## The Mint presented A. M. Smith several copper dollars and a partial 1884 copper proof set. These with the exception of a duplicate 1884 trade dollar were sold in Bolender's 2/36 sale as noted below.

## EXCESSIVELY RARE U.S. PATTERN COINS

Note-All of the following thirteen trial pieces of U.S. Silver and gold coins struck in copper were unknown to Mr. Adams and to Mr. Woodin, who published the book on the subject. A. M. Smith got them from the superintendent of the mint in 1884 and they have remained in the Smith collection these fifty years, and have never been offered for sale.
