RUSTY MEETS HOAGY

On this Long Playing Mercury recording, two all-American artists pool their talents; one a performer whose stature grows every day as an exponent of the peculiarly American style of easy person-to-person delivery of a song, Rusty Draper, and the other a songsmith who fashions a tune in a peculiarly American idiom of informality and fresh melodic appeal, Hoagy Carmichael.

Put these two men together and you have a most unique combination for producing a quality of Americana rarely found in our country's popular art. There are indeed certain qualities which often appear in popular music which you won't find on this of all records: you won't find pretentiousness nor bombast nor big blaring notes nor big words of obscure, over-romantic imagery. But what you will find is a rich abundance of a down-to-earth American feeling.

For these songs are the work of two pensive and poignant artists, the singer and the writer, Rusty and Hoagy; each of these creative artists is full to the brim with the simple emotions of the honest human being, feeling things and expressing things in the understandable symbols of the millions of sensitive, responsive people who are their fans.

So sit back and enjoy yourself with Rusty and Hoagy as they run through a spectrum of musical color, all on a let-your-hair-down level of good taste, ranging from the unabashed solitude of Georgia On My Mind and Old Rockin' Chair to the frothy bounce of In The Cool, Cool, Cool Of The Evening and Doctor, Lawyer, Indian Chief and all the way to the exciting fun of Hong Kong Blues. You're in for a rare, informal treat with old friends.
