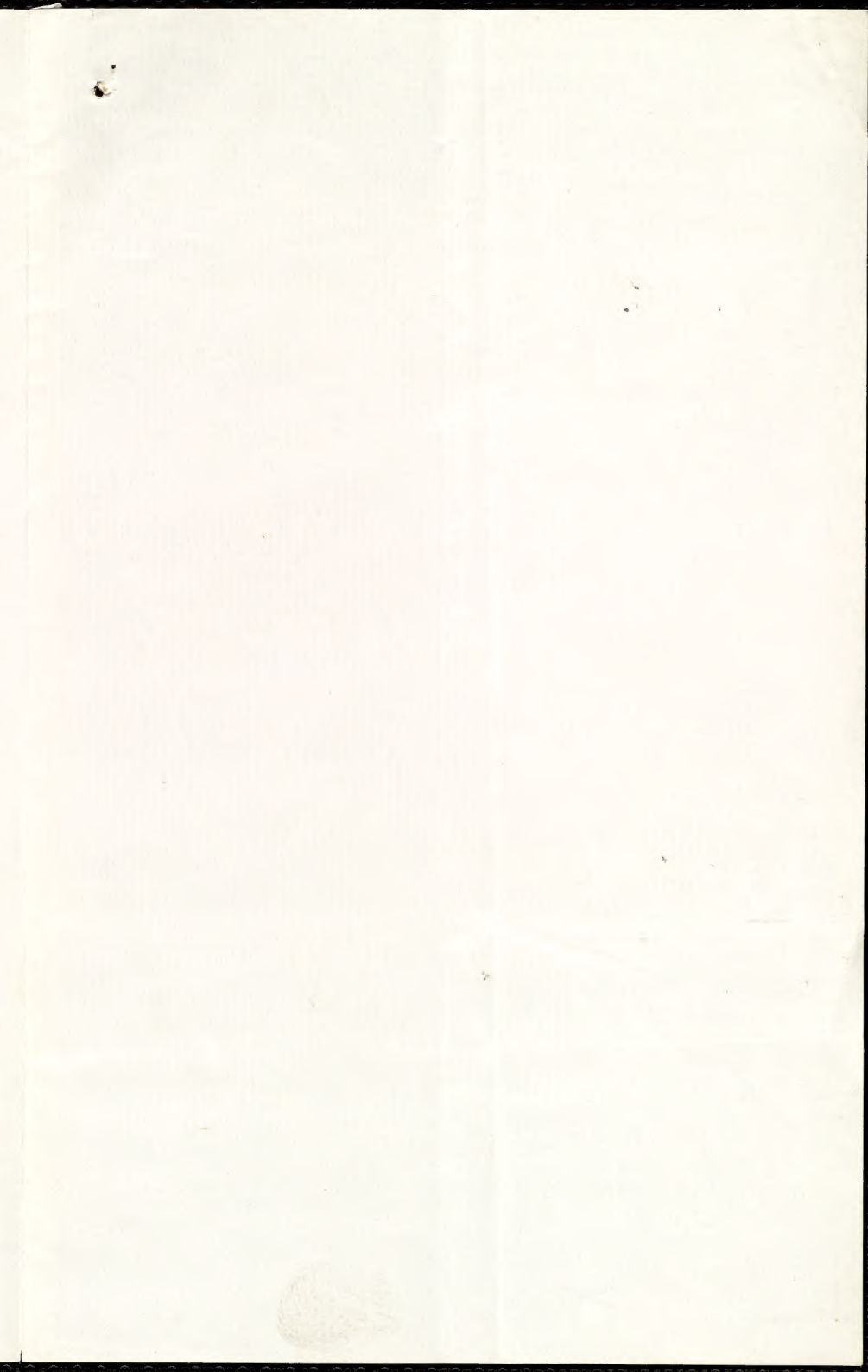
Dear Mrs. Chapman,
