The subject of this biography is Lord Cochrane, a Napoleonic-era sea captain whose adventures were the source material for many popular series of naval fiction. He started to write an autobiography called *Autobiography of a Seaman*, but he passed away after completing only two volumes, so naval historian Henry Fox Bourne and Cochrane's son decided to complete the biography by collaborating on two additional volumes under the title *The Life of Thomas, Lord Cochrane, Tenth Earl of Dundonald.* In this first volume, Cochrane helps the Chilean navy defeat the Pacific navy of Spain, and then takes command of the navy of Brazil. The volume ends with him sailing to Greece to aid them in rebellion against their Ottoman overlords.
