I hope to be out of in Massachusetts - so to be near you till I am able again to do duty - You at home can do a good deal for me - I know you and Mrs Chapman have high friends which I suppose can make it possible for me to get home for a Month - to get well -

I will see myself by the by what I can do with my Doctor as soon we have a Hospital or where we are going to be moved -

Well Miss Hannah, I am lucky that I have got out the fight so saved it over all the time a shower of Bullets over and around me three bullets went through my blouse - a bullet hit my bridge-side and my head while pointing the Gun 1/2

oh it was terrible - Capt. Bigelow is Wounded twice and going home - Lieut. Eriksen  
killed and left on the field - Lieut. Whitaker Wounded - and gone home - We have 3 Sergeants Wounded  
1 killed - Corp. Baker was Wounded very severely - & given to be dead - there is forty  
others missing in killing & wounded - 60-70 Horses - killed -

We stood the ground and fought like Tigers - to the last extremity -

As soon I am removed I shall write again - please give my

kind regards with three Cheers - for the Victory near Gettysburg to Mrs. Weston  
to the Dr. Miss Anna Miss Emma and Mrs. Chapman

and to Almira and little Anna inform them that I am all  
right - and should like to come home to see them all
