

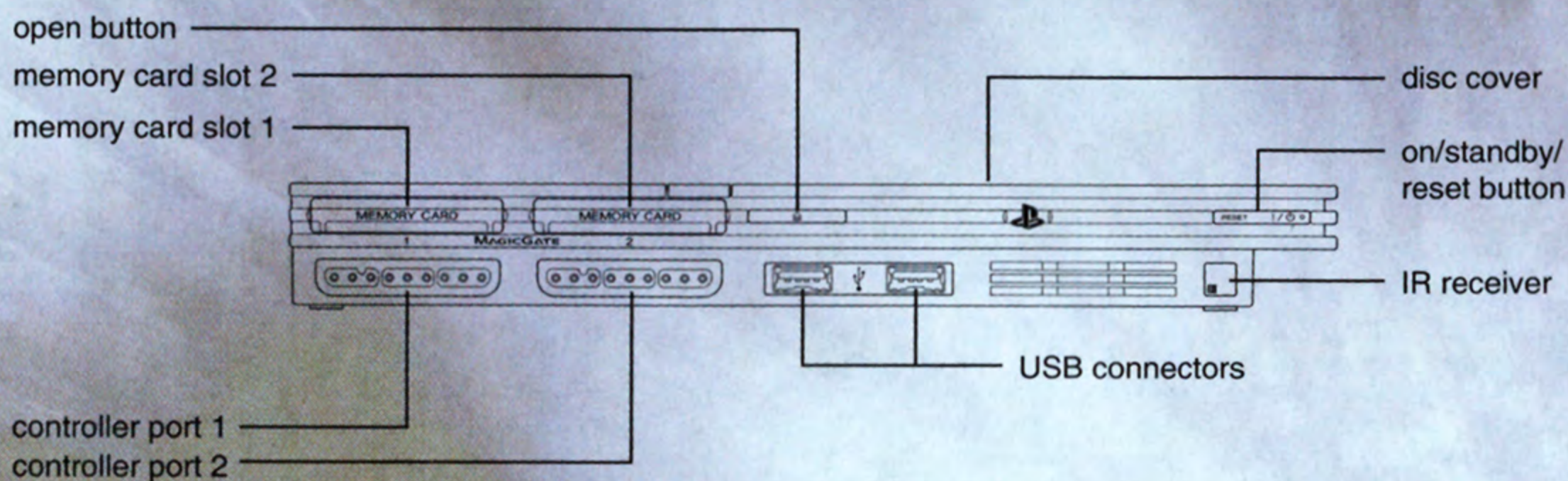

Set up your PlayStation®2 Console

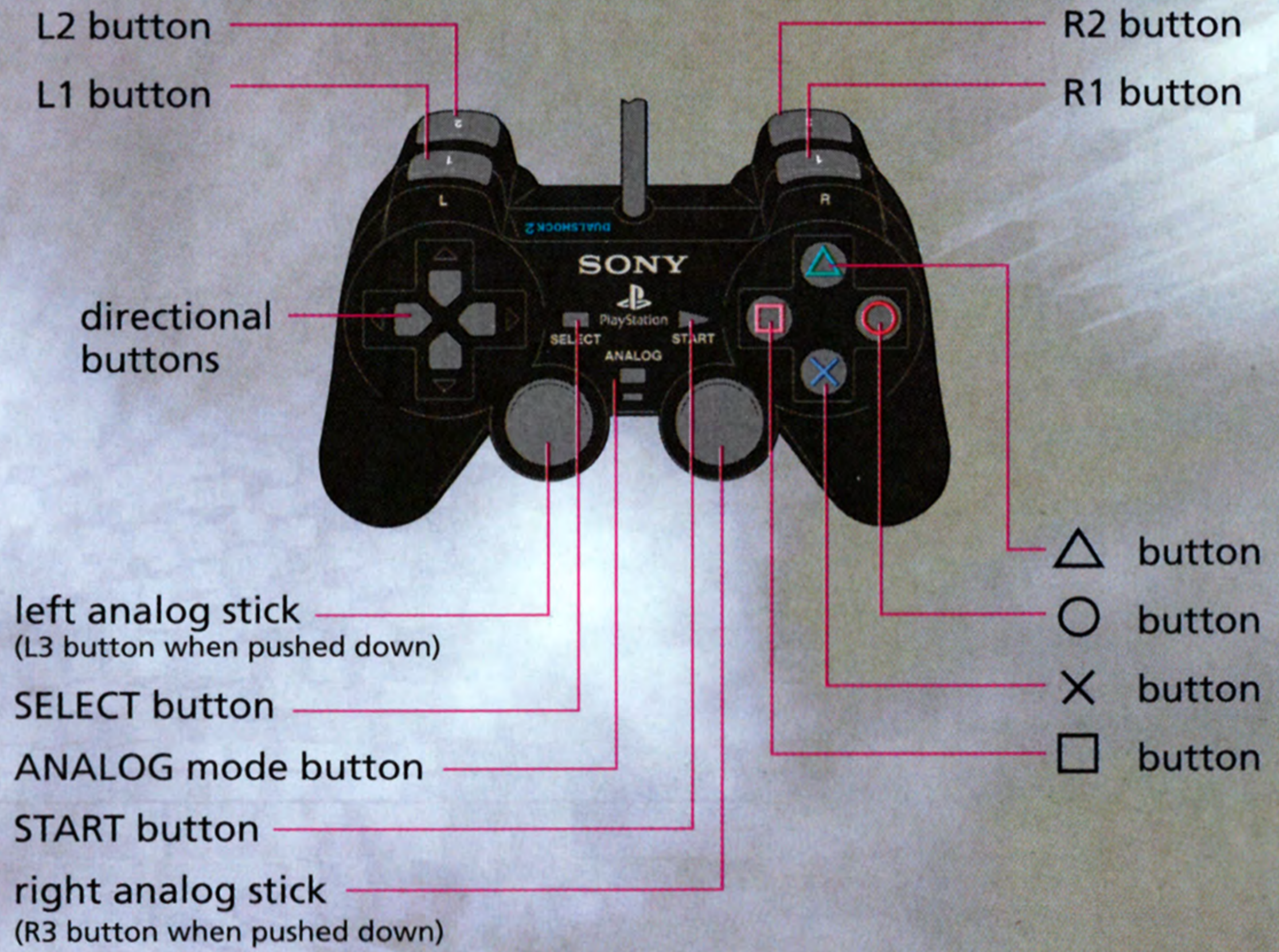
Set up your PlayStation®2 computer entertainment system according to the instructions supplied with your system. Check that the system is turned on (the on/standby indicator is green). Insert the **Heavenly Guardian™** disc in the system with the label side facing up. Attach game controllers and other peripherals as appropriate. Follow the on-screen instructions and refer to this manual for information on using the software.

Memory Card (8MB)(for PlayStation®2)

To save game settings and progress, insert a memory card (8MB)(for PlayStation®2) into MEMORY CARD slot 1 of your PlayStation®2 system. You can load saved game data from the same memory card or any memory card (8MB)(for PlayStation®2) containing previously saved games.






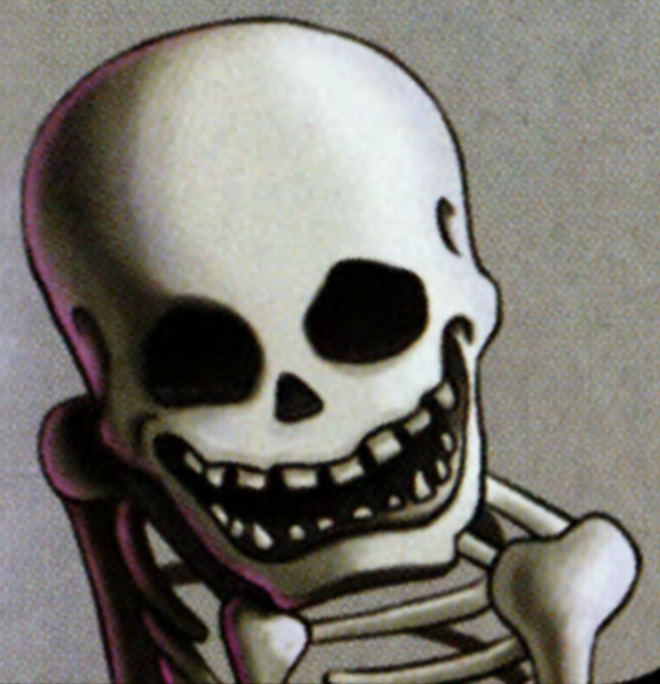
CONTROLS

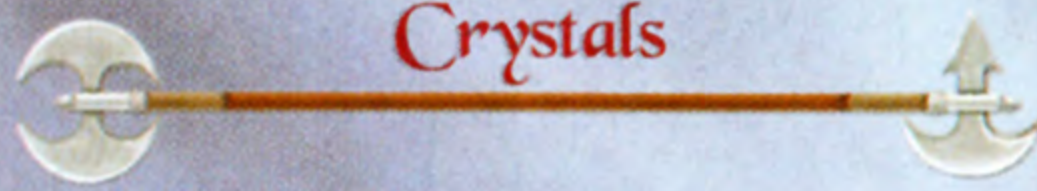

Crystals

There are four crystals that upgrade Sayuki's icicle shot. Collect more crystals to power-up each attack. Each crystal can power-up five times.

Rapid Shot

Rapid Shot

This is Sayuki's primary attack. Shoot fast single icicles.



3-Way

A spread like attack ideal for destroying enemies that surround you.

ABILITIES



Homing

Attacks and follows enemies until impact. A weak but accurate weapon.



Bomb

A slow but strong attack that deals a ton of damage.



Blizzard (Consumes 5 snowballs)

Summon a blizzard that destroys all in its path. The blizzard can also be used to slow down the bosses.



Toto's Wild Dance (Consumes 25 snowballs)

Toto will freeze and attack enemies that touch him. He will also circle around Sayuki giving her a shield-like protection.



Evade

A roll move used to dodge enemies and their attacks.

AILMENTS

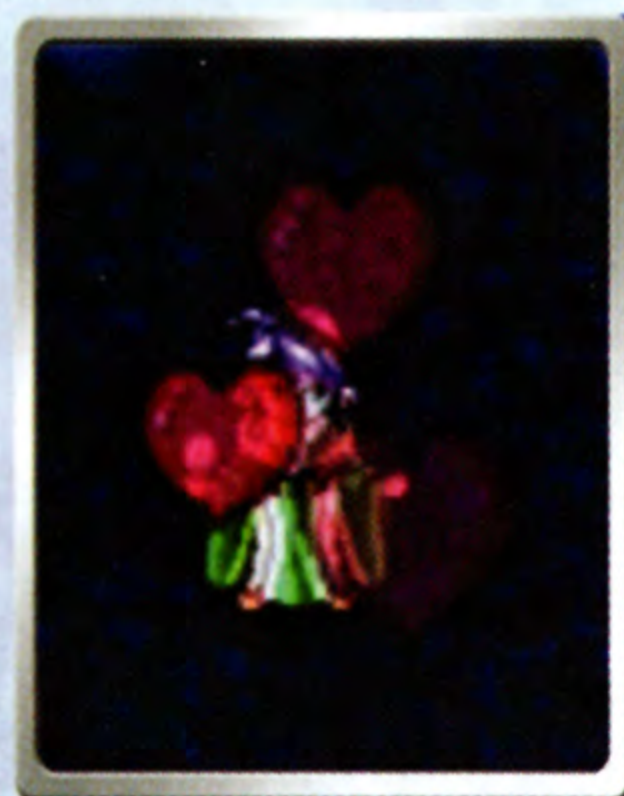


Possessed

When possessed by an enemy, the character cannot attack.

Heart Magic

When charmed by an enemy, the character will move in the opposite direction.



Spider String

When caught by a web, the character's movement will be slow.

Theft

Enemies can steal the character's power-up and score.



ITEMS



Small Snowball

Gives the player 1 snowball.



Medium Snowball

Gives the player 5 snowballs.



Large Snowball

Gives the player 25 snowballs.



Rice Ball (Small)

Restores 1 health bar.



Dango Cake

Restores 3 health bars.



Rice Ball (Large)

Fully restores the character's health.

ITEMS



Heart

Gives the player an extra life.



Snow Crystal

Collect three of these to increase the maximum health bar by one.



Old Coin

Gives the player a small amount of points.



Gold Coin

Gives the player a medium amount of points.



Haniwa Doll

Gives the player a large amount of points.

SNOW BOY

There are 10 Snow Boys hidden in each stage. To find a Snow Boy, look for an area where snow is falling. Perform a blizzard attack in that area to reveal the Snow Boy. Finding the Snow Boys will unlock New Modes and Secrets.



MODES



1 Player

Control Sayuki on her quest to save her beloved young man. Toto will fight alongside Sayuki and offer powerful aid.

2 Players

Control Sayuki and her sister Koyuki as they battle each other for title of Beauty Queen. Fight the enemies and collect the snowballs to win.



Boss Attack (Find 10 Snow Boys to unlock this mode)
Revisit the boss fights and conquer them all.

Boss Attack 2P

2 Players can revisit and battle each boss.
