




















































Letter from the EDITOR

ABOVE: Concept designs for **The Second Devourer**. Note that the third design is closest to the final, but without the lower jaw or head shape.




ABOVE: Head designs for The Second Devourer. By this point a lower jaw was decided upon. Please take special note of 7½: The Pompadour Devourer.


