INDIAN HISTORICAL RECORDS COMMISSION

New Dolhi, the 30th August 1957

No. F.8-2/57.C-2. In supersession of the Ministry of Education Resolution No. F. 92-8/52.A.2, dated the 25th June, 1952, 6th June, 1953 and 17th September, 1953, the constitution of the Indian Historical Records Commission will be as follows—

The Commission shall consist of the following two categories of Members:—

- (A) Ordinary Members-
 - (i) The Hon'ble Minister for Education and Scientific Research, Government of India, Ex-officio President.
 - (ii) Five members, of whom one shall be a Scientist, to be nominated by the Government of India in their individual capacity.

- (iii) One nominee each of such State Governments as may have organised Central Record Office.
- (iv) All Members of the Research and Publication Committee mentioned below.
- (v) The Director of Archives. Government of India, Exofficio Secretary.

(B) Corresponding Members-

The selection of Members in this category will be confined to persons directly interested in records, only published work of sufficient merit being accepted as satisfactory evidence of such interest. The number of Corresponding Members from within the country shall be limited to 25. There shall be no limit to the number of Corresponding Members residing outside the country.

Corresponding Members can attend the public meetings of the Commission and may, by special invitation, participate in the deliberations of the Members' meetings. They will, however, be expected to bear their own expenses.

In case the President is unable to attend a meeting, he shall have the right to nominate a member to-act as Chairman

- 2 The Commission will have the following two adjuncts:-
- (1) 4 Research and Publication Committee.

The duties of this Committee will be to further the research activities of the Record Offices of the Central and State Governments and to undertake or to promote regional surveys for bringing manuscript records in private custody to public notice as well as to suggest ways and means for preservation and publication whenever necessary of such manuscript records. The composition of the Committee will be as follows:—

- (a) The Educational Adviser to the Government of India, Ly officio Chamman
- (b) The nominees of the Government of India as given in para 1 (A) (ii) above
- (c) One nominee each of such State Governments as may cooperate with the Commission in the publication of State records
- (d) One nominee each of the universities in India which may co-operate with the Commission in the publica-tion of State records and in conducting regional surveys and exploration of records.
- (e) One nominee each of such institutions as are approved by the Government of India.
- (f) The Director of Archieves, Government of India, Exofficio Secretary.

The Director of Archives, Government of India will remain the general editor of the Indian Records Series but, whenever necessary, the services of other experts will be utilized to assist in the publication of any particular volume or volumes. The Research and Publication Committee, especially in the matter of regional surveys, will need regional co-operation, whether purely official or official and non-official combined. The Covernment of India trust that the State Government will set up regional organisations constituted according to the special heads of the territories under their control to co-operate with the Central Organisation on which they will be tully represented. fully represented.

(2) Local Records Sub-Committee --

The main function of this Sub-Committee will be to advise the Director of Archives, Government of India, on such matters connected with the work of the National Archives as may be referred to it. The composition of the Committee will be as follows:—

- (a) The Educational Advisct to the Government of India, Ex-officio Chairman.
- (b) A nominee each of the Ministries of Home Affairs and Education and Scientific Research.
- (c) A nominee each of four other Ministries by rotations to be co-opted by the Chairman for one year.
- (d) A member co-opted by the Chairman for one year.
- (e) The Director of Archives, Government of India, Ixofficio Secretary.
- 8. The Government of India desire that the nominees of the State Governments appointed as Ordinary Members of the Commission should be the heads of their Central Rethe Commission should be the heads of their Central Record offices and that the nominees of universities and institutions appointed as Members of the Research and Publication Committee should be men of academic distinction with a considerable amount of original research work on the Modern period of Indian History to their credit. A State Government will be at liberty to nominate the same person or different persons to serve on the Commission and the Committee.
- 4 The Ordinary Members of the Commission (other than Ex-officio Ordinary Members) and also all Corresponding

Members of the Commission will be appointed for a term of five years as follows -

- (i) All appointments and reappointments for full term of five years will be made en blor with effect from the same date, but on the expiry of their term the Members concerned will be eligible for reappoint ment.
- (ii) Vacancies due to resignation or otherwise which may occur within the period of five years fixed under clause (i) above will not be filled for a full term of five years but only for the unexpired pointon of the term
- 5 The travelling allowance of the Lx officio President and Secretary of the Commission, the Ex officio Chairman, and Secretary of the Research and Publication Committee and the nominees of the Covernment of India on the Commission and on the Research and Publication Committee referred to in para 1 (A) (n) above, will be a charge on Central Revenues The Ex-officio President and Secretary of the Commission the Ex-officio Chairman and Secretary of the Commission of the Government Servants will draw travelling allowance as on tour for attending meetings of the Commission of the Committee and the expenditure will be debitable to the same head as their pay Non-officials appointed as ordinary members vide para 1 (A) (n) above will draw travelling allowance for attending meetings of the Indian Historial Records Commission and Research and Publication Committee at rates admissible to Grade I Officers of the Central Covernment and daily allowance at the highest rates admissible to Grade I Officers of the Central Covernment for the respective localities. The expenditure will be met from the budget grant of the National Archives of India. The State Covernments, the Universities and Institutions will be required to bear the travelling allowances of their nominees serving as Ordinary Members of the Commission or is Members of the Research and Publication Committee.

Ordered that the Resolution be communicated to all the State Government all Administrations of Union Territories all the Ministrics of the Government of India Cabinet Scale tanat, Prime Minister's Secretariat Partition Secretariat, Department of Parliamentary Affairs Supreme Court, Parliament Secretariat Planning Commission all Universities in India and the Director of Archives to the Government of India.
