








FIG. 7. LADY HARRISON. \$90 TO \$135.




FIG. 9. MUFF AND BOA IN ALL KINDS OF FURS. FROM \$5 TO \$25.




FIG. 19. THE ROSEDALE, \$5.50 TO \$10.50. FIG. 20. THE LYNDHURST. \$8.25 TO \$15.






FIG. 21. THE AVERNE. \$15 TO \$30 FIG. 22. THE NORMANDIE. \$16.50 TO \$35.


FIG. 28. THE BIJOU. \$7 TO \$10





# Repairs.

If your garments need altering or repairing, have it attended to in the summer months, for the following reasons: First, *economy*; as it will cost you less at this season of the year when labor is cheap and very little repairing to be done, and also to avoid the delay of trying to get it done when the busy season sets in; and how pleasant it is to have a warm garment ready to put on at the first cold snap.
