

Dear Sir

Carlisle 26th June 1775

I take the liberty at last to intrude upon your important occupations & give you some account of our proceedings — upon receipt of the letters & Resolves of the Congress we applied to the Merchants of this Town who generously advanced £200 it was agreed to raise one Company of Buffs Men in your & Col. Callendar's Brothers the other end Col Thompson & Col. Montgomerys — I went up to Chambersburgh where I found some of the principal officers their effort on the occasion was such as did honor to the County I gave me great pleasure to see Major Chambers goes as Capt from them James Green got it the other less were not absolutely fixed upon who should ~~and may~~ but I am sure proper persons are before now appointed the Officers got fine Cash & proper Insignias & set out to raise the men Major Blane & Capt Henderick are over the Hill at Gettysburg I have this moment wrote to them to exert themselves I mentioned the engagement at Boston in just a manner as I hope will animate & not discourage you told I have been mentioned to go on this glorious service an ambition not very usual has seized me — an ambition to become less a Major instead of Lt Col It gives me great pleasure that you stand foremost among these illustrious Matroats whose wisdom I trust (under God) will preserve your exertions & liberties Your little Nelly called me to her today from the Street she is quite healthy & gay my best respects to Mrs Wilson




