This musical aggregation blasted into the spotlight via the smash single, "Gimme Some Lovin", then continued the fireworks with another blockbuster disc entitled "I'm A Man". They are, of course, THE SPENCER DAVIS GROUP, and these swinging, gifted English lads are here to stay and stay and stay. 
