The five daily prayers

1. *Fajr*, or morning prayers.
2. *Zuhr*, or noon prayers.
3. *Asr*, or afternoon prayers.
4. *Maghrib*, or evening prayers.
5. *Isha*, or night prayers.

Say: "Bismillah!" Wash both hands completely up to the wrist.



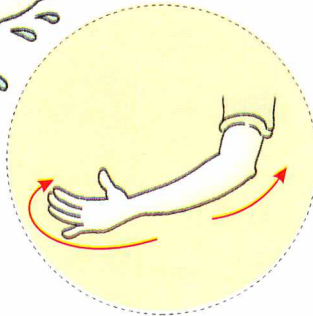
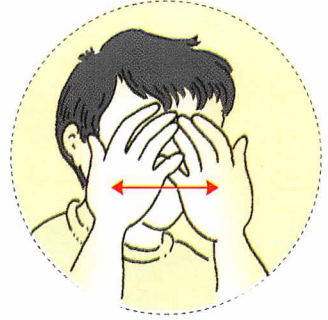
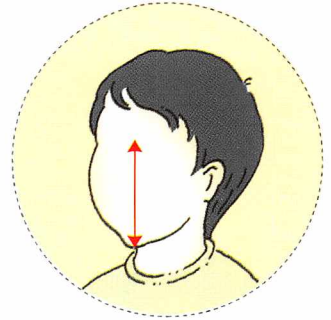
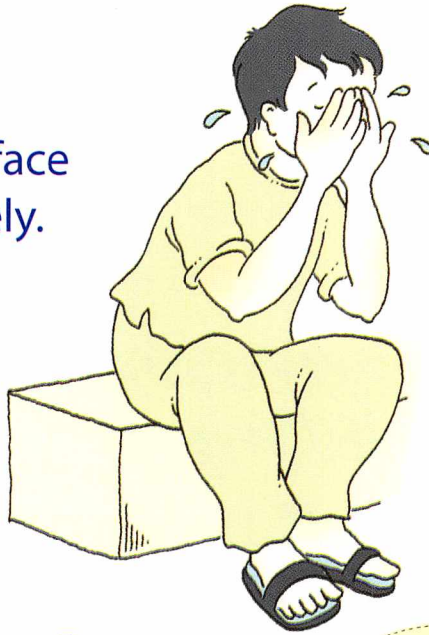
Step 2

Rinse the mouth thoroughly, inhale water into the nose and blow it out.



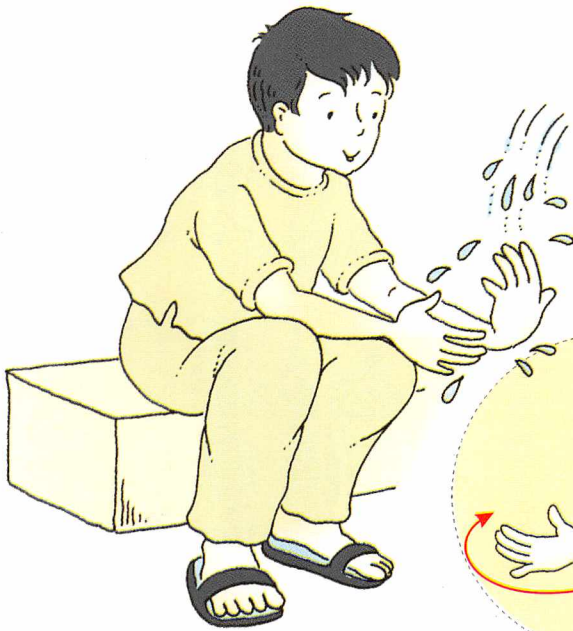
Step 3

Wash the face completely.



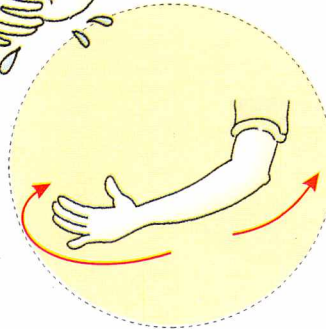
Step 4

First wash your right hand and forearm, including the elbow.



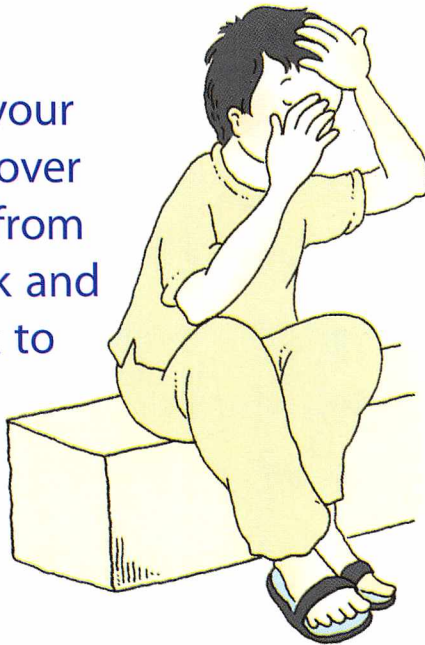

Then wash your left hand and forearm, including the elbow.



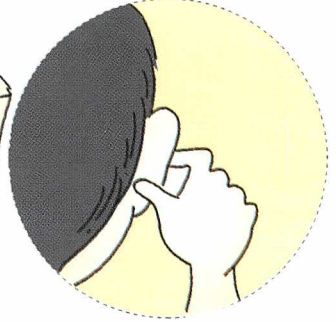
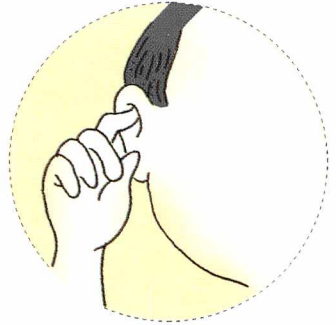
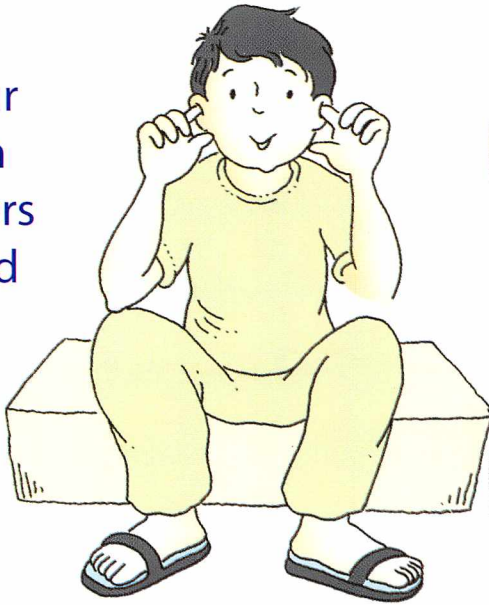

First wash your right foot thoroughly, including the ankle.



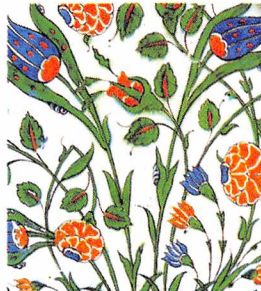
