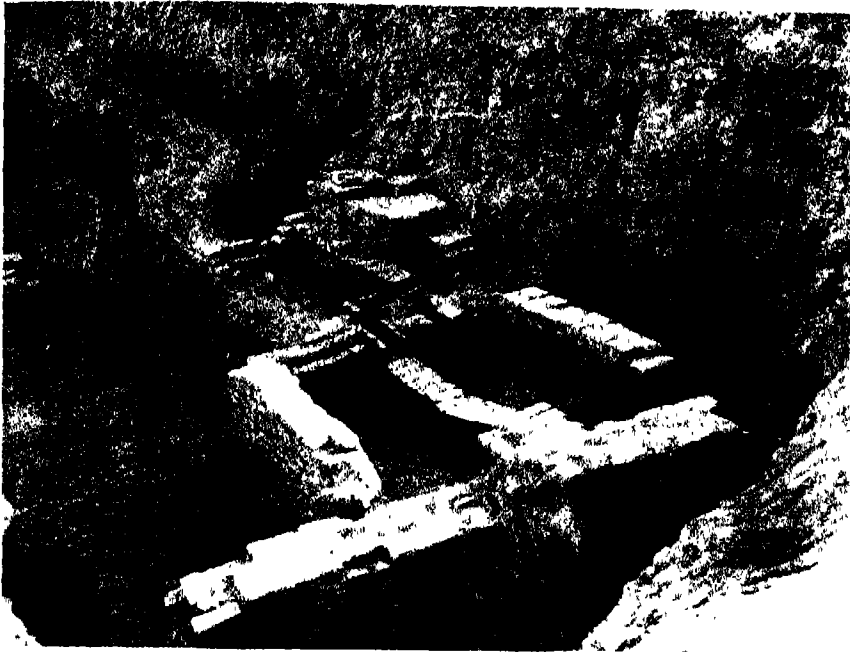

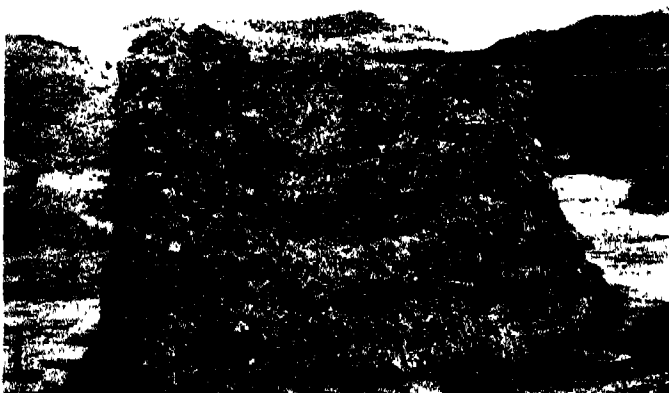

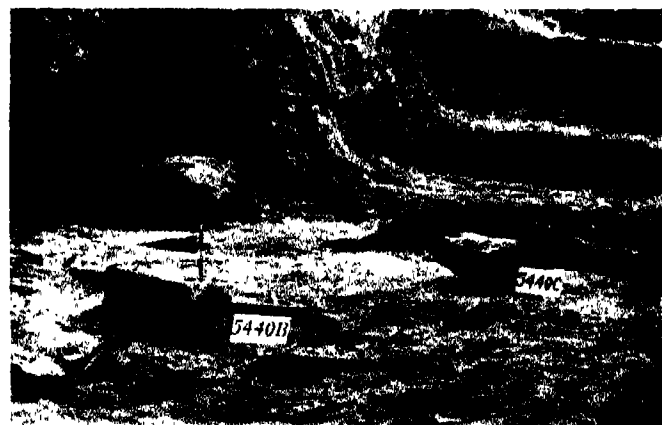

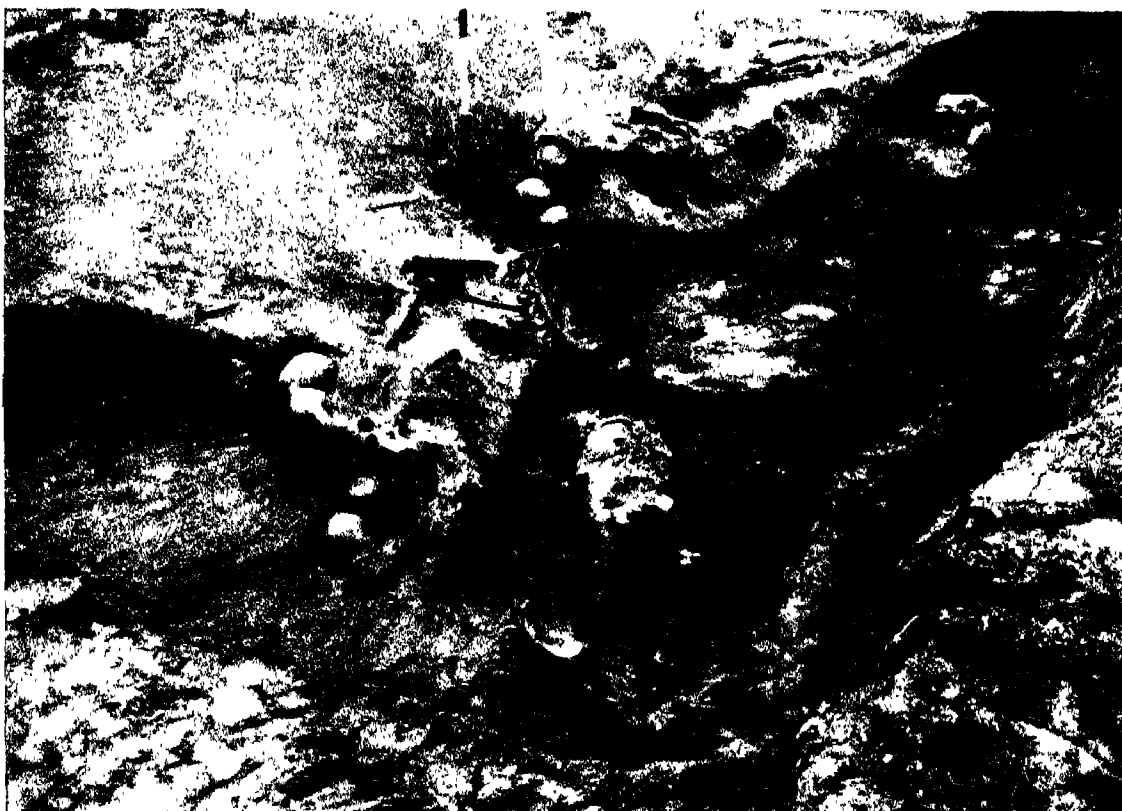

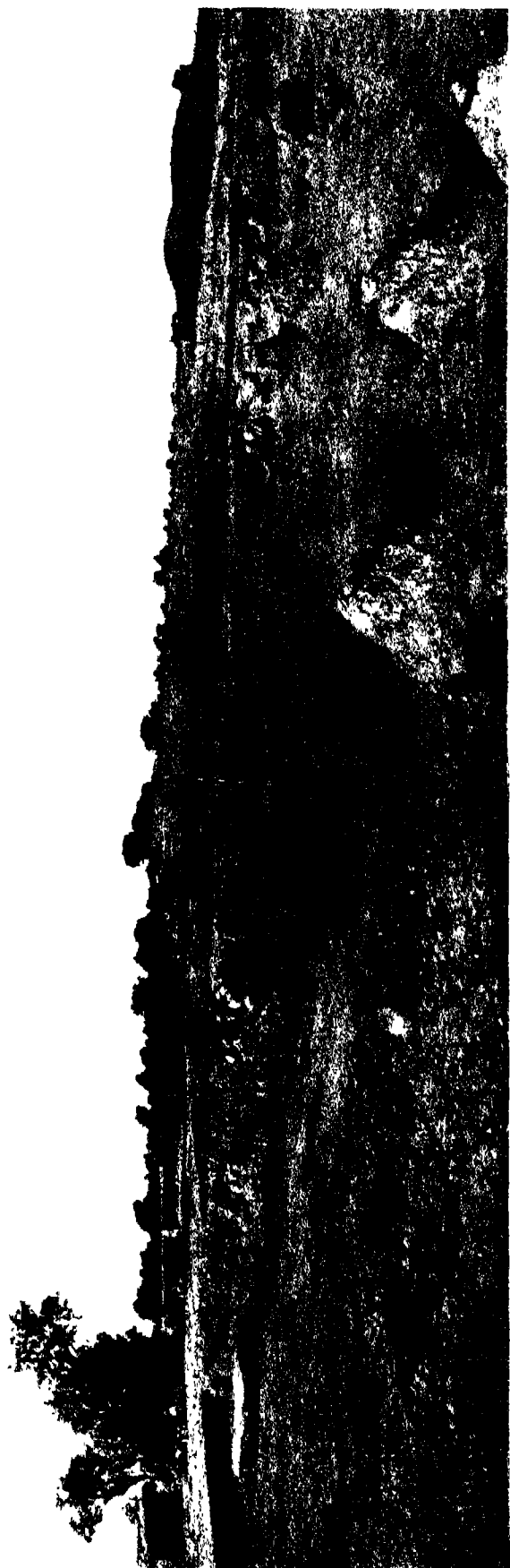

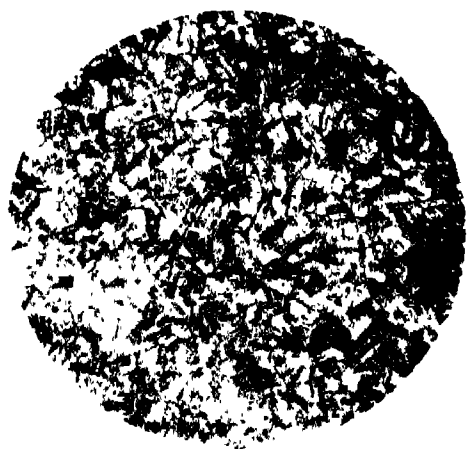

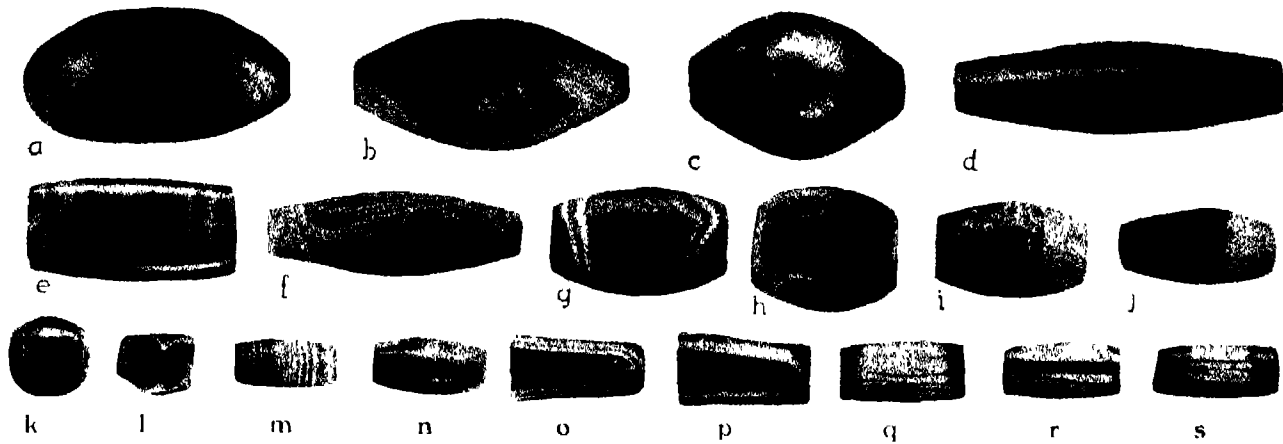


FIG. 1 BEADS OF AGATE

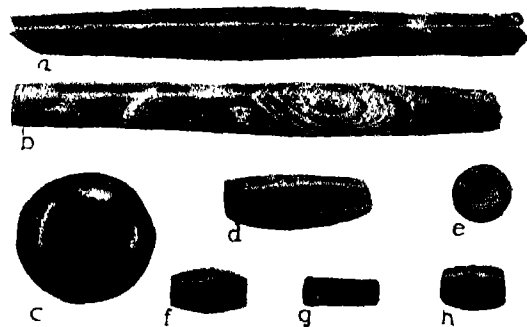


FIG. 2 BEADS OF CARNELIAN

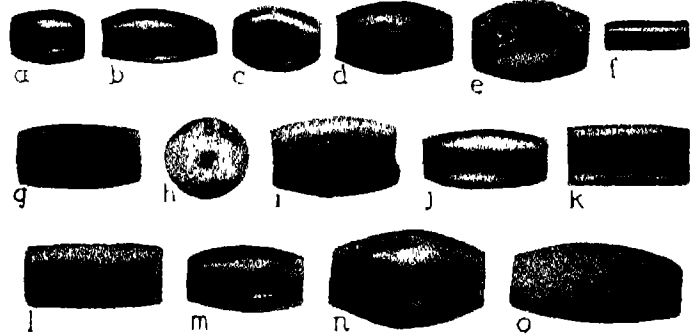


FIG. 3 BEADS OF VARIOUS SILICATE STONES a-f, JASPER, g-k CHERT, l-n CHALCEDONY, o, MILKY QUARTZ.

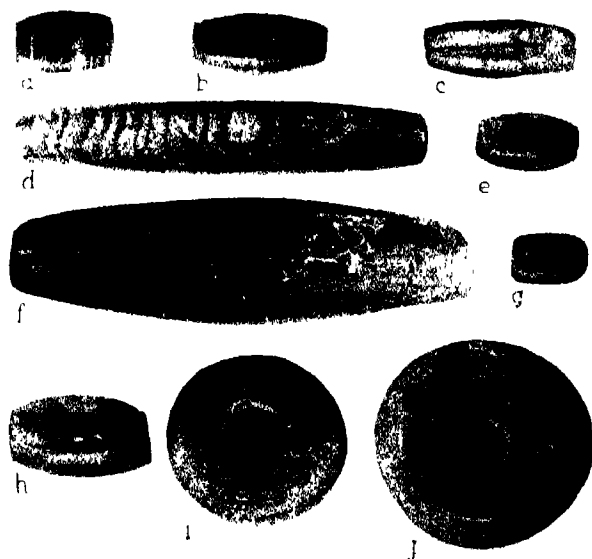


FIG. 6 BEADS OF LIMESTONE & STALAGMIT.

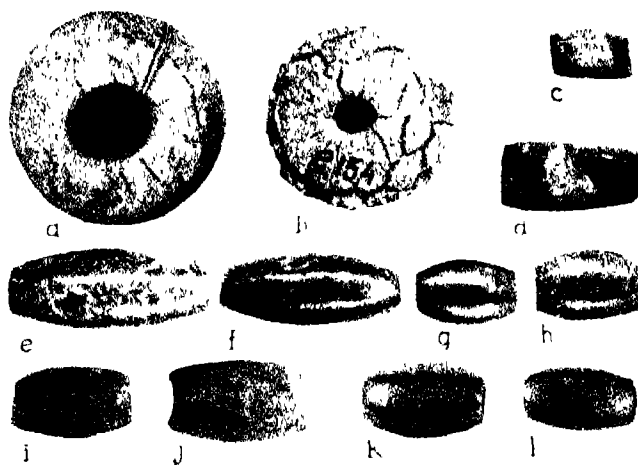


FIG. 7 BEADS OF SUNDRY STONES a & b, MARBLE, c CALCITE, d HORNBLEND, e-g, SERPENTINE, h DIORITE, i & j, LAPIS, k & l JADEITE.

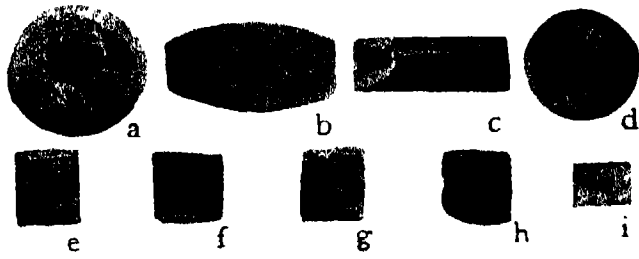


FIG. 1 BEADS OF NATURAL STEATITE.

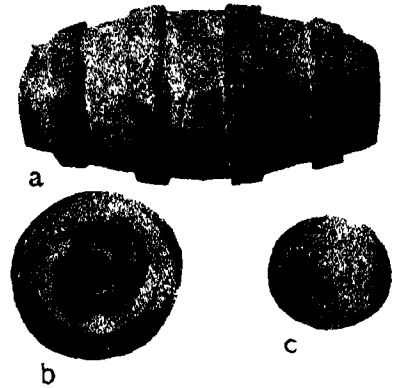


FIG. 2 ZONE BEADS OF BURNT STEATITE.

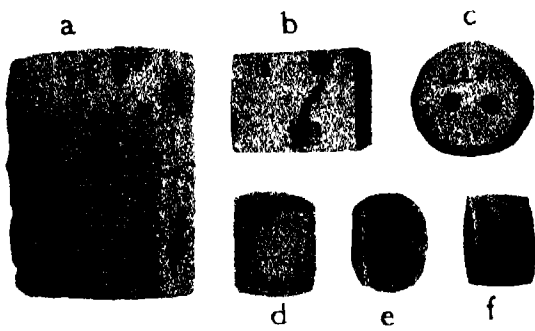


FIG. 3 SPACING BEADS OF BURNT STEATITE.

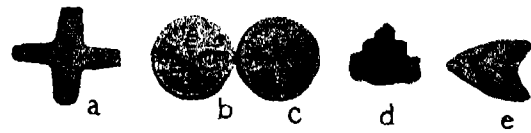


FIG. 4 CROSS, STEP & TOOTH BEADS OF BURNT STEATITE.

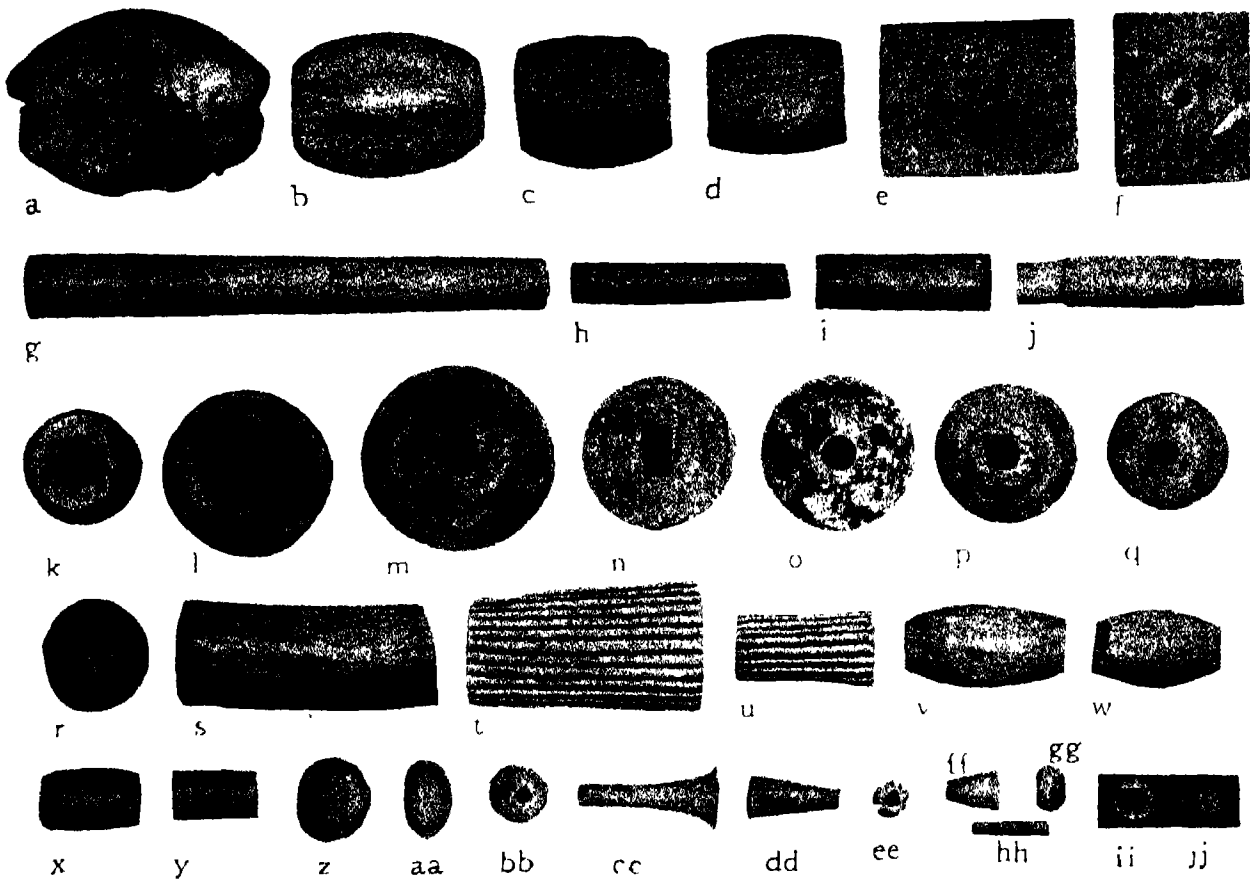


FIG. 5 BEADS OF BURNT STEATITE.



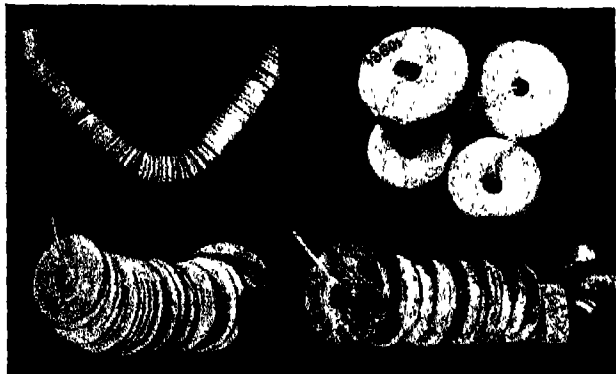


FIG. 1 DISC BEADS OF "BURNT" STEATITE.

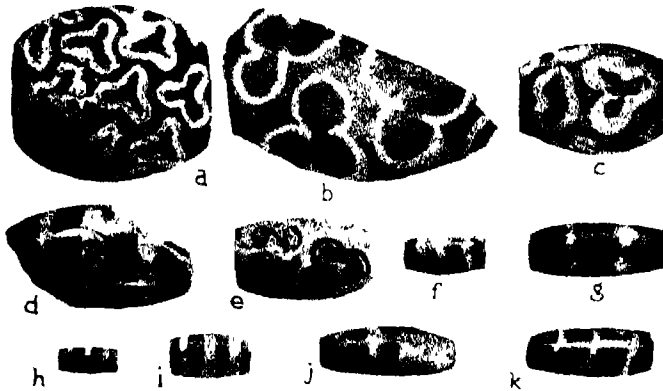


FIG. 2. PAINTED STEATITE BEADS

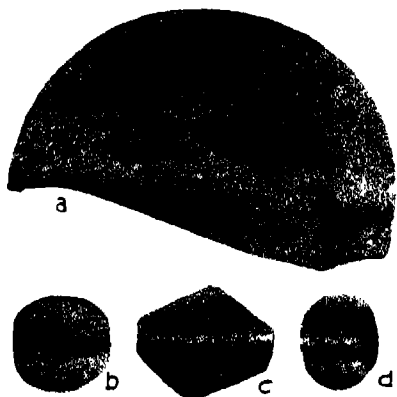


FIG. 3 FAIENGE SPACING BEADS WITH MIDDLE RIB.

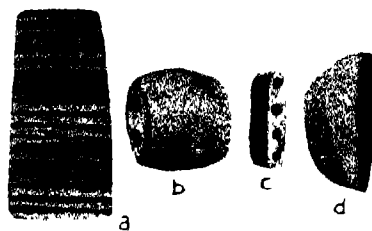


FIG. 4. FAIENGE SPACING BEADS.

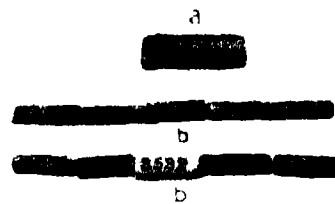


FIG. 5 BLACK FAIENGE BEADS.

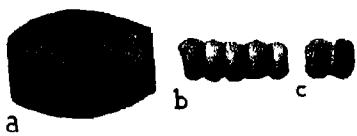


FIG. 6 WHITE FAIENGE BEADS.

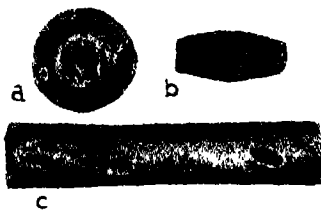


FIG. 7. YELLOW FAIENGE BEADS.

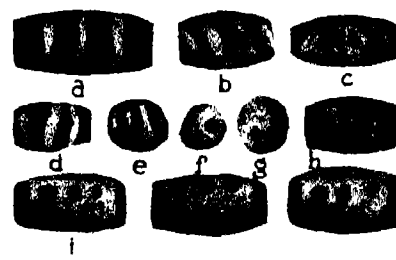


FIG. 8 VARIEGATED FAIENGE BEADS.

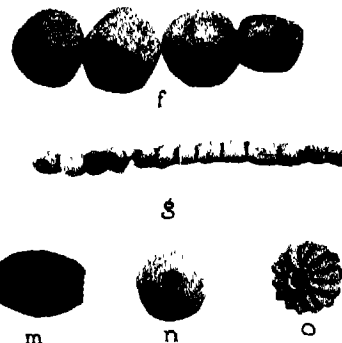
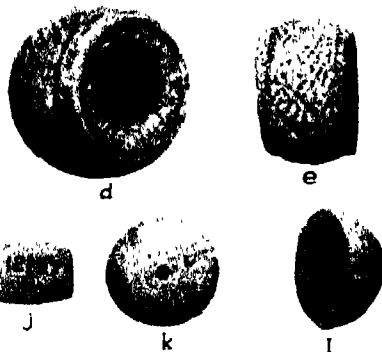
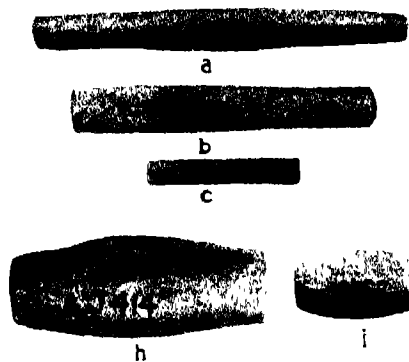


FIG. 9 FAIENGE BEADS- MOSTLY BLUE OR GREEN.

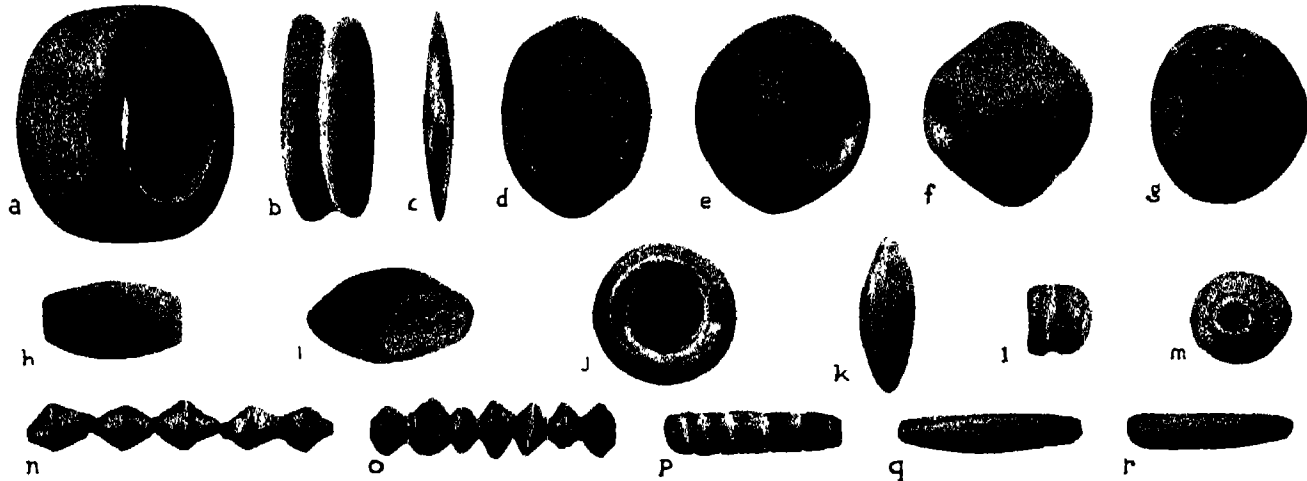


FIG. 1. BEADS OF TERRACOTTA OR POTILRY

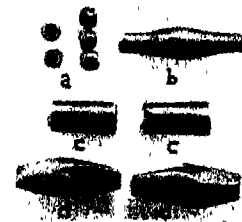


FIG. 7. GOLD BEADS.

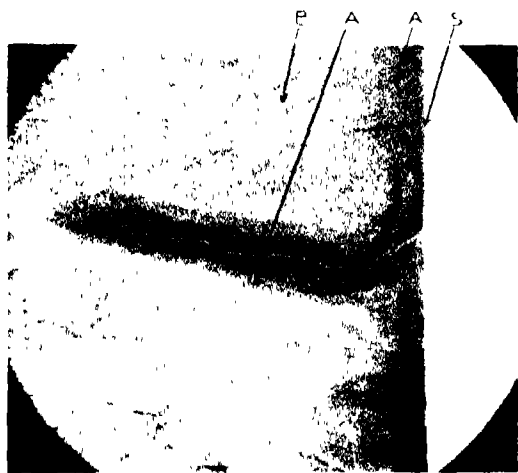


FIG. 10. SMALL STEATITE BEADS X 4. a, c HARAPPA b UR



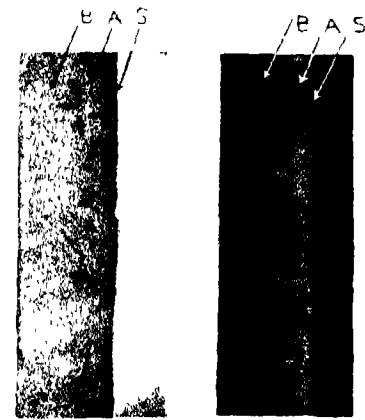
FIG. 11. X 1/1

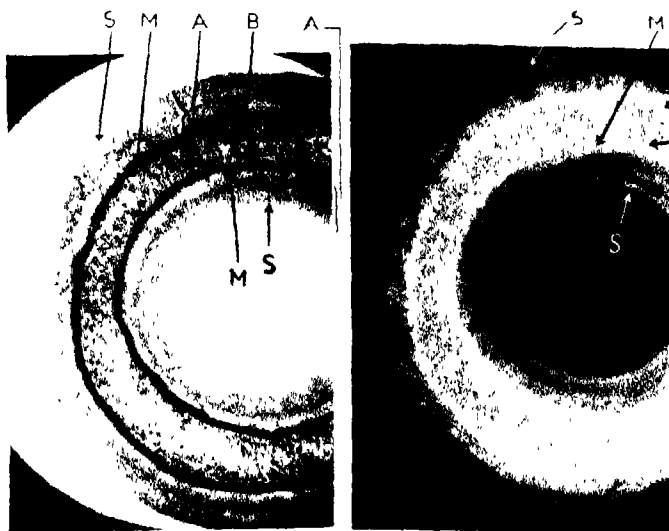

MOHENJO-DARO.



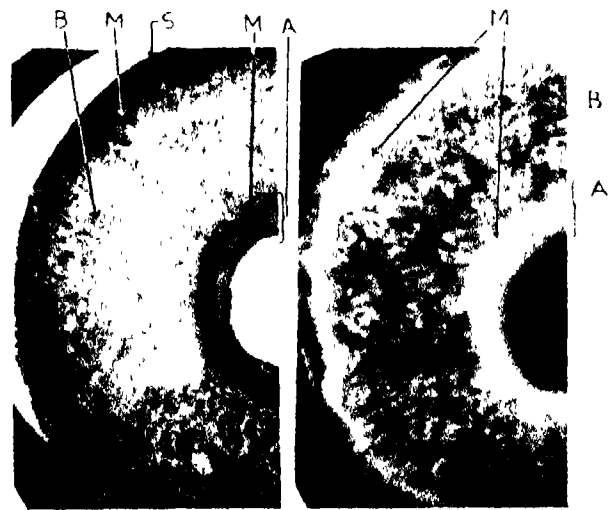

SEAL FROM HARAPPA.



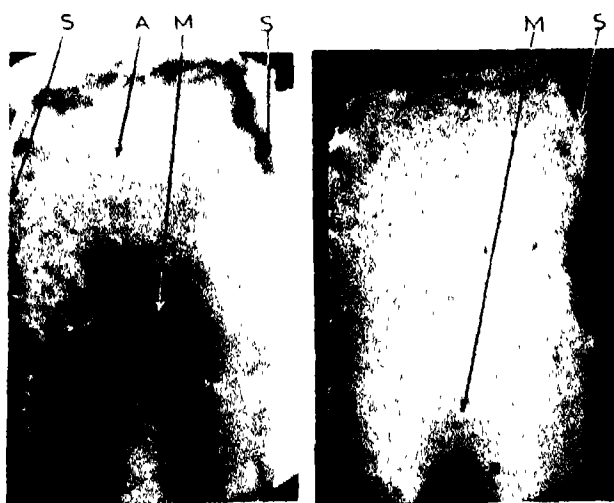

SECTION OF "BURNT" STEATITE BEAD FROM UR.



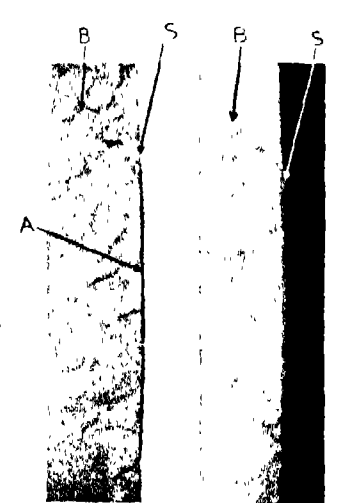

HARAPPA.



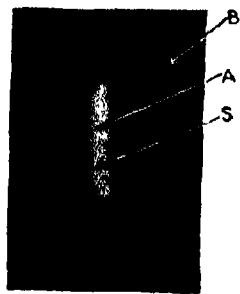

S = SURFACE OF SPECIMEN

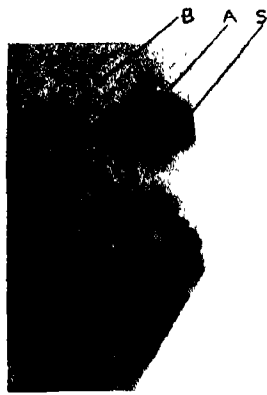

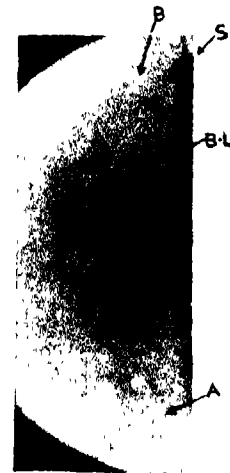

b LIGHT REFLECTED FROM ABOVE

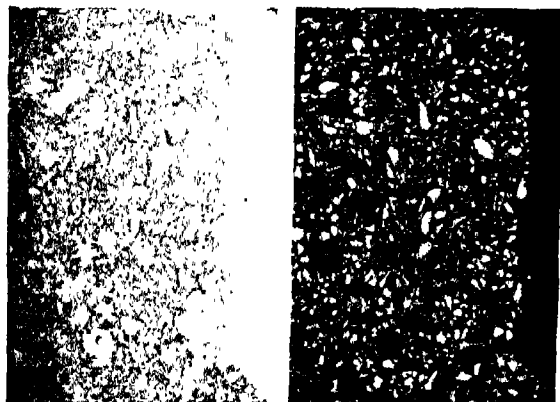
A= AFFECTED AREA. S= SURFACE OF SPECIMEN

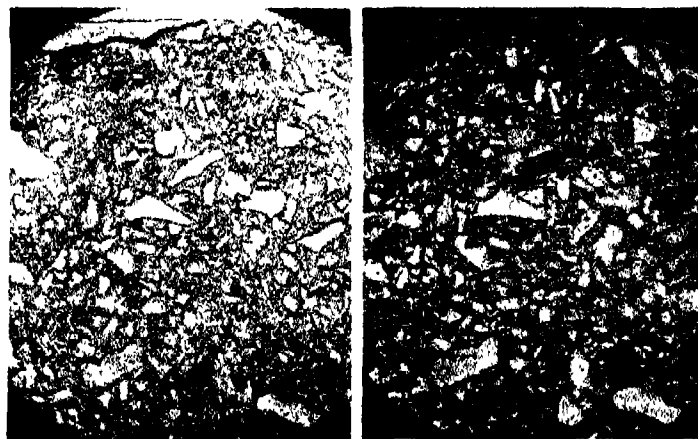

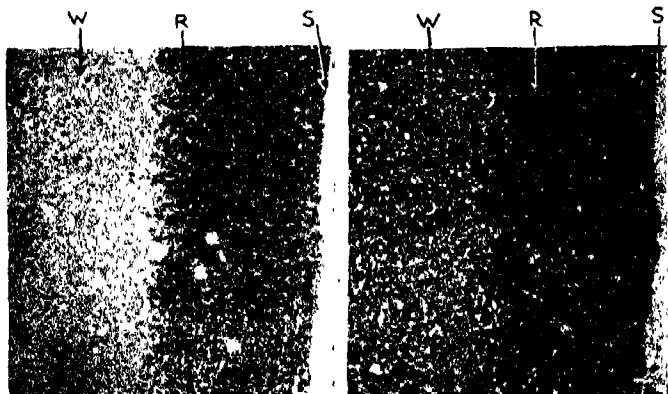

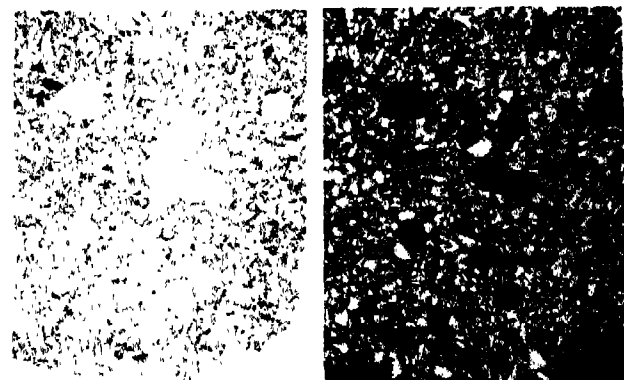

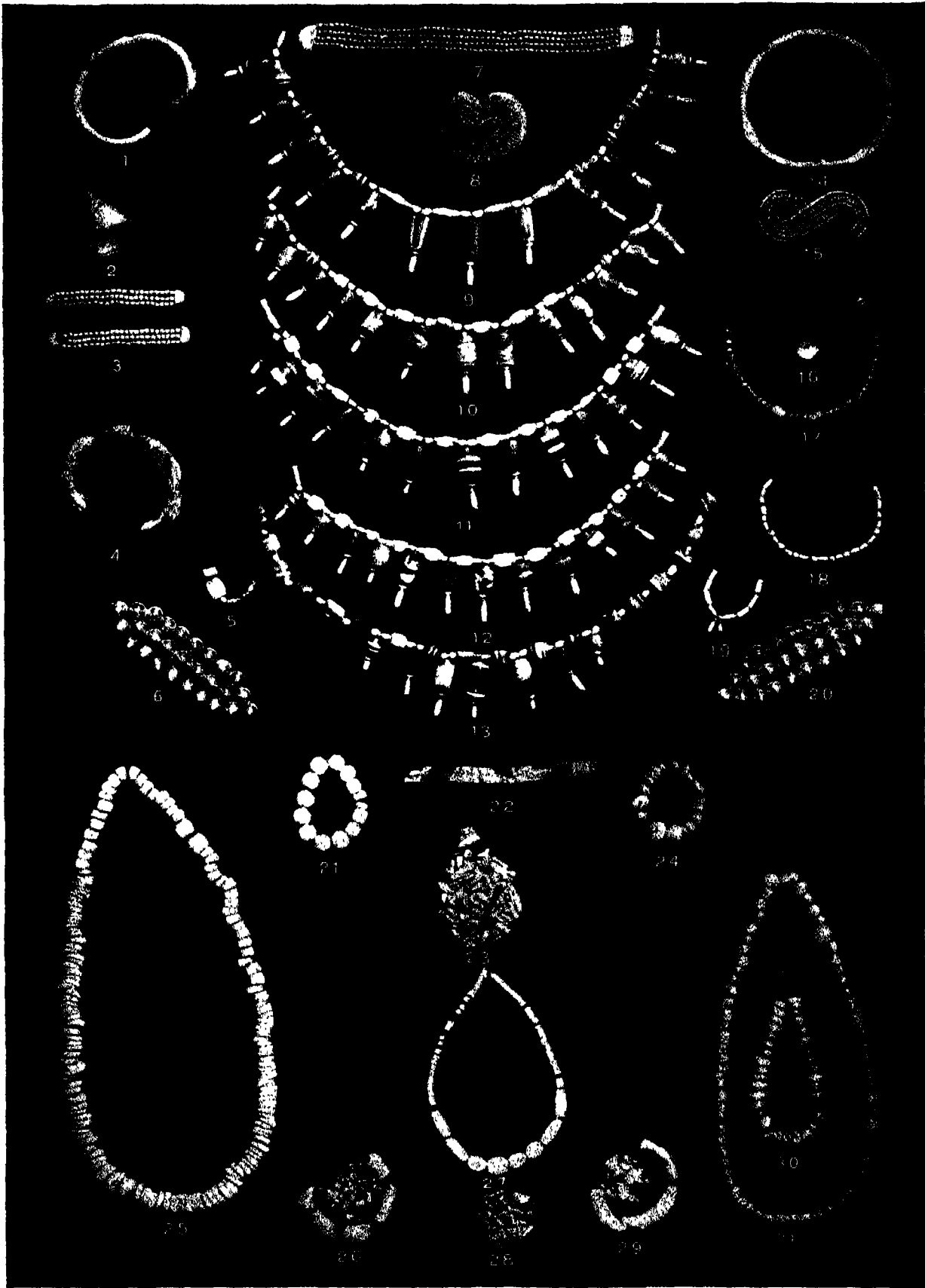

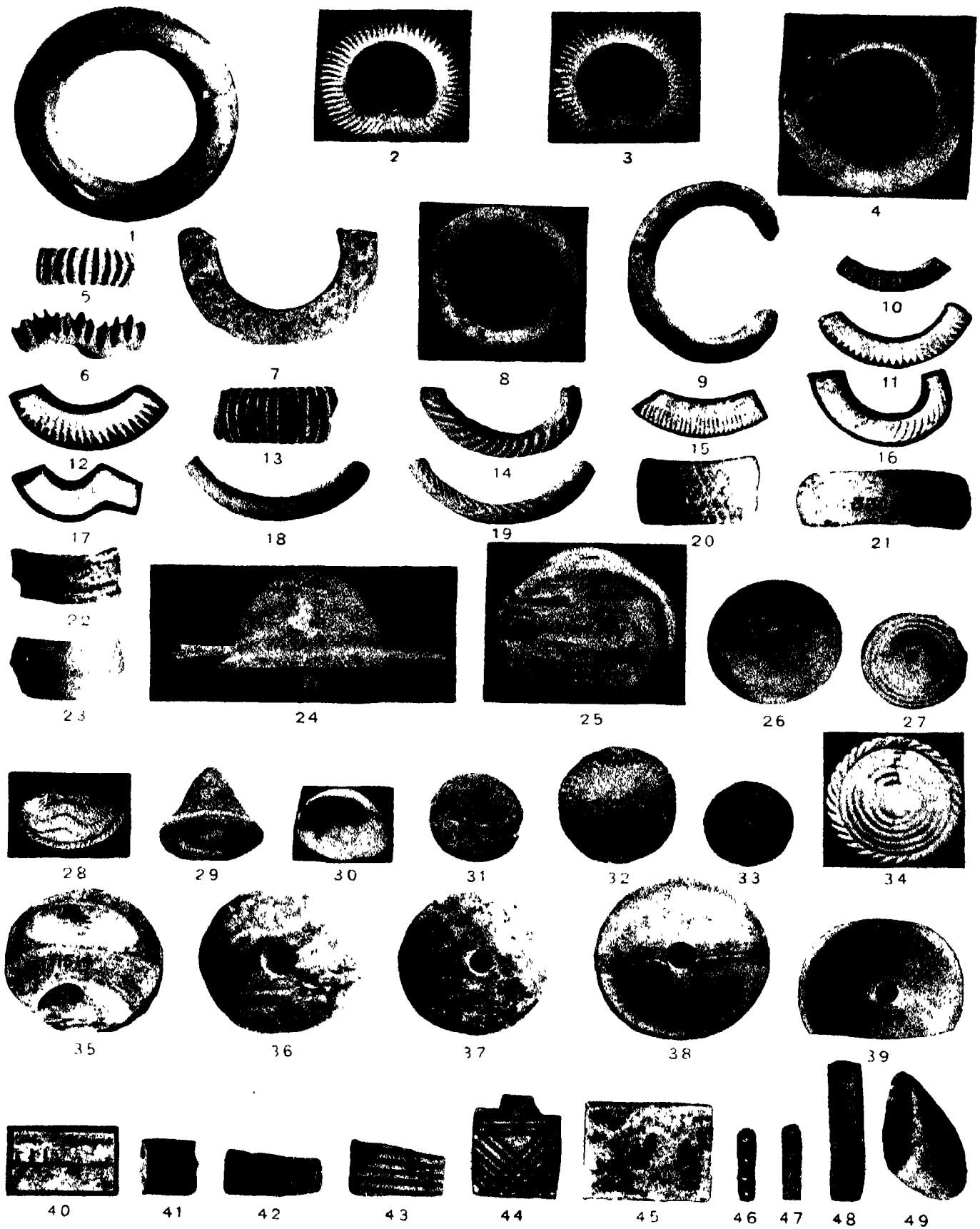

SOMETIMES CALLED VITREOUS PASTE.

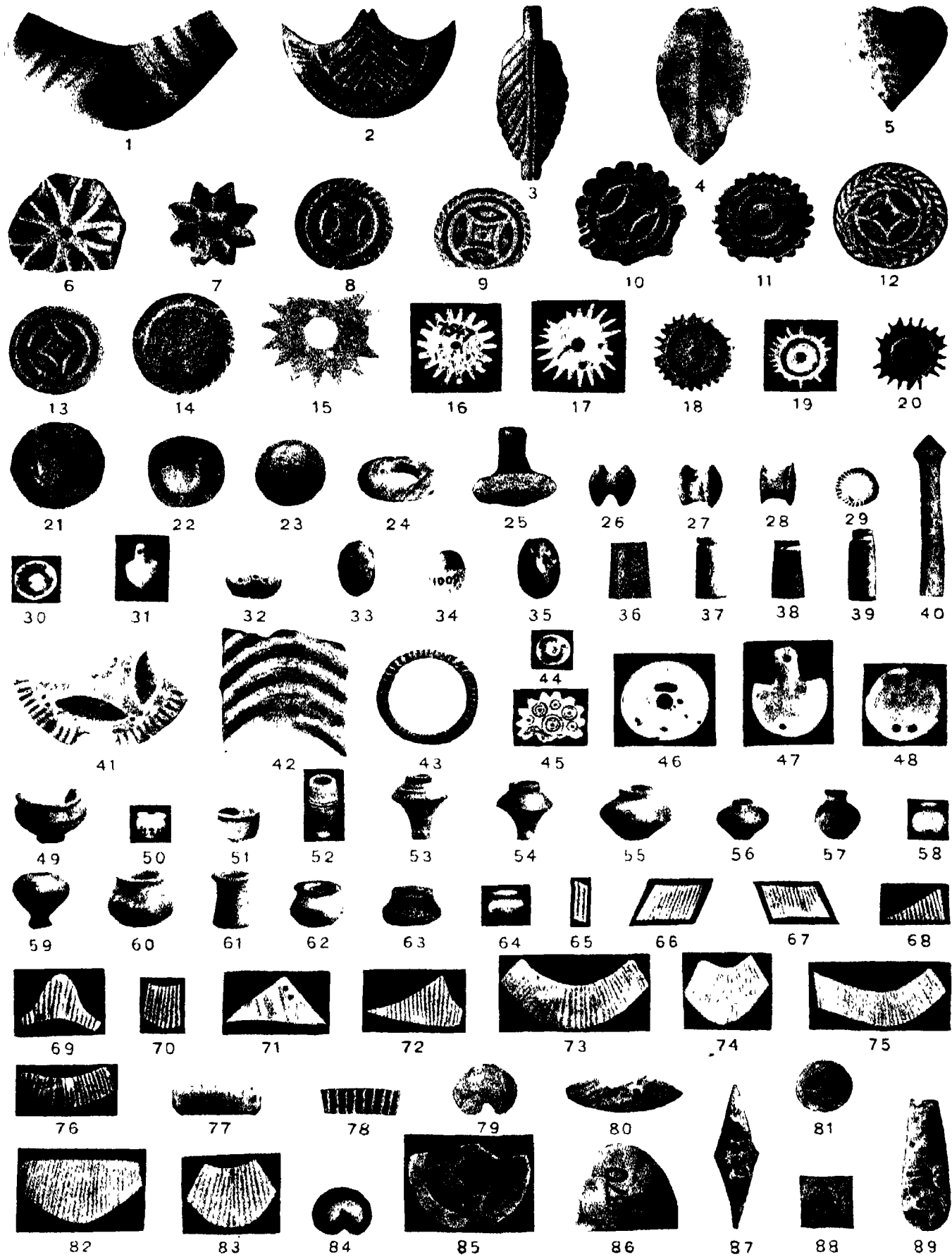
