

MODERN CHINESE A BASIC COURSE

By the Faculty of Peking University

The records and grammar book comprising this introductory course in modern Chinese were designed by the Faculty of Peking University and have been used successfully for the past decade in teaching English-speaking and other foreign students basic Mandarin Chinese. The book and the record set make an excellent self-study program as well as an effective classroom course. The diligent student will learn a large basic vocabulary and will be conversant in the simple Chinese of daily life . . . achieving such complex constructions as "On Saturday I borrowed a translated novel from a friend, and on Sunday—(in one day) I read the whole novel."

The course begins with phonetics and concentrates first on pronunciation skills. The first four lessons introduce all the basic sounds, which are then joined and gradually built up into syllables, covering all possible combinations. Special heed is paid to tones, and vocabulary and simple sentence drill are included. Grammar begins with the most elementary principles—the negative and interrogative—and progresses to such advanced concepts as optative verbs and the perfective aspect. In the "text" section of each lesson, these rules are practiced in

sample sentences, which have been specially translated for this present Dover edition, and New Words are given and rehearsed.

The three records, based on the 249-page book, contain the Chinese of the Exercises of Lessons 1–8, the New Words and Simple Sentences of Lessons 9–12, and the New Words and Text of Lessons 13–30. Following along in the book or on the record is made easy by notations of record sides and bands at appropriate points in the lessons.
