## PART I—Section 1

**Notifications relating to Non-Statutory Rules, Regulations and Orders and Resolutions issued by the Ministries of the Government of India (other than the Ministry of Defence) and by the Supreme Court**

**MINISTRY OF REHABILITATION****RESOLUTION**

*New Delhi, the 4th March 1960*

No. 6(5)DNK/59.—In partial modification of the Government of India (Ministry of Rehabilitation) Resolution dated the 12th September, 1958, regarding constitution of the Dandakaranya Development Authority (published in the Gazette of India dated 20th September 1958) the President is pleased to order that the existing paras 2, 4 (ii) and 5 of the above Resolution may be substituted by the following:—

*Para 2.*

The composition of the Authority shall be as follows:—

**Members**

- (1) A Chairman.
- (2) The Chief Administrator, Dandakaranya Project, who will also be the Deputy Chairman of the Authority.
- (3) The Chief Secretary, Government of Madhya Pradesh or his nominee.
- (4) The Chief Secretary, Government of Orissa or his nominee.
- (5) A representative of the Union Ministry of Rehabilitation.
- (6) A representative of the Union Ministry of Home Affairs.
- (7) Member (Finance).
- (8) Member (Engineering).
- (9) Member (Agriculture).

The Chief Administrator, Dandakaranya Project shall be the chief executive officer of the Authority. A whole-time officer will be appointed as Secretary of the Authority.

*Para 4 (ii).*

to sanction schemes involving capital expenditure not exceeding Rs. 10 lakhs. Provided that schemes involving expenditure in excess of this amount shall be referred to the Central Government for approval.

*Para 5.*

The Authority may delegate to the Chairman, Chief Administrator, Member (Finance), Member (Agriculture) or Member (Engineering) such of its powers as it may deem necessary for the speedy execution of the scheme. The Chairman and other members may in turn re-delegate, with the approval of the Financial Adviser and Chief Accounts Officer to their subordinate officers any of their powers which may be deemed necessary.

**ORDER**

Ordered that a copy of the Resolution be communicated to:—

- (i) All State Governments and all Chief Commissioners.
- (ii) All Ministries of the Government of India, the Planning Commission, the Union Public Service Commission, Cabinet Secretariat, Prime Minister's Secretariat, Secretary to the President, Comptroller and Auditor General of India, All Accountants General and Comptrollers, Railway Board, Directorate General of Supplies and Disposals.
- (iii) Financial Adviser and Chief Accounts Officer, Dandakaranya Project, Jagdalpur (M.P.), Chief Administrator, Dandakaranya Project, Koraput. (Orissa).

Ordered also that the Resolution be published in the Gazette of India for general information.

**RESOLUTION**

*New Delhi, the 19th February 1960*

No. 4-26/60-Com.III.—The Government of India have decided that para 3 of the late Department of Education, Health and Lands Resolution No. F254/34/A, dated the 28th May, 1956, setting up the Indian Central Jute Committee, as amended by the Ministry of Food & Agriculture (Agri.) Resolution No. F4-13/53-Com II, dated the 17th December, 1955, shall be further amended as follows, in so far as tenure of appointment of members is concerned:—

"The tenure of appointment of the members of the Committee other than those who are appointed by reason of the office or appointment they hold, or elected by Lok Sabha or Rajya Sabha, will be three years with effect from the 1st April of the year in which they are appointed or such lesser period as may be specified in the letter of appointment."
