Friend Caroline

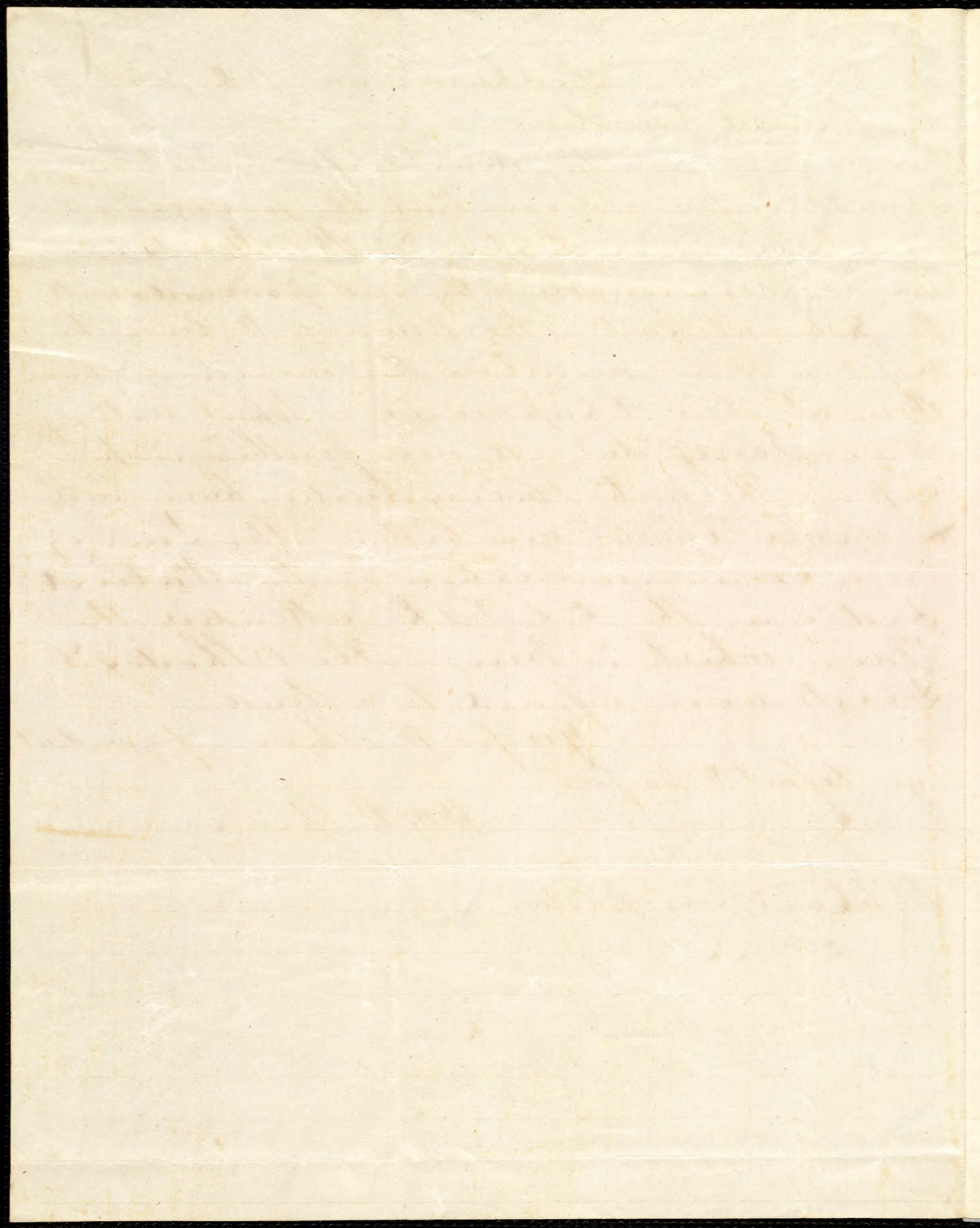

"Yes for the Slave" if you don't go to fast & too far"

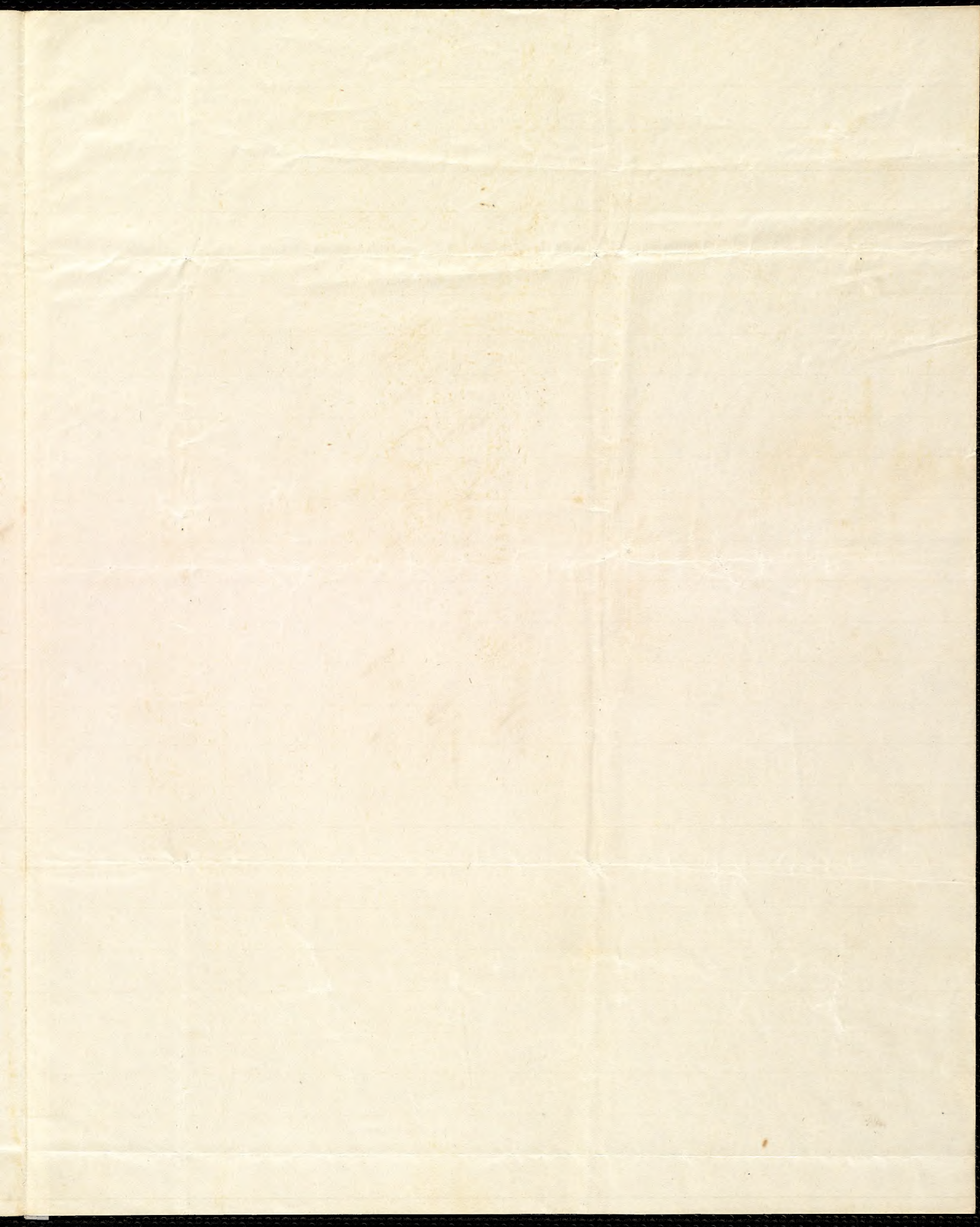
