The following Abbreviations are used to express the form of the Flower :

- GLOB.,** Globular. The outer petals encircling the flower till fully blown, illustrated by the common Cabbage or Provence Roses.
- CUP.,** Cupped. The outer row of petals erect, rather incurved, enclosing numerous smaller petals; the Crimson Perpetual, or Madame Hardy, will illustrate this term.
- COMP.,** Compact. Petals stiff, close and upright, resembling a double Ranunculus.
- Ex.,** Expanded. The flower rather flat, petals open; in some varieties showing the central stamens.

The letter P placed immediately after the names, indicates those varieties which make long vigorous shoots, and if their branches are left long and tied up, form fine Pillar Roses.

R. P. begs to observe that, in the following list, only such varieties as are worthy a place in every distinguished collection, are enumerated; having found it expedient to exclude many of the old and less-valuable Roses (which, however, he has still in cultivation, and can be supplied at lower rates) to admit others possessing many superior qualifications.

Several of the new Roses not named in this list, can be supplied; and, also, any others not on hand, will be procured on the shortest notice.

Purchasers, not altogether acquainted with Roses, who are desirous of forming a Rosary or new Rose Clumps, and favoring R. P. with their orders, are respectfully invited to leave the selection of the same entirely to him, stating the amount of the sum they may wish to go to, the quantity wanted, the situation and purpose for which intended; and he begs to add that Amateurs so favoring him, will have no cause to repent of their confidence, as, in this case, Plants can be sent stronger, and charged lower than the catalogue prices—thus, the object of the Purchaser is more nearly attained.
