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Abstract
Russian Policy toward Arab World (2000-2010)

This study aimed to closely identify Russian Foreign Policy and its relationship with Arab World from 2000 to 2010 under Vladimir Putin, focusing on the key issues that formed center of these relationships by taking up goals of Russian Foreign Policy, challenges facing them, areas of corporation in Arab-Russian relationships, and the most important determinants of Russian Foreign Policy in the Arab region, and finally, Russian position on Arab spring.

This study uses both historical and descriptive methods, and it shows that the Arab-Russian relationships have witnessed a noticeable interaction since 2000 unlike the abatement and recession during nineties of the past century. Furthermore, Russia tries to deal with Arab World as a regional entity unlike other major countries which refuse notion of "Arab World". Moreover, Russia does not seek to achieve political gains or play a security or military role competing with the intensive American presence in the Arab Region. On the contrary, Russian seeks to achieve strategic partnership with Arab countries in terms of economic and technical collaboration leading to a direct economic return in favor of Russian and a real developmental return for countries of the region.

The study ends with several recommendations; the most of important of which is that Russia should determine the key domestic and foreign challenges facing its foreign policy by taking long-term executive actions for purpose of preventing and decreasing risks of domestic and foreign challenges. Furthermore, development of Arab-Russian relationships in the next phase is subject to the ability of supporting and developing the partnership in economic, technical, and military areas, as well as maintaining political and cultural understandings between the two sides.

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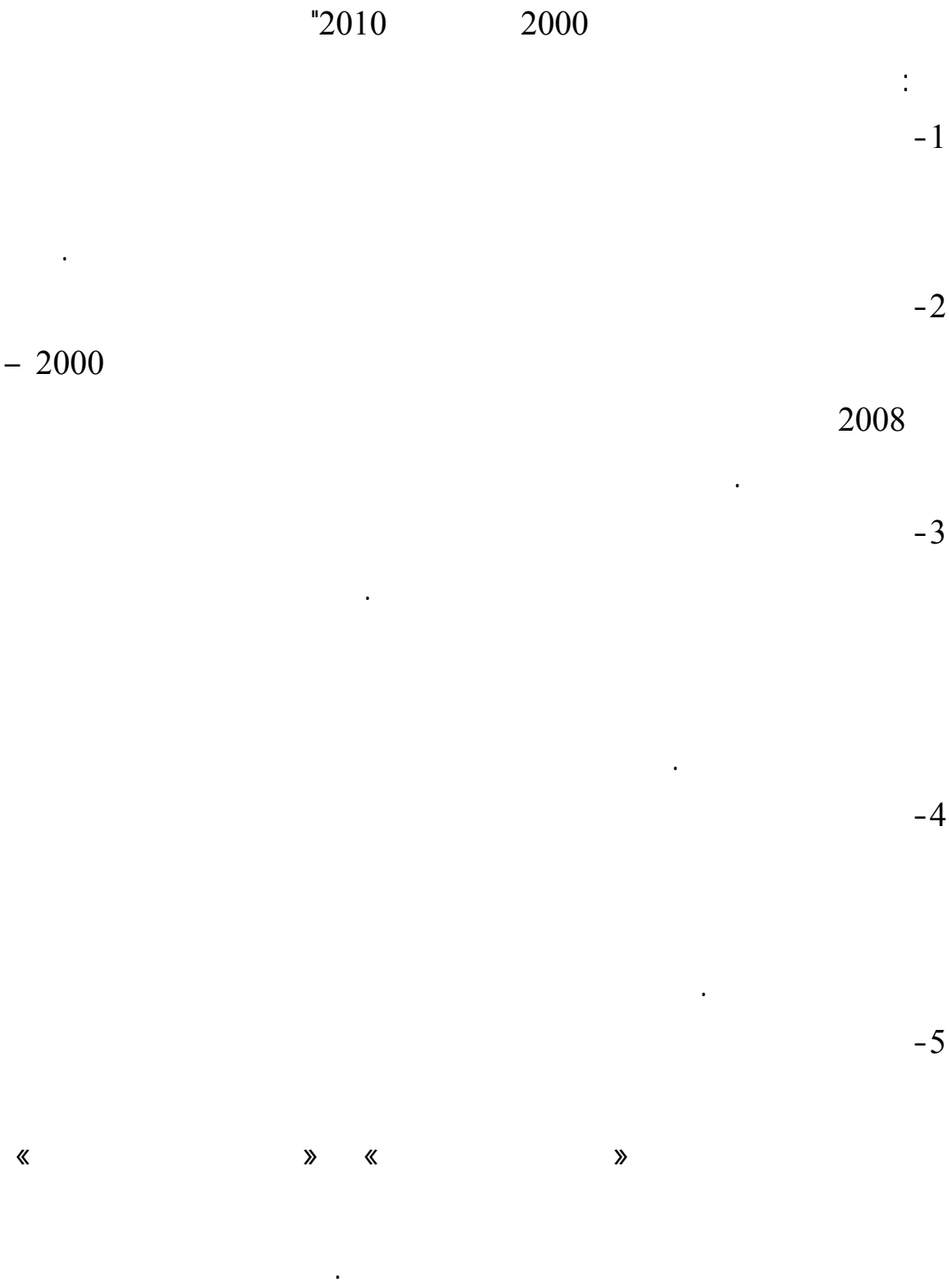
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
