This album for me is the final product of an idea that was conceived some 3 years and 30,000 miles ago. A project that in the end took on meaning and proportions far beyond its original concept.

It was very rewarding to me to be able to get together some of my favorite performers and friends to create this unique jazz presentation.

Each musician has his own very special place on this album. Bassist Marshall Hawkins from Washington, D.C. and the "Dynamic Les De Merle from Hollywood" on drums are long time friends of mine now living in Los Angeles. When teamed up with my more recent acquaintances, guitarist Bruce Forman from San Francisco, pianist Dick Hindman from Denver and percussionist Michael Spiro from Seattle they give me that All-American Hollywood sound that I was looking for. With the addition of superb guest appearances by the Manhattan Transfer and Tom Waits the sound of "Hollywood Madness" began to take shape.

All we needed now was the Godfather. My friend and partner Eddie Jefferson who was taken from us much too soon, tied the whole "Hollywood Madness" sound together. Eddie's ideas and experience contributed heavily to the concept of this album and he will be greatly missed by me and his many, many friends throughout the world.

The music too reflects very special ideas of Hollywood from many different perspectives. Naturally, an album named "Hollywood Madness" must begin with an optimistic version of "Hooray for Hollywood". We follow this with an updated California rendition of Randy Weston's "Hi Fly". "Tokyo Rose" has moved to Hollywood, but is still singing the blues along with Charlie Parker who is "Relaxin' at Camarillo".

Gerald Price composer of "Cole's Nocturne" gave us another beautiful song in "Malibu Breeze" and of course Desi is still keeping his eye on Lucy. While driving in the van through the Pacific Northwest Eddie and I wrote the next song, "Waitin' for Waits", for one of our favorite people, Tom Waits, who explains personally at the end (very logically) why he kept us waiting.

When all is said and done we end the album the way we began but with a new reality.

And so from Hollywood we'll dim the lights and hope you've understood life's pleasures, treasures stem from music's madness through tears and gladness they're equally understood.....
