NOTIFICATIONS

New Delhi, the 5th April 1967

S.O. 1220.—Whereas a vacancy has occurred in the seats allotted to the State of Jammu and Kashmir in the Council of States by reason of the resignation of Shri G. M. Mir;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 147 of the said Act, the Election Commission hereby calls upon the elected members of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Jammu and Kashmir to elect, in accordance with the provisions of the said Act and of the rules and orders made thereunder, a person to fill the vacancy so caused before the 5th May, 1967.

S.O. 1221.—In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (1) of section 147 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, the Election Commission hereby appoints for the election to the Council of States to be held in pursuance of notification No. 100/J&K-CS/2/67(1), dated the 5th April, 1967.

- (a) the 12th April, 1967, as the last date for making nominations;
- (b) the 14th April, 1967, as the date for the scrutiny of nominations;
- (c) the 16th April, 1967, as the last date for the withdrawal of candidatures;
- (d) the 3rd May, 1967, as the date on which a poll shall, if necessary, be taken; and
- (e) the 5th May, 1967, as the date before which the election shall be completed.

S.O. 1222.—In pursuance of section 56 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, the Election Commission hereby fixes the hours from 2.00 P.M. to 6.00 P.M. as the hours during which a poll shall, if necessary, be taken for the election to the Council of States to be held in pursuance of its notification No. 100/J&K-CS/2/67(1), dated the 5th April, 1967.

S.O. 1223.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 21 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, the Election Commission in consultation with the Government of Jammu and Kashmir hereby designates the Secretary, Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Council to be the Returning Officer for the election to the Council of States to be held in pursuance of its notification No. 100/J&K-CS/2/67(1), dated the 5th April, 1967.

S.O. 1224.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 22 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, the Election Commission hereby appoints the Deputy Secretary, Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Council to assist the Returning Officer for the election to the Council of States to be held in pursuance of its notification No. 100/J&K-CS/2/67(1), dated the 5th April, 1967, in the performance of his functions.
