



Otherworld: Cadences

F. S. FLINT (1885 - 1960)

English author Frank Stuart Flint was a prominent poet in the Imagist movement, along with Ezra Pound and T. E. Hulme. Flint abandoned school at the age of 13 to pursue rigorous self-study, eventually mastering 10 languages, including French and Latin, while working at various jobs. At 17, he took up poetry, inspired by the writing of Keats. This, his third and last book of poetry, reflects the influence of innovative French poetry, the Imagist movement and his friendship with Ezra Pound. At age 35, following the death of his wife, he ceased poetry altogether.
