Haryana State Central Cooperative Bank

- (i) To examine the Cooperative Societies Act and Rules including election rules framed thereunder, and to suggest amendments with a view to simplify the election procedue and clearly define the role of the officials vis-a-vis non-officials connected with the Cooperative Movement.
- (ii) To examine the prevalent procedure of recruitment at all levels by the Copperative Societies including the Apex Institutions with a View to find out if it meets the demands of the day.
