# **Genesis Review**

- st God made a good universe culminating with humans to represent him.

[1-4 • 5-7] • CAMPAIGN MAP • 8-12 • WHY ALL THIS? NOW IT'S PERSONAL! 13-16 • WHEN LOT IS CAPTURED, ABRAM ROUTS FOUR GREAT KINGS WITH 318 MEN! NOT SURE WHICH IS MORE IMPRESSIVE :: MILITARY MIGHT • LOYALTY TO LOT 17-24 • CONSIDER ALL THE WAYS ABRAM IS A DIFFERENT MAN

The Covenant - Genesis 15

WE LEARN ONE THING ABOUT ABRAM AND A LOT ABOUT GOD ALL IN VERSE 1

## Ge 15:1

The fundamental relationship God wants with Abram is one where

Abram realizes that **<u>GOD</u>** is **<u>ALL</u>** he <u>**NEEDS**</u>.

## Ge 15:2-6

## SIMPLE HONEST QUESTION

Abram believed the LORD, and he credited it to him as righteousness.

Genesis 15:6

DEFINE RIGHTEOUSNESS AS DOING THE RIGHT THING, BEING IN RIGHT STANDING.

\* Righteousness is something God "**CREDITS**" to people. THE ROOT OF "BELIEVE" • A-M-N • AMEN, CONVICTION, PILLAR OR COLUMN

# \* Righteousness comes from a **FIRM <u>COMMITMENT</u></u>**

AT THIS POINT, GOD HAS GIVEN NO PROOF, ABRAM IS TRUSTING THE PERSON NOT THE PROOF.

\* Righteousness comes from accepting what **<u>GOD</u>SAYS**.

NOTHING SPIRITUAL IN THIS COMMITMENT • PRACTICAL • NOW IN SIMPLE TERMS • "OKAY" THAT'S WHAT GOD HAS WANTED SINCE THE GARDEN... FOR PEOPLE TO SAY "OKAY" TO HIM!

# Righteousness begins when we say "<u>**O K**</u>" to <u>**G O D**</u>.

## Ge 15:7-17

#### ABRAM ALREADY BELIEVES, BUT HE STILL WANTS TO KNOW... AND THAT'S OKAY! STOP AT VERSE 17

Those who have violated my covenant and have not fulfilled the terms of the covenant they made before me, I will treat like the calf they cut in two and then walked between its pieces. The leaders of Judah and Jerusalem, the court officials, the priests and all the people of the land who walked between the pieces of the calf, I will deliver into the hands of their enemies who want to kill them. Their dead bodies will become food for the birds and the wild animals.

Jeremiah 34:18-20
