Western Australia

Calaby & Medutook

~~18-23/9/52.~~ Nyabing - 18-9-52.

Mallee - fairly dense with a fair understratum of small sclerophyllous shrub. Light-coloured fairly coarse sandy soil. One ♂ *Monistria*.

Newdegate - 19-9-52

Mallee and larger Eucalypts with understratum of smaller sclerophyllous shrubs. Light greyish soil.

♀ *Monistria* in Mallee habitat.

Propadnura eyrei

Propadnura in a clearing with coarse grass-like tussocks.

Other acridids ~~xxx~~ in small shrubs and grasses round granite rocks.

58 m. S.W. Norseman

Open Stand of Salmon Gum and Ginkgo
not dense. Reddish sandy soil.
Understratum of small shrubs.
One ♂ Moraba.

20.9.52.

At Lake King and at 58 m S.W.
Norseman, a couple of small nymphs
of the same sp. of Monistrid were
seen but not collected.

On trip this day from Newdegate to
Norseman many small nymphs of
several spp. seen (Coryphistes, Gonidea, etc.)
Loway wet day.

5 m. N. Norseman 21-9-52

Eucs. with smaller shrubs. bare stony earth mostly. Clump of *Triodia*. *Coryphistoids* in liter around Eucs.

14 m. N. Norseman 21-9-52

As for above, but much stonier and barer.

4 m N. Higginsville 21-9-52

Eucs. with some acacias and fairly plentiful understatum of shrubs. Hard stony soil.

Pair of *Monistrias* in cop on small sclerophyllous bush

7 m. N. Widgiemooltha. 21-9-52

Eucs. with some shrubs and much bare ~~stony~~ earth.

Loose red soil.

9 m S. Coolgardie 21-9-52.

Reddish sandy soil with
Mallee, smaller shrubs and
large patches of *Triodia*.

10 m. S.W. Kalgoorlie 21-9-52.

As for above but a much
stonier soil.

2 m. W. Coolgardie 22-9-52

Mallee, other Eucs. and smaller
sclerophyllous shrubs on red sandy
soil. Extensive patch of bluebush,

12 m NE. Woolgangie 22-9-52

Large salmon gums and mallees with
small shrubs. Bare soil between plants

2 m. W. Boondi, 22-9-52

Light yellow sand with
Mallee and *Triodia*. Odd
patches of flowering shrubs on
edges of tree clumps. Patches of
drying *Styca* and *Poa*?

3 m. E. Karalee, 22-9-52

Mallee with some *Triodia* on
light reddish sandy soil.
Some shrubs, much bare earth.

Southern Cross 23-9-52

One specimen from a grassy
slope, about 50 yds from a
clump of *Euc.* *A. cruciata*
plentiful. (not collected).

→ Brown sp. with reddish tibiae in
Triodia. Grey sp. with yellow tibiae
in flowering shrubs. Small *Macrotona*
in drying grass.
