






FRESCO AND STUCCO RELIEF IN SMALL CELLA OF SHRINE D. II, DANDÂN-UILIQ.








RUINED CELLA D. XII, DANDAN-UILIQ, AFTER EXCAVATION.




RAWAK STŪPA AND ENCLOSING QUADRANGLE, SEEN FROM SOUTH.







PLAN OF RUINED SITE DANDĀN-UILIQ.






HEAD OF COLOSSAL RELIEF IN STUCCO FROM BAWAK STUPA COURT.





