FIRST GENERATION IN AMERICA

 THOMAS LEE, 1st, and his wife, *PHEBE BROWN came from England in 1641 with their three children, Thomas, 2nd, Jane and Sarah. Thomas Lee, the father, died on the passage. The widow and children landed in Boston and went to Saybrook, Connecticut.

**Extract from Diary of Joshua Hempstead*

"My grandmother was the daughter of William Brown who lived in County Essex, Town of Rusper, England, and came to New England in 1645. (Others of the family connection came too). He had three children that came over, Hennery, Phebe and Mary. Hennery lived at Providence and had three sons. Phebe had three husbands, first Thomas Lee, second Greenfield Larrabee, Sr. and third Cornish. Larrabee had five children, Greenfield, John, Elizabeth, Joseph, and Sarah. Joseph died young. Cornish had two sons, James and one still-born, with whom she died in child-bed at Northampton. Mary married Robert Marvin who lived at Southampton, L. I. and Hempstead. Their predecessors were ministers ever since Queen Mary's time."

SECOND GENERATION IN AMERICA

Children of THOMAS LEE, 1st, and PHEBE BROWN:

Jane Lee, married June, 1659, Samuel Hyde at Hartford, born about 1637. They had eight children. Samuel Hyde later married Mary De Wolf Lee the widow of his brother-in-law Thomas Lee 2nd.

Sarah Lee, married John Larg or Lag. We have no further record of her family.

Thomas Lee, 2nd, married Sarah Kirtland (or Kirkland) of Saybrook. They had five children. His second marriage was June, 1676, to Mary De Wolf, daughter of Balthazar De Wolf and Alice. They had nine children.

Thomas Lee, 2nd was one of the first settlers of Lyme. He was Freeman of Lyme May 12, 1670. He represented Lyme at a General Court at Hartford October 8, 1685—was recorded as "Ensign" Thomas Lee, later was recorded as "Sergeant." He died December 5th, 1704. Walworth's Hyde genealogy says Thomas Lee was one of the first settlers of Lyme, Connecticut, and had large possessions there.



THIRD GENERATION IN AMERICA

* The solemn Charge of John Lee of Lyme, Conn., given on his death bed January 13, 1726, to his children . . . , who departed this life on the 17th of the same month in the assurance of faith.

"I charge you my dear children that you fear God and keep His commandments, and that you uphold His public worship with as great diligence and constancy as you can and that you be constant in the duty of secret prayer twice every day, and all the days of your Life, and all of you that come to be heads of families that you be constant in family worships evening and morning with your families, besides your prayers at meal, that in your prayers you pray for converting grace for yourselves and others, and that God would show you the excellency of Christ, and cause you to love and believe in Him and show you the evil of sin, and make you hate it and forever flee from it, and that you may never give over until you have obtained converting grace from God. Furthermore, I charge you to choose death rather than deny Christ in any degree. Also I charge you that you never turn Papist or Heretic, but serve God in the way that you have been brought up, and avoid all evil companions, lest you be led into temptation and a snare, and be very careful to avoid excess in drinking. Also to avoid profaneness and all other sins. Also I charge you always to be dutiful to your mother and kind to one another.

This I leave in charge to all my posterity to the end of the world charging every person of them to keep a copy of this my dying charge to my children.
