PREFACE

The original Kuhns Genealogy was published in 1910 by the late Philip H. Shaub of Berwyn, Ill. The author of this revised edition has collected additional family history and endeavored to bring the genealogy down to date. In a number of instances it has been found impossible to locate certain relatives and get desired information. It is the regret of the author that these branches could not be completed. Your attention is called to the fact that any descendant of our Revolutionary ancestor, Philip Kuntz, is eligible to membership in the Sons of the American Revolution or the Daughters of the American Revolution, as the case may be. The author has taken pains to avoid mistakes in spite of the hand writing of some of his relatives. Any relative having additional information as to marriages, births and deaths should send it to him.

A GENEALOGY


The Kuhns genealogy should be written in Eastern Pennsylvania, because our ancestors first settled in Northampton County. On Dec. 26, 1738 the ship Loyal Judith with Edward Painter, commander, was cast away on Block Island and a great number were lost. There is a middle ground in the Delaware River north westward of the entrance to Woodbury Creek, with is marked on the south west end by Block Island Light. The ship had sailed from Rotterdam, Netherlands, Sept. 3, 1738 with 315 Palatines, who were Lutherans fleeing from religious persecution in their native country, Germany.

The Palatinate was a name given to the district in Germany lying on both sides of the river Rhine, about midway between its source and its mouth, and its capitals were Heidelberg and later Manheim. The two Palatinates are now provinces of Bavaria. The Rhenish-Palatinate lies on the west side of the Rhine and detached from the rest of the republic. Its capital is Spires. The Upper Palatinate is in north east Bavaria and its capital is Nuremberg. Among those passengers above mentioned, tradition places the fifteen year old boy, Bernard Kuntz, who probably came over with relatives or friends. He settled in Northampton County, Pa., at or near Cherryville where he later was buried. There he married Catherine Eberhard whose parents emigrated from Germany at the same time that he did.

To them were born six sons:
Frederich, born Dec. 25, 1746, and died March 26, 1772.
Philip, born Apr. 11, 1747 and died June 18, 1822.
George, born Apr. 8, 1751, and died Oct. 2, 1817.
Peter, born Sept. 12, 1757 and died Dec. 16, 1846.
Jacob, born Feb. 28, 1759, and died Oct. 31, 1841.

Bernard Kuntz married twice, first Catherine Eberhard and second Anna——, but we are chiefly interested in Catherine. The inscriptions on the tomb stone are:

"Here lies in the hope of the resurrection of the dead, Bernard Kuntz. He was born on the 3rd day of December in the year of our Lord 1723 and he died on the 14th day of July in the year of our Lord 1807, having reached the age of 83 years, 7 months and two weeks." The inscription on Catherine's is: "Here lies buried the deceased, first wife of Bernard Kuntz. She was born in the year 1723. Her name was Catherine Eberhard. She died the 17th of September, 1780, aged 57 years." These tombs are in St. Paul's church yard at Cherryville.

After Greensburg in Westmorland Co., was founded, Philip moved to that place and bought quite a bit of property. There he reared his family and there died June 18, 1822, age seventy-five years. Emma Margaretha died Jan. 16, 1837, aged eighty-three years. They were buried in the old German Lutheran Reformed Cemetery which denomination had been founded in Greensburg and vicinity largely through his efforts. Philip Kuntz, son of Bernard Kuntz, was a man prominent in Colonial affairs. He was one of the many signers of a petition to the Penns begging protection from Indians who were raiding the country. We have not been able to discover his actual service during the Revolution, but tradition says that he served under Boquet and participated in the battle of Bushy Run. He took the Oath of Allegiance, the original of which is still in the family. The original differed in the spelling.

"I do hereby certify that Philip Kuntz of Westmorland County hath voluntarily taken and subscribed the Oath, Affirmation of Allegiance and Fidelity as directed by an act of General Assembly of Pennsylvania passed the 13th day of June 1778." "Seal" "Chistopher Truby"

John Kuntz, son of Bernard Kuntz and brother of Philip, married Elizabeth Marchand, daughter of Dr. David Marchand. She had a long pedigree back of her. They had ten children, only seven of them being known, the others probably dying young. Jacob, Daniel, David, Reuben, Joseph, Samuel and Eliza.

In 1911, John Kuhns, residing at 427 W. Pittsburg St., Greensburg, Pa., a great grandson of John Kuntz, worked out three generations of his descendents and intended to publish his findings. Luther M. Kuhns, 2433 Franklin St., Omaha, Aug. 10, 1910 writes of some of his investigations. From his uncle Philip S. Kuhns and his father he obtained quite a bit of family history. At his home in Greensburg, Pa., Philip S. Kuhns showed relatives several Revolutionary papers and one he remembers distinctly was the commission of Philip Kuntz as lieutenant in the Continental army. These papers were in a little desk in the sitting room at the time of the visit. His father and several cousins vouch for having seen them.

There are different variations of the spelling of the name "Kuhns." The original German spelling and that used on the tomb of Bernard was "Kuntz," but in these papers which have come down to us we find many different spellings, such as Countz, Cuntz, Cons, Kons, Kuns, Counze and Koons. The oath of allegiance was signed "Philip Conz." The first time that we came across the spelling "Kuhns" was in the will of Philip, on record in the Court House at Greensburg, Pa. Since then that spelling has been used.

There are many descendants of Bernard Kuntz scattered throughout Pennsylvania and other states. A member of the family who has traveled widely in Pennsylvania in search of family history, told the writer of this genealogy that the eastern portion of the state was "full of the Kuhns people."

FIRST GENERATION

Bernard Kuntz was born in the Palatinate, Germany, Dec. 3, 1723, at the age of 15 years he was brought by his elders to Cherryville, Northampton County, on the eastern border of Pennsylvania. There he later married Catherine Eberhard, born 1723, whose parents had emigrated from Germany at the same time that he came. Six sons were born to this union: Frederich, born Dec. 25, 1746, died March 26, 1772; Philip, born April 11, 1747, died June 16, 1822; George, born April 8, 1751, died Oct. 2, 1817; Peter, born Sept. 12, 1757, died Dec. 16, 1846; Jacob, born Feb. 28, 1759, died Oct. 31, 1841. John's date of birth is not known but he died in 1823. Bernard's second wife was Anna ———, born Jan. 1724, and died Nov. 25, 1804, age 80 years. We do not know of any children born to this second union. They lived all their lives at Cherryville and are buried there. Philip died July 14, 1807 and Catherine Sept. 17, 1780.

SECOND GENERATION

The only two sons of Bernard that we know anything about are Philip and John. About 1770 or 1780 they moved to Westmorland County in south-western Pennsylvania.

Philip Kuntz married Emma Margaretha Steinbach, daughter of Philip Steinbach and Christina Kuntz residing in Northampton County, Pa. She was born Jan. 5, 1754 and died Jan 16, 1837, aged 83 years. Philip died June 18, 1822, aged 75 years. They had ten children; Katherine, Jacob, Elizabeth, Philip, Mary, John, Susan, Margaret, Hannah and Sophia. The family lived at Greensburg, Pa.


John Kuntz married Elizabeth Marchand, daughter of Dr. David Marchand. They had ten children, only seven being now known, the others probably dying young. They were Jacob, Daniel, David, Reuben, Joseph, Samuel and Eliza.

THIRD GENERATION

Our ancestor next in line is Philip Kuhns, a man of small stature. His farm was two miles south-east of Greensburg, Pa., and a part of it was converted into a cemetery called Hill View, and there he and a number of his descendants are buried. At the age of 67 he was thrown from a horse and trampled on so that he died a few days after, Sept. 9, 1848. He was twice married. His first wife was Elizabeth Felgar, who was born in 1783 and died Dec. 19, 1825. To this union were born Jacob, Oct. 4, 1806; Daniel, Nov. 6, 1808; Mary M., March 9, 1811; Henry, Sept. 24, 1813; Philip, June 23, 1816; Eliza, May 17, 1820; Margaret, July 8, 1823. His second wife was Margaret Bosch Rumbaugh, who died Jan. 2, 1838. To this union were born Joseph, July 16, 1827; Martin, March 19, 1829; Susan, Nov. 19, 1830; and three whose names could not be deciphered on the record were born April 14, 1832, Aug. 6, 1834, July 19, 1936. One of these was possibly named John, as there was a John in the family. The incompleteness of this genealogy is again shown by the fact that nothing can be learned of the descendants of the children of this second union except that John and Martin moved to and died in the West. And of the first marriage, the descendants of the last daughter, Margaret, have dropped from sight. It is known that she married a man by the name of Woodburn Kincaid, was the mother of several children, and died. Mr. Kincaid married again and moved to the West, where all trace of them has been lost.

FOURTH GENERATION

Jacob Kuhns' first wife was Elizabeth Shoop. She was the daughter of Michael Shoop and Jane Royer, who lived in Montgomery County, Pa. She became the mother of their only child, Eliza L., June 1, 1836, at Leechburg, Pa. His second wife was born May 13, 1819, in the state of Ohio, and died Sept. 8, 1851. Her name was Catherine Kircher, who was a daughter of John Kircher and Eva Moller. To this union were born Margaret, Dec. 14, 1838; Mary, Jan. 6, 1840; Henrietta, June 20, 1842; Harriet, Feb. 2, 1845; Rolena, Dec. 19, 1846; Henry Albert, Oct. 16, 1849; Catherine, Sept. 5, 1851. It is thought that Mary died in infancy, Harriet at the age of 15, and Catherine lived only a few days, her



mother preceding her. These children all claimed Marine, Ill., as their native town and it was here the father lived up to within six months of his death. He died near Clinton, Mo., Sept., 1882.

Daniel Kuhns married an only daughter of a Greenburg, Pa., resident and was the father of an only son, Joseph, who lived about six miles from Greensburg.

Mary M. Kuhns was married Aug. 23, 1832, to John M. Hugus, who was born April 16, 1807. To them were born Anna Elizabeth, April 15, 1834; Kathryn, Nov. 11, 1835; Simon D., April 9, 1837; Nicholas H., June 21, 1839; Mary M., Aug. 24, 1841; John R., March 6, 1843; Sophia M., March 5, 1845; Philip R., Jan. 9, 1848; Samuel E., May 3, 1849; George L., Feb. 21, 1852; William Ezra, Oct. 8, 1854. Of these five died in infancy, near Greensburg as follows: Mary and John, Aug. 18, 1848; Sophia, Aug. 26, 1848; Philip, Aug. 21, 1848; Samuel, May 9, 1853. The husband and father died Feb. 22, 1879, at Hortons, Pa. His wife survived him sixteen years, dying June 26, 1895.

Henry Kuhns was married to Margaret Thompson, Oct. 30, 1837, and lived at Mt. Pleasant, Pa., where their children were born. They were Mary J., born Sept. 2, 1838; John, May 20, 1840, and Eliza, July 2, 1844. The husband and father died Sept. 20, 1845, aged 32. His wife died a few years later and the children were raised by three different uncles. They saw little of each other and hardly seemed related.

Philip Kuhns married Sybilla Rugh and moved to Scotch Grove, Iowa. It has been said that they had three sons.

Eliza Kuhns was married April 10, 1845, to John Rugh, who was born Feb. 20, 1823. They had seven children, namely, Oliver, Mary, Cyrus, Joanna, Amanda, John and Elizabeth. The mother died Feb. 9, 1901, and the father, April 23, 1906, both having lived to a venerable old age in their native town.

FIFTH GENERATION

The Jacob Kuhns Family

Eliza L. Kuhns was married at Leechburg Pa., Dec. 16, 1855, to William Black who was born Oct. 15, 1826. They moved to a farm north-east of LaSalle, Ill., where they raised their family and lived to the end of their lives. Children were born to this union as follows: Thomas Kuhns, was born at Morris, Ill., Oct. 2, 1856; James J., in the city of LaSalle, May 8, 1858; Mary Elizabeth, at LaSalle, Aug. 29, 1860; Alice Maud, near LaSalle, Aug. 7, 1869; William Charles, near LaSalle, Jan. 26, 1875; Edith May, near LaSalle, Nov. 26, 1878. The wife and mother died Jan. 20, 1902, and was followed by her husband Oct. 30, 1903. Both are buried in the cemetery at Troy. Grove, a few miles north of their former home.

Margaret Kuhns was married at Marine, Ill., on March 15, 1860, to Henry Herman Gottenstrater, who was born in Hesse, Darmstadt, Germany, Sept. 17, 1834. They always lived on a farm near Marine, and in this vicinity all their descendants live. Their children were: Mary Agnes,



born Jan. 6, 1861; William Jacob, Aug. 12, 1863; Emma Etta, Aug. 29, 1866; Henry Louis, Aug. 20, 1869. The husband and father died Aug. 23, 1901. The writer was not able to find the date and place of death of the mother.

Henrietta Kuhns was married on Sept. 19, 1869, at Marine, Ill., to Francis Louis Shaub, who was born at Lichtenau, Hesse Cassel, Germany, Dec. 12, 1843. With the exception of two years, when they lived near Edgewood, Ill., they had lived on farms in the vicinity of Marine, Ill. In 1903 they moved to Highland, Ill. Their children were: Philip Harmon, born at Marine, Ill., June 19, 1870, and Nellie May, born June 5, 1876, at Edgewood. Henrietta died Feb. 17, 1904. Francis L., died Sept. 6, 1923.

Rolena Kuhns married Adam Oberlin on Nov. 24, 1868. He was a native of Indiana, having been born there July 12, 1845. They lived near Marine until about 1877, when they moved to Tarrant County, Texas. They were the parents of eight children; infant daughter, Aug. 23, 1869; Estella Elizabeth, Aug. 9, 1870; George Allen, Jan. 28, 1873; Nettie Rolena, Sept. 9, 1875; infant daughter, Aug. 30, 1878; Elmer Curtis, Oct. 15, 1879; Addie May, Aug. 24, 1882; infant son, Nov. 19, 1885. Elmer Curtis died April 8, 1881. Rolena died Nov. 23, 1885. The father and husband died Jan. 17, 1907. Grapevine, Texas, was the family home.

Henry Albert Kuhns was married to Margaret Shart at Smithport, Pa., Nov. 11, 1875. She was born in New York City, Feb. 13, 1844. They made their home near Marine, Ill., for about 4 years, when they moved to West Point, Kansas. They moved back to Marine about the year 1894. They later moved to Burlingame, Kansas, where they resided on their own farm. They were the parents of five children; William Henry, Oct. 14, 1876; John Jacob, March 17, 1878; George Elmer, Feb. 28, 1880; Margaret Belle, March 5, 1882; James Albert, July 23, 1885. John died March 21, 1896. The father died Oct. 28, 1923, at Assaria, Kansas. The mother died at Assaria, Kansas on May 12, 1927.

The John M. Hugus Family

Ann Elizabeth Hugus became the wife of Samuel States on Sept. 18, 1856, in Indiana County, Pa. He was born Feb. 15, 1833, in the same county. The first three children were born in Indiana County, Pa., Keithsville, Mo., and Marysville, Iowa, respectively, the latter place being the birthplace of the remainder of the family and the place where the mother died April 15, 1905. Their children were born as follows: Joanna, May 6, 1857, Mary Susan, April 8, 1859; Sophia Katherine, Oct. 24, 1861; Allie, May 30, 1862; Jane, May 11, 1864; Lucy, Sept. 6, 1866; Adam, Jan. 11, 1871; John, Oct. 23, 1874. Mary Susan died Aug. 25, 1866.

Catherine Hugus was married to Lawrence McQuown May 6,1886. She had no children. She died at Canoe Ridge, Pa., March 3, 1909.

Simon D. Hugus was married at Franklin City, Pa., to Winnifred Fay on July 4, 1866. She was born in Ireland, Sept. 27, 1848. They had two sons, William Ezra, who is dead and Robert James, born Jan. 24, 1869.

Nicholas Hugus married Margaret P. Watson at Philadelphia, Pa., on Dec. 4, 1877. She was born Aug. 18, 1842. They had no children.



George L. Hugus married Mary Henry, a native of Indiana County, Pa., on Feb. 21, 1878. She was born March 28, 1852. They were the parents of three children. They lived at Rochester Mills, Pa.

William Ezra Hugus became the husband of Mary Emelia Wetzel, a native of Clarion County, Pa., on March 11, 1880. She was born April 12, 1862. The family home was at Knox, Pa. To these parents were born five children: Kate May, Feb. 17, 1881; John Edward, March 24, 1886; George Lloyd, June 2, 1890; Edgar Stanley, June 21, 1896; William Oscar, Aug. 17, 1904. John died at the age of twenty, Aug. 24, 1906.

The Henry Kuhns Family

Mary J. Kuhns became the wife of John Ruff, Jan. 7, 1858. They resided near Greensburg, Pa. They were the parents of three children; Laura Ida, born Sept. 20, 1860; Maggie, Oct. 25, 1862; Norman, Dec. 11, 1872.

John Kuhns was raised by his uncle, Daniel Kuhns. He enlisted in the Civil War and was flag bearer in the Battle of Fredericksburg. In this battle he lost a leg and received other wounds. After the war he married and was the father of two daughters, the second not having been born when he died, in Pittsburg. His wife died soon after and their children were raised by their maternal grandmother, being known by her name. They married and live in Pittsburg.

Eliza Kuhns married David Brady. They had no children. Both died in Pittsburg, Pa.

SIXTH GENERATION The William Black Family

Thomas Kuhns Black on March 15, 1882, married Alice E. Hamel, who was born near LaSalle, Ill., on Oct. 26, 1857. She is the eldest daughter of Johannes Hamel and Lucy Riggs. Her father was born Aug. 27, 1823, at Hatzbach, Hessen Cassell, Germany. He died July 26. 1888 near LaSalle, Ill. Her mother, Lucy Riggs was born May 17, 1835 at Pottsville, Pa., and died at LaSalle, Ill., Dec. 23, 1908. They were married Dec. 25, 1852 at LaSalle, Ill. Thomas K. died March 21, 1927, at Jefferson, Iowa, and his widow still lives there. They had two children, John Roland, who was born March 15, 1883, near LaSalle, Ill., and Bessie Vane, who was born near Jefferson, Iowa on Sept. 19, 1885.

James J. Black married Minnie Peters on May 29, 1884 at LaSalle, Ill., the native town of both. She was born Aug. 21, 1866, the daughter of James Peters and Elizabeth Pherson. Their children were born near LaSalle, Ill., as follows: Ida Maud, April 4, 1885; Charles Earl, July 21, 1887; Jeane Elizabeth, March 26, 1893 and William James, July 21, 1895.

Mary Elizabeth Black became the wife of George Johnson Shinn on Jan. 8, 1885, at LaSalle, Ill. He was born at Lebanon, N. J., Dec. 20, 1859, the son of William Shinn and Katherine Hirsch. Their children, all born at Streator, Ill., are: Fannie Lloyd, Oct. 22, 1885; Fred William, Oct. 15, 1887; and George Black, March 18, 1893. The father died at their home in Ames, Iowa, July 31, 1926. Mrs. Shinn now resides in Des Moines, Iowa.



Alice Maud Black was married to John Boyd Forbes, Feb. 3, 1892, at LaSalle, Ill. He was born at Bloomington, Ill., Oct. 12, 1863, a son of Andrew Forbes and Christie Ann McMillan. While residing at Jefferson, Iowa, four children were born to them, Russel B., Jan. 4, 1893, who lived less than a month, dying Feb. 3, 1893. Lowell Lynn was born Jan. 17, 1894; Muriel McMillan on June 30, 1896, and Gretchen, Aug. 15, 1910. The father died on Nov. 13, 1929 at Dexter, Iowa.

William Charles Black married Gertrude Sweet at LaSalle, Ill., on Feb. 14, 1898. She was born March 4, 1880 at LaSalle, Ill., the daughter of Marcus Sweet and Mary Pepson. They had two children, Isabelle, born at Chicago on June 22, 1900, and William Charles Jr., born at LaSalle, on Dec. 16, 1901. The home address is 7836 S. Morgan St., Chicago.

Edith May Black became the wife of Arthur Ethelfred Jackson at Ottawa, Ill., on Feb. 8, 1898. He was born Aug. 25, 1875 at Pickering, Ontario, Canada, the son of James Jackson and Mary Jane Fielding. His father was born May 30, 1849 in County Anthrum, Ireland; and he died May 11, 1925 at Winterset, Iowa. His mother was born Nov. 14, 1856, at Liverpool, England, and died May 6, 1921 at Winterset, Iowa. His parents were married March 8, 1873 at Pickering, Ontario, Canada.

The four Jackson children were born as follows: Charles William, born Feb. 19, 1899 at Gault, Iowa; Vivian Eliza, born Oct. 24, 1902 at Gault, Iowa; Raymond Russell, born Aug. 16, 1906 at Winterset, Iowa, and Paul Eugene, born Feb. 18, 1916 at Winterset, Iowa.

The Henry Herman Gottenstrater Family

Mary Agnes Gottenstrater married Willam Henry Pence Jan. 3, 1893, at Marine, Ill., the native town of both. He was born Dec. 23, 1857. Their children are Leola Margaret, born Dec. 18, 1893; Florence Mary, Jan. 24, 1896; George Herman, Oct. 15, 1897; Russell William, March 11, 1900; Ruth Emma, April 2, 1907. Florence Mary died Jan. 8, 1897.

William J. Gottenstrater married Eva Ann Stuckwisch Nov. 25, 1887 at Marine, Ill., where both were born. She was born April 26, 1866. Two children were born at Marine, Ill.; Erwin William Herman, Nov. 14, 1889; and Amy Alvena, Oct. 28, 1904. The mother died Aug. 25, 1904 and the father Feb. 19, 1938.
