






The second man was suffering from baldness. Hair would not grow on his head at all while the third man was blind. One day Allah decided to test the three men. He sent an angel to all of them one by one.





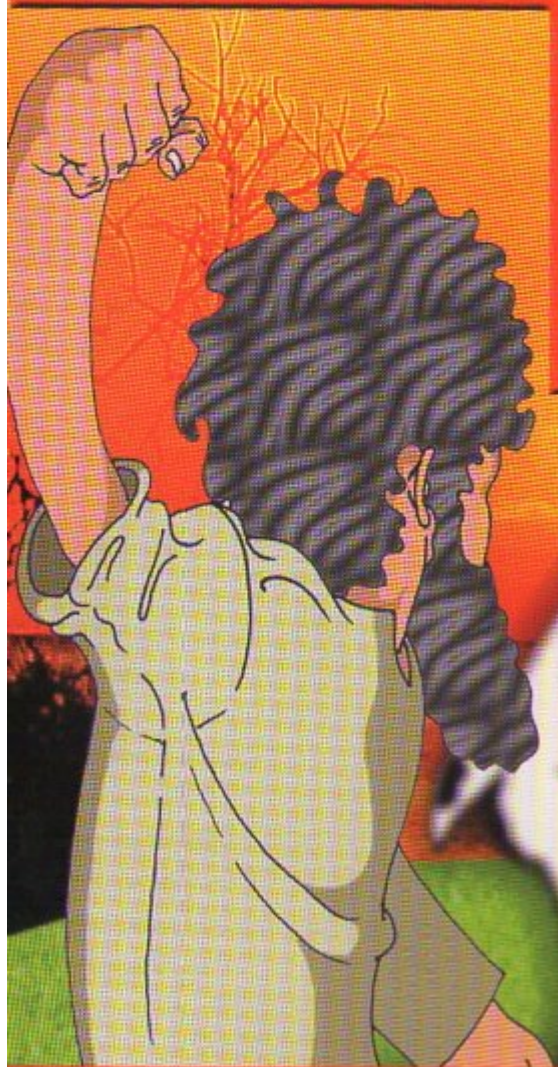
"Look at my beautiful skin!"

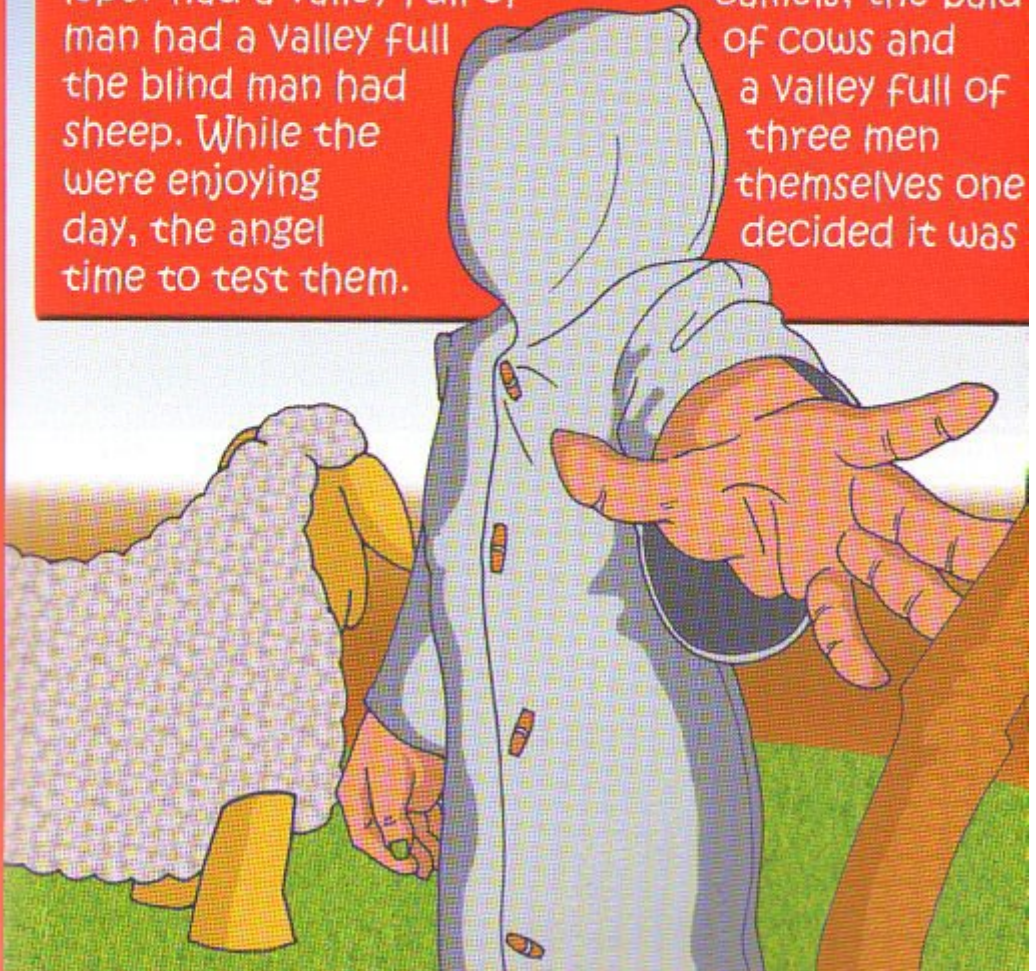
"Cows!" He replied. The angel gave him a pregnant cow and prayed for him while handing the cow over. He became very happy and so the angel left to go to the blind man.



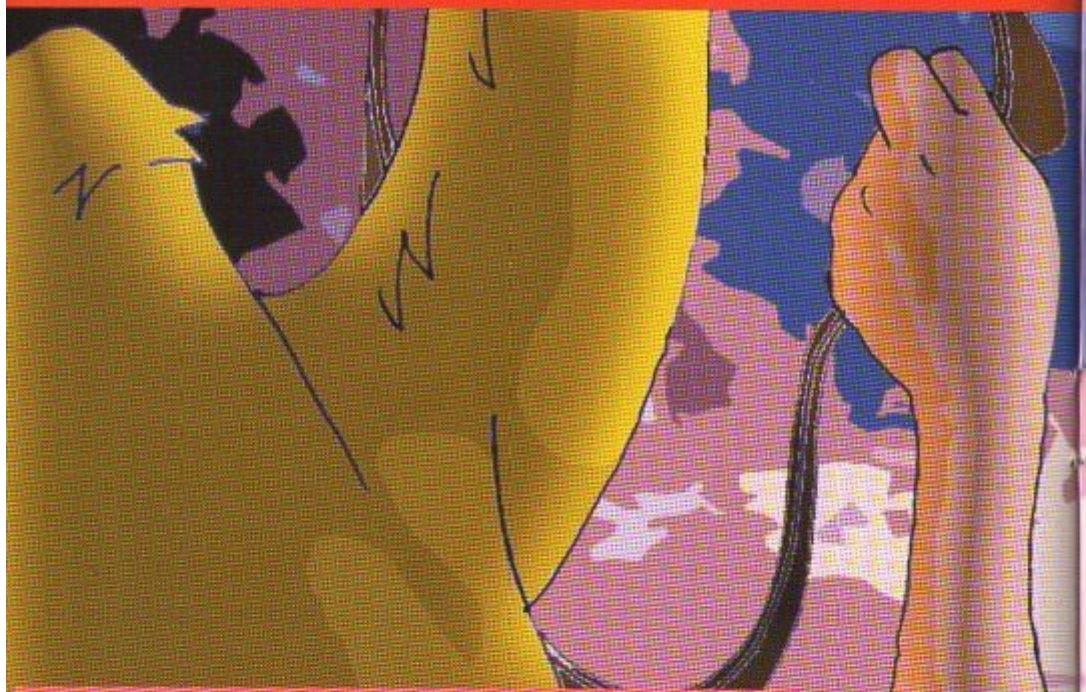

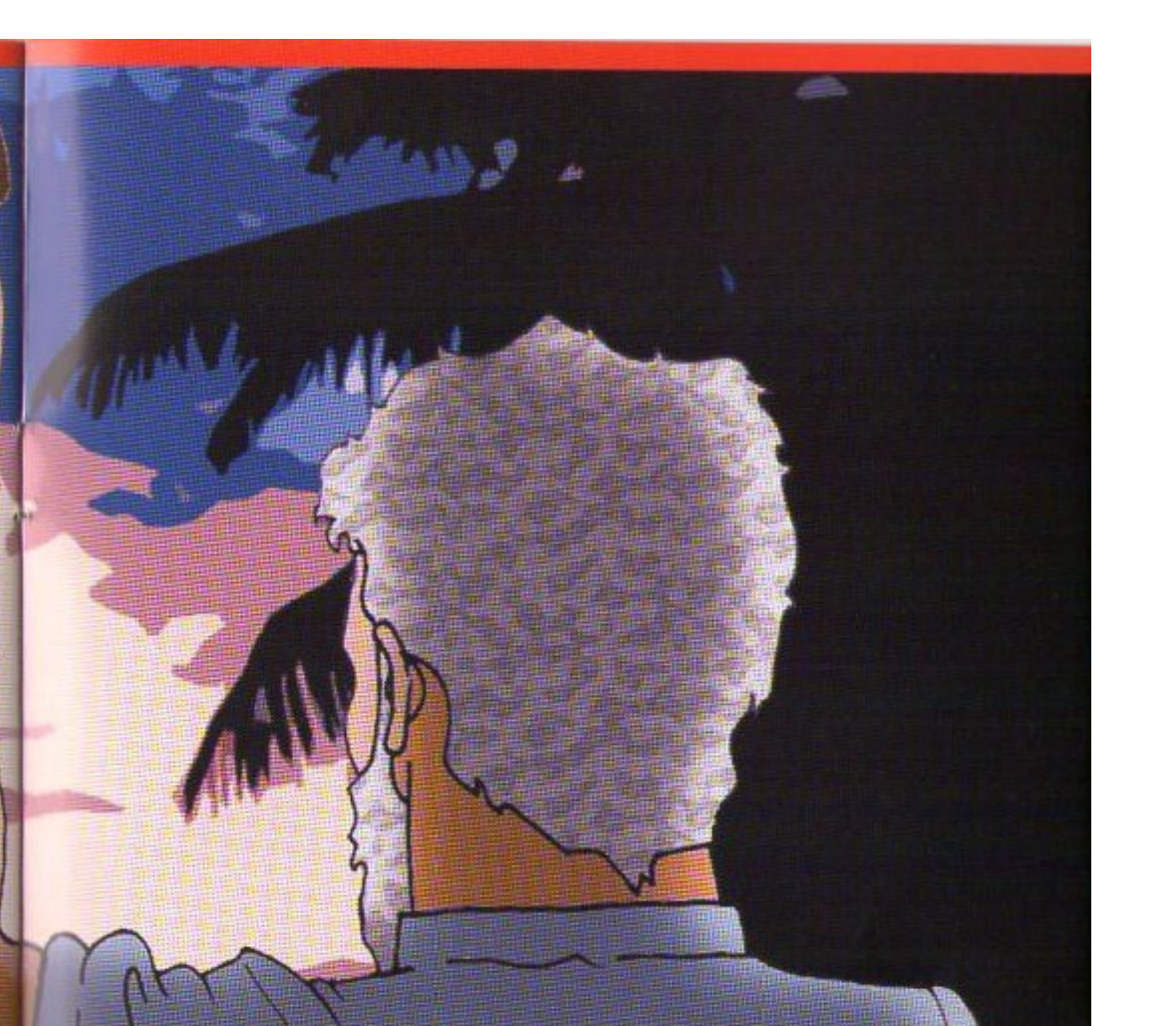

"I can not help you," replied the leper, "I have many responsibilities."

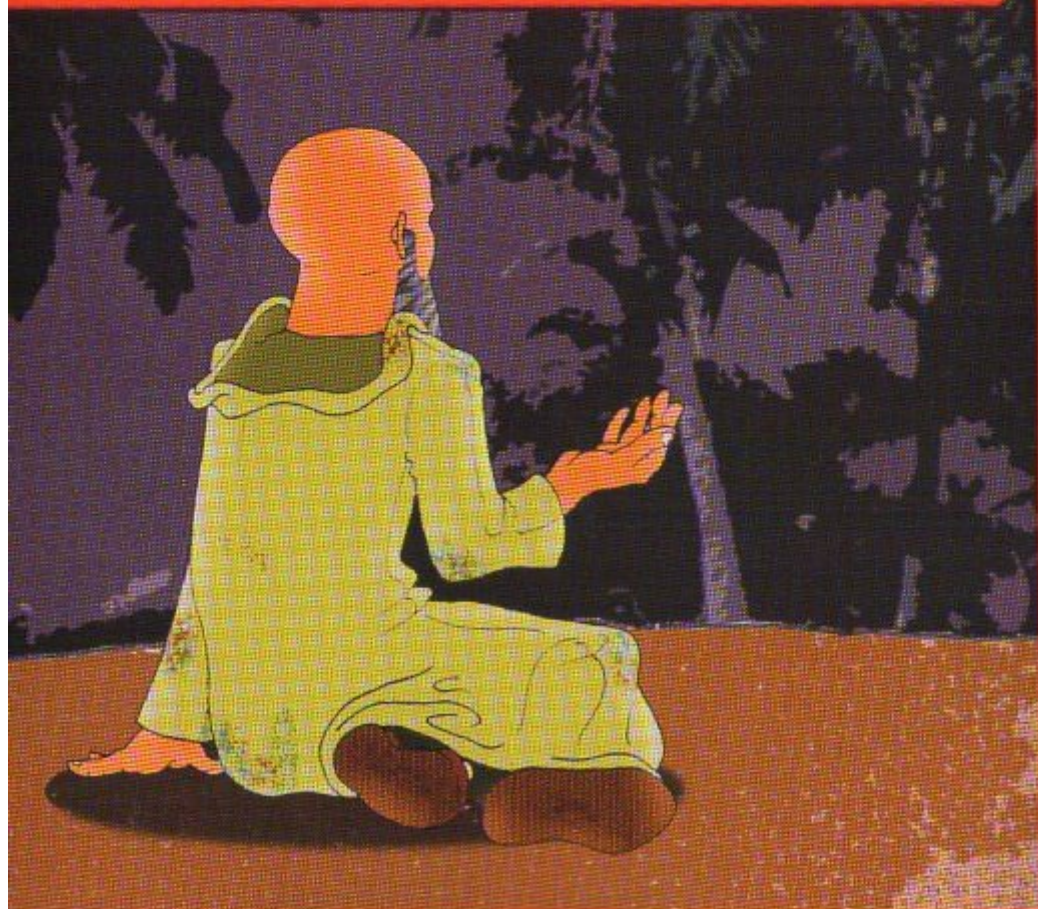
