but about being **Unmarried**.

CHALLENGE AND PERSPECTIVE FOR SINGLES • FOR OTHERS

Matthew 19:8-12 (p. 689)

THE NARRATIVE • SINGLE = CELIBATE (EUNUCHS ESTEEMED!) According to Jesus:

Those who **<u>c</u> a** <u>n</u> accept celibacy <u>**s** h o u l d</u>.

JESUS CALLS IT SOMETHING THAT IS "GIVEN"

Jesus on the "Gift" of Singleness / Celibacy

- You were <u>**born**</u> that way.
 THOSE WITH NO NATURAL DESIRE FOR BIBLICAL SEXUALITY
- You were <u>m a d e</u> that way.
 THOSE WHO BY CIRCUMSTANCES ARE UNABLE (MAYBE SOCIETALLY INELIGIBLE)
- You have <u>C h O S E N</u> it for the sake of God's kingdom. FOCUS HEART ON KINGDOM RELATIONSHIPS? FOCUS TIME ON KINGDOM WORK? FINDING SATISFACTION IN CHRIST // GREAT WORK: NUNS, MONKS, MISSIONARIES -> PAUL

1 Corinthians 7 (p. 796)

VV 1-2 & 6-7 // SEXUALITY = MARRIAGE // PAUL IS EXPERIENCING A "GIFT" CHARISMA FROM GOD!

Paul on the "Gift" of Singleness / Celibacy

MEANINGS: SPECIAL GRACE / ALL WHO HAVE THAT POSITION / THOSE WITH SELF-CONTROL

- vv. 25-28: Singleness spares you many <u>troubles</u>.
 "THE PRESENT CRISIS" = PERSECUTION?
- vv. 29-31: Marriage, like everything else is <u>temporary</u>. PEOPLE ARE ETERNAL, RELATIONSHIPS CAN BE, BUT MARRIAGE ISN'T
- vv. 32-35: Marriage divides your **<u>devotion</u>**. IF YOU ARE MARRIED, BE MARRIED ALL THE WAY. IF YOU AREN'T, THEN BE SINGLE ALL THE WAY.

The Privilege of Singleness

Those who are not married are **<u>e m o t i o n a l l y</u>**

<u>f</u> <u>r</u> <u>e</u> <u>e</u> to build an eternal, undivided devotion to God.</u>
