


# Sub neighborhood map of Venice

Eco-Fest was before my time. However, what was left behind, substantial debt, including a balance due to Rec & Parks, was happening when I first started working with the Chamber back in 2010.

Eco-Fest was run by a Chamber member and the Chamber was the fiscal receiver. However, all of the safeguards we now have, were not employed back then. And there was no oversight or accountability.

I can find out more if need be. However, my impression is that there were many bridges burned by this person.

There is no way what happened then, will happen now. First, the Chamber now has an employed executive director (me!). Back then, the Chamber was operated only by volunteers. Also, we have considerable mechanisms in place to ensure that project spending does not occur until funding is secured. And, we now have reporting requirements, where back then the Chamber did not.

To be clear - we added this to the Citywide event fund so he is referencing half the city fees from that fund - not our office budget. I have been working with Tricia so we don't pay \$6.5k but they still get a hefty level of support from us. I think we settled on paying half the city fees through the special event fund that doesn't affect our office budget and another \$2.5k as a contribution. This means we reduce our out of office contribution by \$4k from last year but still are giving a nearly comparable (though still less) level of financial support. As George has never been reimbursed through the Citywide event fund (because we never made good use of it) he is inquiring to that process.

Right, the City fees are less than I had hoped so the support he is getting from the Citywide event fund is a lot less than he received from our office last year. In an attempt to reduce our office commitment while not pulling out too much from the event (as we discussed in our meeting) we would need to give a donation.

To be clear, George got the following commitment from us last year: 4970 to AAA for staging, chairs, and tables 1047 for BOSS fees (though typically it is ~\$1,400) 274 for DOT

Totally about \$6,300 out of our budget last year

Half the DOT and BOSS fees will be in the neighborhood of \$950. LAPD will likely charge them this year and that is an unknown amount but half of that would be covered by the fee, lets assume a thousand for the sake of conversation, bringing the total estimated contribution from the Citywide event fund to ~\$2k which is \$4,300 less than the City contribution last year hence an additional donation to get us in the same universe of commitment which would still be a 29% reduction in City support and a 60% reduction to the cost from our CD11 budget. Not having to go through AAA (what we required before) and getting more flexible sponsorship dollars represents a financial benefit to George so the gulf is further reduced. This means we save 60% relative to our commitment from last year and the sign lighting only takes a hopefully marginal hit; win-win.

If we want to just give him like \$2k or something... I would just recommend not getting too low too quick both for the sake of the well-attended event and also so he doesn't get a new emcee or whatever else.
