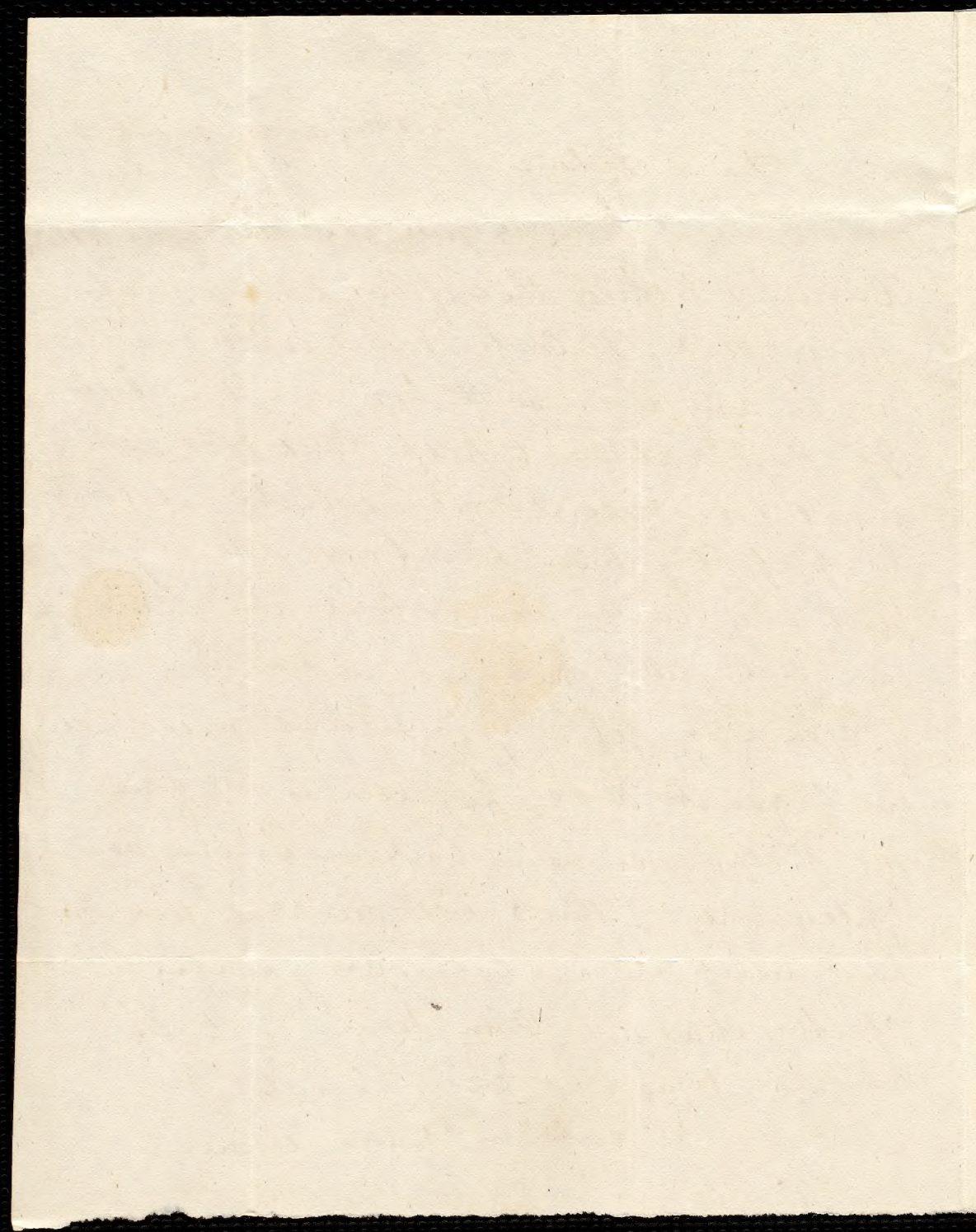


Tuesday noon, nearly 2.
