Count Basie's contributions to swinging sounds over the past several decades make him a giant in the worlds of jazz and popular music. He is an original; one of a kind. While other bands have come and gone, Count Basie continues to roll on and on. At least part of this success is due to Basie's awareness of current musical trends and qualities.

Count Basie will not play just anything. Besides popularity in a tune he looks for quality. He found it with the Beatles. So, now it's "yea, yea," from John, Paul, George and Ringo. And a "one more time" from the Count himself as the Beatles and Basie hook up in a quality album that means excitement.

The genius of the Beatles is not confined to their appearances and publicity. It also lies in the quality of the songs written by John Lennon and Paul McCartney; songs sung by most of the world's top recording stars. It is this same quality that convinced Count Basie to do this album.

The Basie band comes out of the Beatle bag in full-bodied force: modern, inventive and totally exciting. Chico O'Farrill's scores give the Beatle songs a fresh, new, and vital life.

The familiar Basie sound brings the listener a new feel for the Beatles'tunes and O'Farrill's charts add a new dimension to the big band's sound. New too, is the sound of the Count as he swings from piano to organ adding to the different texture of the whole on such tunes as Can't Buy Me Love, Do You Want To Know A Secret, Yesterday and Kansas City.

Yesterday is also memorable for a fine Bill Henderson vocal, while *Michelle* is haunting and moving in the poignant, but never maudlin, Basie style.

Whether you're a Basie or a Beatle fan (or both), you couldn't ask for a more exciting combination than Count Basie and the Beatles.
