Toole County

Located in northern Montana, Toole County is Montana's 34th most populous with 5,267 residents, according to the 2000 Census.

Shelby, the county seat, is the state's 25th largest city with a population of 3,216. Toole County, established in 1914, is named for Joseph K. Toole, Montana's first governor. According to the *Montana Almanac*, by authors Andrea Merrill and Judy Jacobson, Shelby was named for Peter Shelby, a railroad executive. The authors add it became a wild boom town after the Kevin-Sunburst oil field was discovered in 1920.

The Port of Sweetgrass, 35 miles north of Shelby, is the major port entry on the Alaska-Canada highway. It's the busiest port between Blaine, Wash. and Pembina, N.D.

According to the U.S. Bureau of the Census, median income for Toole County households in 1997 was \$30,673. The county is 1,945.8 square miles in area; 1,910.9 square miles in land area and 34.9 in inland water area.

County residents experience the four distinct seasons. According to the *Western Regional Climate Center*, the average minimum temperature in Shelby (airport readings) in January between 1971 and 2000 was 7.4 degrees above zero. The average maximum temperature in July was 82.8 degrees above. The annual precipitation during the same period was 9.29 inches and the growing season was from May 21 to Sept. 13 (last and first frost).
