The Advisory Committee will review the functioning of the college periodically and make recommendations to upgrade the content and quality of education with a view to reduce mismatch between the education system and the job market. Specifically, the Advisory Committee will:

- 1) Review the relevance and utility of the courses being offered by the College and recommend changes in syllabus and restructuring of courses, including introduction of new courses, as may be deemed appropriate. This will be done in close consultation with the end-users.
- 2) Review the arrangements made by the College for practical training and help in establishing linkages with the end-users to facilitate placement of students for practical training and also for subsequent employment.

- 3) Advise and guide the College with regard to infrastructure facilities relating to laboratories, library, hostel accommodation and recreation, etc.
- 4) Focus on issues relating to faculty development, continuing education programmes and flexible and modular course structure in order to strengthen "out reach" activities.
- 5) Review the existing incentive structure for faculty and students, including the performance appraisal systems, with a view to strengthen incentives for good performance and disincentives for poor performance.
- 6) Advise the College in building up a corpus fund to finance various activities and programmes.
- 7) Engage in constructive dialogue with parents, students, faculty, alumni and other stakeholders in order to build healthy traditions and conventions in the College.

The Committee shall meet at least twice a year and may meet at such other times as required.

Four members shall form a quorum for a meeting of the Committee.

The tenure of the Committee shall normally be for three years.

The non-official members of the Committee will be entitled to claim TA/DA for their journeys performed in connection with attending meetings as admissible to Group "A" Officers of the Government at the highest rates.

CHARTER OF DEMANDS

(1) Demand No. 1: Pay scales:

The Union demands that the following pay scales be implemented with effect from 01-05-2004, alongwith the grade and designation.

(2) Demand No. 2: Flat-Rise:

The Union demands that each workman be paid a flat-rise of Rs. 500/- per month over and above the basic salary as on 01-05-2004. The total of Rs. 500/- per month PLUS the basic salary as on 30-04-2004 be fitted in the respective pay scales as demanded above in Demand No. (1) as per the normal standards set for 'fitment'.

(3) Demand No. 3: Fixed Dearness Allowance (FDA):

The Union demands that with effect from 01-05-2004, each workman be paid a Fixed Dearness Allowance (FDA) every month at the rate of Rs. 300/-.

(4) Demand No. 4: Variable Dearness Allowance (VDA):

The Union demands that with effect from 01-05-2004, each workman be paid a Variable Dearness Allowance at the rate of Rs. 1.50 per point above base 2000 points AAICPI (1960=100).

The Variable Dearness Allowance to be revised at every quarter.

(5) Demand No. 5: House Rent Allowance (HRA):

The Union demands that with effect from 01-05-2004, each worker be paid House Rent Allowance at the rate of 25% of the gross salary.

(6) Demand No. 6: Leave Travel Allowance (LTA):

The Union demands that with effect from 01-05-2004, each worker be paid Leave Travel Allowance (LTA) of Rs. 2,500/- per annum.

(7) Demand No. 7: Conveyance Allowance:

The Union demands that with effect from 01-05-2004, each worker be paid a Conveyance Allowance of Rs. 300/-.

(8) Demand No. 8: Uniforms, Slippers and Footwear:

The Union demands that each worker be issued two pairs of uniforms, per year and each worker be issued slippers and footwear once in every six months.

(9) Demand No. 9: Shift Allowance:

The Union demands that each worker be paid Shift Allowance as under:

General Shift Allowance — Rs. 25/- per day.

Night Shift Allowance — Rs. 50/- per day.

(10) Demand No. 10: Leave Facilities:

The Union demands that the workman be eligible to the following leave facilities.

(a) Privilege Leave: 30 days per annum with a facility to accumulate upto 100 days.

(b) Casual Leave : 10 days per annum with a facility to encash the balance leave.

(c) Sick Leave : 10 days per annum with a facility to accumulate upto 30 days.

(d) Holidays : 14 days per annum.

(11) Demand No. 11: Bonus:

The Union demands that each workman should be paid 20% bonus every year.

(12) Demand No. 12: Work on Sundays and Holidays:

The Union demands that the workers working on Sundays and Holidays shall be provided, (a) To & fro free transport, (b) Full 8-hours double pay and one day paid compensatory off.

Whereas the Government of Goa is of the opinion that an industrial dispute exists between the management of M/s. Goa Antibiotics and Pharmaceuticals Limited, Tuem, Pernem, Goa, and their workmen represented by the 'Kamgarancho Ekvott', in respect of the matter specified in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as the "said dispute");

And whereas the Government of Goa considers it expedient to refer the said dispute for adjudication.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (d) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (Central Act 14 of 1947) (hereinafter referred to as the "said Act"), the Government of Goa hereby refers the said dispute for adjudication to the Industrial Tribunal of Goa, at Panaji-Goa, constituted under Section 7-A of the said Act.

SCHEDULE

"(I) Whether the Charter of Demands as specified herein below, which were served vide letter dated 26-12-2002, on the management of M/s. Goa Antibiotics and Pharmaceuticals Limited, Tuem, Pernem, Goa, by 'Kamgarancho Ekvott' on behalf of the workmen, is legal and justified?

CHARTER OF DEMANDS

(1) Revision in Pay scales:-

The existing basic pay scales be revised as follows:

Grade	Pay Scales
G-I	Rs. 600-70-950-90-1,400-100-1,900-110-2,450-120-3,050.
G-II	Rs. 650-80-1,050-90-1,500-100-2,000-110-2,550-120-3,150-130-3,800-140-4,500-150-5,250.
G-III	Rs. 700-90-1,150-100-1,650-110-2,200-120-2,800-130-3,450-140-4,150.
G-IV	Rs. 800-100-1,300-110-1,850-120-2,450-130-3,100-140-3,800-150-4,550.
G-V	Rs. 1,000-110-1,550-120-2,150-130-2,800-140-3,500-150-4,250-160-5,050.
G-VI	Rs. 1,200-120-1,800-130-2,450-140-3,150-150-3,900-160-4,700-170-5,550.

Note:

- (1) On reaching the end of the pay scale, employee to continue to draw last drawn increment amount for subsequent years.
- (2) On promotion/upgradation, employee be given four additional increments and to draw annual increment higher than what he draws in lower scale.

(2) Flat Rise in Basic Pay scale:-

A flat rise of Rs. 800/- per month be given to each employee and thereafter he be fitted in the nearest higher pay scale. Discrimination in wages of employees in Grade-I be removed.

(3) Improvement in Variable Dearness Allowance:

The existing rate of Variable Dearness Allowance of Rs. 1.80 per point be revised to Rs. 2.50 per point.

(4) Flat Rise in Fixed Dearness Allowance:

A flat rise of Rs. 500/- per month in Fixed Dearness Allowance be given to each employee.

(5) House Rent Allowance:

All employees be paid House Rent Allowance at the rate of 20% of their basic pay.

(6) Conveyance Allowance:

All employees be paid Conveyance Allowance at the rate of 10% of their basic pay.

(7) City Compensatory Allowance:

All employees be paid City Compensatory Allowance of Rs. 300/- per month.

(8) Job Rotation:

In Grade-I employees there should be a Job Rotation after every six months.

(9) Night Shift Allowance:

Employees be paid Night Shift Allowance of Rs. 50/- per second shift and Rs. 70/- per third shift.

(10) Medical Facilities:

Employees who are not covered under Employees State Insurance be paid Medical Allowance of Rs. 2000/- per annum. Mediclaim facilities be also provided to the employees with the management contributing 50% of the premium. First Aid Medical Kit be provided in the factory. A visiting doctor be also provided for the benefit of the employees.

(11) Gratuity:

On retirement/resignation of employee, be paid Gratuity at the rate of 30 days of wages for every year of service.

(12) Canteen Facilities:

Besides normal canteen facilities, all employees be provided free milk and biscuits in every shift.

(13) Rainwear:

Employees be provided raincoats and rainshoes every year.

(14) Leave and Holidays:

Leave and Holidays be revised as follows:

- (a) Paid Leave – 30 days (accumulation 180 days)
- (b) Sick Leave – 15 days (accumulation 45 days)

- (c) Casual Leave – 12 days (accumulation 36 days)
- (d) Maternity Leave – 6 months
- (e) Paternity Leave – 8 days
- (f) Holidays – 12 days (excluding weekly off day)
- (g) Special Leave – Special on duty leave be granted to employees who meet with an accident while on duty and their entire medical expenses shall be reimbursed.

(15) Transport Facilities:

Transport facilities be provided to the employees during day shift just as that provided during night shift.

(16) Leave Travel Concession:

Every employee be paid Leave Travel Concession equal to one month's gross salary, every year.

(17) Annual Bonus:

Bonus at the rate of 20% be paid to employees for every financial year without any ceiling.

(18) Group Insurance Scheme:

Each employee be covered under Group Insurance Scheme for an amount of Rs. 2,00,000/-.

(19) Personal Accident Scheme:

Each Employee be covered under Personal Accident Scheme of Rs. 2,00,000/-.

(20) Compassionate Employment:

Those employees who die while in employment, their kith and kin be provided employment in the factory on compassionate grounds.

(21) Loan Facilities:

Employees be granted loan facilities as follows:

- (a) *Housing Loan*: Employer should grant housing loan of Rs. 1,00,000/- for purchase/construction of a house. The rate of interest should be 6%.
- (b) *Vehicle Loan*: Employer should grant interest free vehicle loan of Rs. 30,000/- to the employee.
- (c) *Marriage Loan*: Employees desirous of getting married be given interest free marriage loan of Rs. 25,000/- at the time of marriage.
- (d) *Staff Advance* equal to two months gross salary be given free of interest.
- (e) *Festival Advance*: Festival Advance equal to one month's salary be given to employees and recovered in ten equal instalments.

(22) Promotion Scheme/Upgradation Scheme:

All employees shall be upgraded by one grade i.e. Grade-I workmen be placed in Grade-II and so on. The management should also frame a promotion/upgradation scheme in consultation with the union.

(23) Uniforms:

All employees be provided two pair of Uniform every year.

(24) Existing Facilities:

All existing facilities not altered by above demands shall continue to be in operation.

The Union crave leave to amend and/or alter and/or substitute this Charter of Demands, if found necessary.

The period of settlement be for three years, from 01-01-2003 to 31-12-2005.

- (II) If answer to (I) above is in the affirmative, then, to what relief the workmen are entitled ?”
