Edmund John Eyre (1767 - 1816)

This is a contemporary adaptation for the stage of Sir Walter Scott's narrative poem *The Lady of the Lake* (1810). Set in the Trossachs region of Scotland, it tells three stories: the contest among three men, Roderick Dhu, James Fitz-James, and Malcolm Graeme, to win the love of Ellen Douglas; the feud and reconciliation of King James V of Scotland and James Douglas; and a war between the lowland Scots (led by James V) and the highland clans (led by Roderick Dhu of Clan Alpine). Scott's poem was tremendously influential in the nineteenth century, and inspired the Highland Revival.
