Sara Teasdale was an American lyric poet. Teasdale's first poem was published in *Reedy's Mirror*, a local newspaper in St. Louis, in 1907. Her first collection of poems, *Sonnets to Duse and Other Poems*, was published that same year.

Teasdale's second collection, *Helen of Troy and Other Poems*, was published in 1911. It was well received by critics, who praised its lyrical mastery and romantic subject matter. (Wikipedia)
