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## **ABSTRACT**

### **The personal characteristics of the private school principals and their Impact on the organizational climate of the private schools in the region of Amman**

The aim of this study is to identify the personal characteristics of the private schools principals and their impact on the organizational climate of the private schools in Amman. the population of study consisted of (21500) male and female school teachers. The sample was (1799) male and female schools teachers in Amman selected randomly.

The researcher depended on the primary data resources through a questionnaire designed to develop Quantative statistical methods representing arithmetic mean, standard deviation ratios and frequencies have been used to highlight the study characteristic and theoretical frame work for the study.

- The personal characteristics have school significant impact.
  - The salient personal characteristics of school principals has introvert type where as the study sample at a percentage (ratio) 76.4% concurred to that.
  - 23.6% of the sample view that extrovert character is influencing qualities of the schools principles of the organizational climate.
- the study of recommende:- school principals, should employe the open type with school staff.

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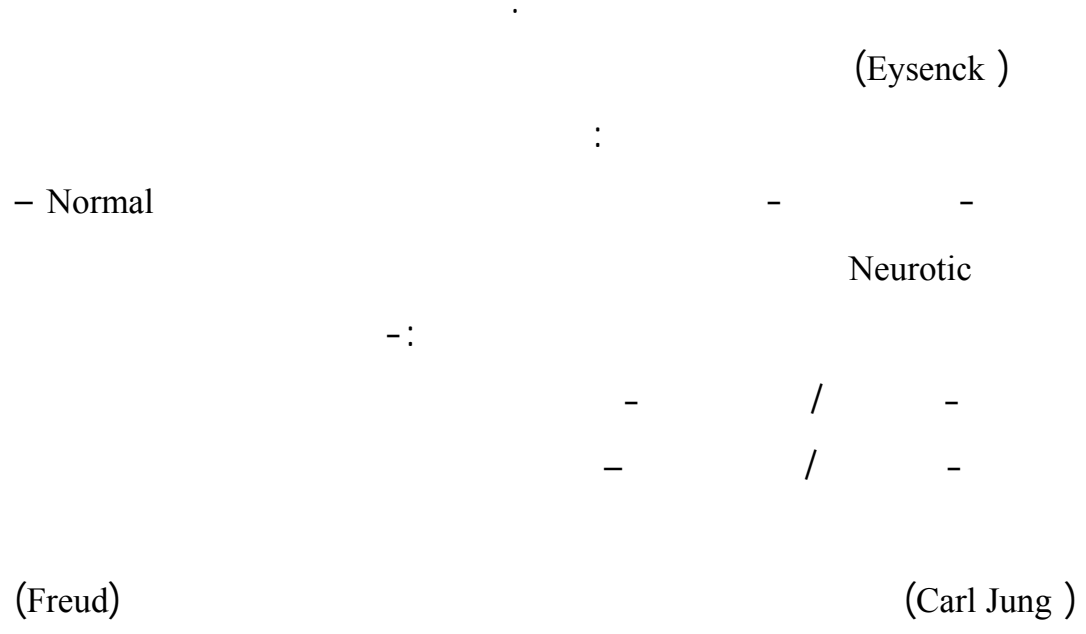

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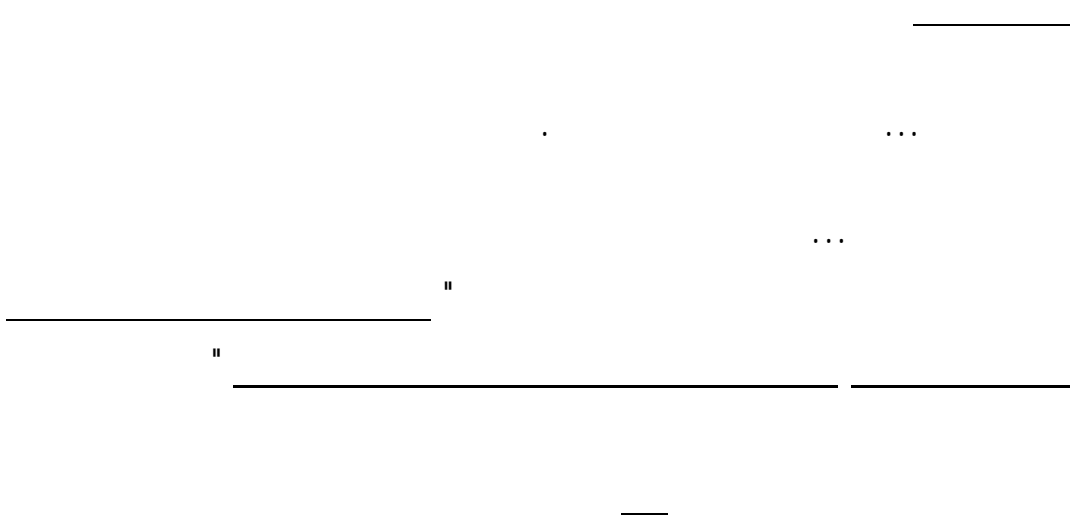
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
