


But the rest of the Council have revealed their true colors and captured our intrepid trio—will they be able to escape the Council's clutches?



Editorial commentary that's been"silver aged" to perfection!






BELOW: Evan Stanley's model sheet for Gold the Tenrec's first appearance in *Sonic Universe* #80. Note the height difference shown in the bottom left

Pretty cool, huh? Well there's more where that came from, but not 'til next time!



ABOVE: Evan Stanley's design concept for Silver's hideaway. Introduced in *Sonic Universe* #79, this is where Silver practices his powers in secret.




