

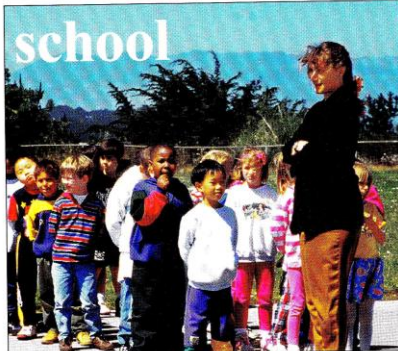

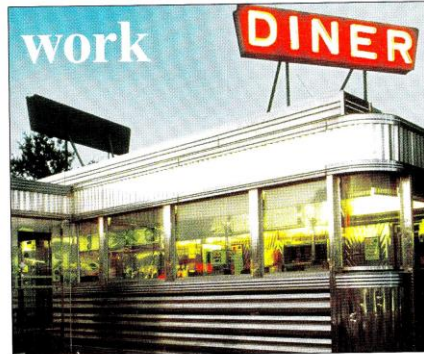


Mary Taber's kindergarten class
